although it receives much less attention than better known disarmament processes the destruction of small arms is reshaping the military arsenals of the world out of roughly 200 modern military small arms world wide about 500 000 are destroyed every year the commitment of major governments and international organizations makes small arms destruction a permanent addition to the global disarmament repertoire but the prospects for greater military small arms disarmament may be declining as war in afghanistan and iraq create unprecedented demand for second hand weaponry inconspicuous disarmament of small arms and ammunition is reshaping the global picture of firearms light weapons and ammunition the process is far from comprehensive but much more than cosmetic small arms destruction is here to stay but its contributions may be fleeting this book is the first full length examination of the issue the case studies in this volume examine the politics of military small arms disarmament when they ask is surplus destruction most likely and what can be done to make destruction more likely and more effective case studies examine small arms destruction by nato and the osce and in bulgaria cambodia germany kazakhstan papua new guinea romania serbia ukraine and others this book was published as a special issue of contemporary security policy

the end of the cold war opened unprecedented opportunities for reductions in weapons of mass destruction with these opportunities came new challenges both scientific and political traditionally approached by different groups the scientific technical and political challenges are inextricably intertwined agreements to dismantle and destroy chemical nuclear and conventional weapons after having been negotiated via diplomatic channels require the expertise of scientists associated with their development to determine the safest and most environmentally sound methods of destruction it is in this context that representatives from sixteen countries and five international organizations were convened jointly by nato the ministry of foreign affairs of the federal republic of germany and the state government of north rhine westphalia 19 21 may 1996 in a meeting near bonn to take stock of worldwide efforts to destroy and dismantle chemical nuclear and conventional weapons remaining after the end of the cold war nato support was provided under the auspices of the nato science committee s panel on disarmament technologies the conference brought together the major actors involved in the dismantlement and destruction of chemical nuclear and conventional weapons highlighted the substantial accomplishments achieved in this area and pinpointed the remaining technical obstacles still to be overcome it also underlined the critical importance of transparency data exchange and verification as indispensable preconditions for disarmament and cooperative security

most talk of and writing on art is about its relationship to creation and creativity this of course takes various forms but ultimately the creative act in the making of art works is a key issue what happens when we put together art and destruction this has been referenced in some major areas such as that of art and iconoclasm and auto destructive art movements less evident are accounts of more intimate smaller scale destructive interventions into the world of the made or exhibited art object or more singular and particularised approaches to the representation of mass destruction this volume addresses these lacunae by bringing together some distinct and very different areas for enquiry which nevertheless share a theme of destruction and share an emphasis upon the history of twentieth and twenty first century art making scholars and makers have come together to produce accounts of artists whose making is driven by the breaking of or breaking down of matter and medium as part of the creative materialisation of the idea such as richard wentworth bouke de vries cornelia parker to name some of those artists represented here and indeed in one case how our very attempts to write about such practices are challenged by this making process other perspectives have engaged in critical study of various destructive interventions in galleries some of these whether as actual staged actions in real time or filmic representations of precarious objects are understood as artistic acts in and of themselves at the same time an account included in this volume of certain contemporary iconoclasts defacing or otherwise effecting destructive attempts upon canonised exhibited artworks reflects upon these destructive interventionists as self styled artists claiming to add to the significance of works via acts of destruction yet other chapters provide a fresh outlook upon distinctive and unusual approaches to the representation of destruction in terms of the larger scale and landscape of artistic responses to mass destruction in times of war this book will be of interest to readers keen to encounter the range of nuance complexity and ambiguity applicable to the bringing together of art and destruction
