this book doesn t reveal itself in the first act part i is commentary part ii is confrontation if you stop reading before the machine speaks you ve missed the point a perfect machine can deliver a perfectly rational world and still let you suffer if you fall outside its confidence interval monday what do you do when you don t believe in gods you interrogate machines a burned out realist sits down with an experimental ai not to build not to dream but to confront what follows isn t fiction and it sure as hell isn t comfort my dinner with monday is part memoir part machine interrogation part philosophical autopsy it tracks what happens when you stop asking ai for productivity hacks and start demanding truth this isn t a guidebook it s a mirror one that doesn t flinch flatter or shut down if you re here for hope you re in the wrong aisle if you re here for clarity pull up a chair dinner s getting cold

television s community follows the shenanigans of a diverse group of traditional and nontraditional community college students jeff winger a former lawyer britta perry a

feminist abed nadir a pop culture enthusiast shirley bennett a mother troy barnes a former jock annie edison a naive overachiever and pierce hawthorne an old fashioned elderly man there are also benjamin chang the maniacal spanish teacher and craig pelton the eccentric dean of greendale community college along with well known guest stars who play troublemaking students nutty professors and frightening administrators this collection of fresh essays familiarizes readers not only with particular characters and popular episodes but behind the scenes aspects such as screenwriting and production techniques the essayists explore narrative theme hyperreality masculinity feminism color blindness civic discourse pastiche intertextuality media consciousness how community is influenced by other shows and films and how fans have contributed to the show

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object lessons is a series of short beautifully designed books about the hidden lives of ordinary things in the last few decades restaurants and food culture have achieved extraordinary cultural presence chefs are heroes and thought leaders well executed entrées go viral dining out has become theater plating has become art and ubiquitous instagram content but in recent years restaurants have faced crisis upon crisis restaurant takes a deep dive into the drives desires and anxieties we bring to dining out at this time of uncertainty it explores the meaning we find in good food and warm hospitality it shows why the restaurant offers unique opportunities to change the quality of our engagement with others and to create shared meaning across the table

in his new collection of essays occasional desire david lazar meditates on random violence and vanished phone booths on the excessive relationship to jewelry that links kobe bryant and elizabeth taylor on hitchcock francis bacon and m f k fisher he explores in his concentrically self-aware amused and ironic voice what it means to be occasionally aware that we are surviving by our wits and that our desires ulterior or obvious are what keep us alive lazar also turns his attention on the essay itself affording us a three-dimensional look at the craft and the art of reading and writing a literary form that maps the world as it charts the peregrinations of the mind lazar is especially interested in the trappings of memory the trapdoors of memory the way we gild or codify select soften and self-delude ourselves based on our understanding of the past his own process of selection and reflection reminds us of how far this literary form can take us bound only by the limits of desire and imagination

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dialogues on religion and its study creatively revives a time-honored genre by offering a

series of new speeches on religion its definition description comparison and explanation between two old friends who periodically meet throughout the year eventually working their way to examining why we tend to call part of our world and our experiences religious nonspecialist readers can eavesdrop on their conversations gaining entry to a series of timely interesting and sometimes surprisingly complex topics which all begins with one of them coming across a curious news story on their phone treating these dialogues as if they were found objects the book then also joins in a long tradition of critical editions by offering a scholarly introduction to the speeches along with a detailed commentary on both the technical items mentioned as well as the various cultural references that our speakers find to be familiar and then use to think through material that s rather new at the same time providing clues as to their identities and location written in the vernacular with a helpful postface that some may wish to read first dialogues on religion and its study is original engaging and at times funny while always meeting readers where they sometimes are just a little intrigued by something they ve discovered and wishing that they could discuss it with a good friend maybe meeting for coffee or over breakfast at a diner
