winner of the 2018 media ecology association s erving goffman award for outstanding scholarship in the ecology of social interaction winner of the eastern communication association s everett lee hunt award a behind the scenes account of how death is presented in the media death is considered one of the most newsworthy events but words do not tell the whole story pictures are also at the epicenter of journalism and when photographers and editors illustrate fatalities it often raises questions about how they distinguish between a fit and unfit image of death death makes the news is the story of this controversial news practice picturing the dead jessica fishman uncovers the surprising editorial and political forces that structure how the news and media cover death the patterns are striking overturning long held assumptions about which deaths are newsworthy and raising fundamental questions about the role that news images play in our society in a look behind the curtain of newsrooms fishman observes editors and photojournalists from different types of organizations as they deliberate over which images of death make the cut and why she also investigates over 30 years of photojournalism in the tabloid and patrician press to establish when the dead are shown and whose dead body is most newsworthy illustrating her findings with high profile news events including recent plane crashes earthquakes hurricanes homicides political unrest and war time attacks death makes the news reveals that much of what we think we know about the news is wrong while the patrician press claims that they do not show dead bodies they are actually more likely than the tabloid press to show them even though the tabloids actually claim to have no qualms showing these bodies dead foreigners are more likely to be shown than american bodies at the same time there are other unexpected but vivid patterns that offer insight into persistent editorial forces that routinely structure news coverage of death an original view on the depiction of dead bodies in the media death makes the news opens up new ways of thinking about how death is portrayed

departing from the present need for cultural models within the public debate this volume offers a new contribution to the study of cultural icons from the traditional religious icon to the modern mass media icon from the recognizable visual icon to the complex entanglement of image and collective narratives the construction and dynamics of cultural icons offers an overview of existing theories compares different definitions and proposes a comprehensive view on the icon and the iconic focusing in particular on the making of iconic representations and their changing social cultural meanings through time scholars from cultural memory studies art history and literary studies present concrete operationalizations of the ways different types of cultural icons can be studied

support of the ottoman empire was official british policy for some forty years following the crimean war a widespread and astonishing confidence prevailed in england whatever past and continuing deficiencies might exist the ottoman porte as the government of the empire was known in europe was determined to westernize and in fact was becoming more british every day but reports of a series of alleged massacres by the turks against their bulgarian subjects scandalized britain in 1876 igniting a firestorm

of protest that shook the nation reluctant icon tells the story of one of the most relentless social crusades of the victorian era under the leadership of former prime minister william ewart gladstone a loose coalition of nonconformists radicals and high churchmen created a climate of indignation over the massacres that was strong enough to call into question the disraeli government s policy toward the near east this absorbing analysis by ann pottinger saab draws on contemporary newspaper accounts parliamentary petitions and the diaries and personal papers of gladstone to recreate a pivotal episode in late nineteenth century british history saab provides an informative historical backdrop to her study by tracing the multiple sources of strain in british ottoman relations that existed before the massacres she then examines gladstone s evolving role as public idol and backstage adviser to a coterie of special groups that became bonded to him by a shared moral vision and a sense of continuing emergency through the lens of the bulgarian agitation gladstone emerges as a man motivated more by his own complex emotional and political drives than by opportunism a somewhat different picture from that presented by earlier historians the heart of the book is saab s richly detailed exploration of the nascence and maturation of the militant extra parliamentary multi class protest movement itself which mobilized the anger of groups previously outside politics such as newly enfranchised working men reluctant icon yields new insights on gladstone on the language of victorian social protest and on a national protest movement remarkable as much for its cohesiveness and longevity as for its fervor it will be welcome reading for all those with an abiding interest in the victorian age and especially for scholars and students of social religious and diplomatic history

artfully curated by james r hansen a reluctant icon letters to neil armstrong is a companion volume to dear neil armstrong letters to the first man from all mankind collecting hundreds more letters armstrong received after first stepping on the moon until his death in 2012 providing context and commentary hansen has assembled the letters by the following themes religion and belief anger disappointment and disillusionment quacks conspiracy theorists and ufologists fellow astronauts and the world of flight the corporate world celebrities stars and notables and last messages taken together both collections provide fascinating insights into the world of an iconic hero who took that first giant leap onto lunar soil willingly and thereby stepped into the public eye with reluctance space enthusiasts historians and lovers of all things related to flight will not want to miss this book
