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emotions shape our mental and social lives but their relation to morality is problematic are they sources of moral knowledge or obstacles to morality fourteen original articles by leading scholars in moral psychology and philosophy of mind explore the relation between emotions and practical rationality value autonomy and moral identity

moral issues and questions abound in daily life media outlets frequently raise awareness of many such as those concerning individuals right to privacy the same venues seldom if ever raise awareness of others such as moral issues and questions concerning our fantasies regardless of the level of publicity various venues afford particular moral matters most people who become aware of those matters find many interesting and important a problem

most encounter however is determining the criteria through which they should approach the moral matters they wish to engage ethicists have long sought a moral theory that would provide the desired criteria but most will grant readily that those efforts have not produced a generally accepted theory this book presents the author's case that a kind of moral liberalism is the theory we should use to engage daily life's moral matters the author presents a conception of moral liberalism argues that it is the best approach to practical morality in a plural society and applies it to several of morality's practical matters

self control is a fundamental part of what it is to be a human being it poses important philosophical and psychological questions about the nature of belief motivation judgment and decision making more immediately failures of self control can have high costs resulting in ill health loss of relationships and even violence and death whereas strong self control is also often associated with having a virtuous character what exactly is self control if we lose control can we still be free can we be held responsible for loss of self control in this thorough and clearly written introduction to the philosophy of self control the authors examine and assess the following topics and questions the importance of self control what is self control self control and the law of desire mechanisms of self control how is it possible to lose self control blameworthiness and the loss of self control externalist self control pathologies of self control combining philosophical analysis with surveys of the latest psychological research and including chapter summaries suggestions for further reading and a glossary of key terms self control is essential reading for students of philosophy of mind and psychology moral psychology free will and ethics it will also be of interest to those in related fields such as psychology and cognitive science

like david hume whose work on justice she engages here annette c baier is a consummate essayist her spirited witty prose captures nuances and telling examples in order to elucidate important philosophical ideas baier is also one of hume's most sensitive and insightful readers in the cautious jealous virtue she deepens our understanding of hume by examining what he meant by justice in baier's account hume always understood justice to be closely linked to self interest hence his description of it in an enquiry concerning the principles of morals as the cautious jealous virtue but his understanding of the virtue expanded over time as evidenced by later works including his history of england along with justice baier investigates the role of the natural virtue of equity which hume always understood to constrain justice in hume's thought arguing that hume's view of equity can serve to balance his account of the artificial virtue of justice the cautious jealous virtue is an illuminating meditation that will interest not only hume scholars but also those interested in the issues of justice and in ethics more generally

this latest volume of the register of educational research in the united kingdom lists all the major research projects being undertaken in britain during the latter months of 1992 the whole of 1993 and 1994 and the early months of 1995 each entry provides names and addresses of the researchers a detailed abstract the source and amount of the grant where applicable the length of the project and details of published material about the research

the catholic university of america press is honored to publish the english critical edition of the works of karol wojtyła john paul ii under the auspices of an international editorial board the english critical edition will comprise more than 20 volumes covering all of john paul s writings and correspondence in the years before and during his papacy this collection is essential for several reasons for one thing gaining access to the saint s writings has posed a significant challenge except for official papal addresses and documents preserved and disseminated by the vatican st john paul s works have been scattered and limited many documents need a new translation finally english language audiences have faced the challenge even in the case of published texts of dealing with several languages various translations and textual idiosyncrasies the second volume of the series presents wojtyła s lectures at the catholic university of lublin and his works on max scheler this volume consists of three parts karol wojtyła s lectures at the lublin university from 1954 to 1957 during three academic years wojtyła s articles related to the ethical issues discussed in the lublin lectures and his habilitation thesis on max scheler from 1953 with other essays related more closely to scheler s thought as was the case with volume 1 volume 2 also relies on the original manuscripts and typescripts of wojtyła s works these original texts were compared with the polish published editions and the significant differences between them were marked in the scholarly apparatus some of the essays in this volume were never published in english others were never published before
