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in this major new text christoph knill and jale tosun provide an engaging introduction to the theory and practice of public policy analysis and to the changing nature of the policy process the book examines the key approaches and methods of public policy analysis and shows how these can inform public policy choices it assesses the way various actors interests and institutions affect each stage of the policy process including agenda setting decision making and implementation the authors go on to explore core themes such as policy change over time and policy variation across countries and sectors diverse real world examples from alcohol control in russia to environmental policy in mexico are included throughout to illustrate the international and multilevel dimensions of public policy

this ground breaking study offers a new paradigm for understanding the beliefs and religions of the goths burgundians sueves franks and lombards as they converted from paganism to christianity between c 350 and c 700 ce combining history and theology with approaches drawn from the cognitive science of religion belief and religion in barbarian europe uses both written and archaeological evidence to challenge many older ideas beginning with a re examination of our knowledge about the deities and rituals of their original religions it goes on to question the assumption that the germanic peoples were merely passive recipients of christian doctrine arguing that so called arianism was first developed as an entry level christianity for the goths focusing on individual ethnic groupings in turn it presents a fresh view of the relationship between religion and politics as their rulers attempted to opt for catholicism in place of familiar debates about post conversion pagan survivals contemporary texts and legislation are analysed to create an innovative cognitive perspective on the ways in which the church endeavoured to bring the christian god into people s thoughts and actions the work also includes a survey of a wide range of written and archaeological evidence contrasting traditional conceptions of death afterlife and funerary ritual with christian doctrine and practice in these areas and exploring some of the techniques developed by the church for assuaging popular anxieties about christian burial and the christian afterlife

public policy research has become increasingly comparative over the past several decades but the methodological issues involved in this research have not been discussed adequately this handbook provides a discussion of the fundamental methodological issues in comparative policy research as well as descriptions and analyses of major techniques used for that research the techniques discussed are both quantitative and qualitative and all are embedded in the broader discussion of comparative research design

the second edition of this popular textbook combines coverage of public policies in different countries with the conceptual and methodological frameworks for analysing them this new edition pays particular attention to the international contexts of ideas interests and institutions in which

decision makers operate in addition it considers the bilateral multilateral and transnational aspects of policy making in today's interconnected world this is a core text for introductory modules on undergraduate and postgraduate public policy public management and public administration programmes in addition it will be useful for those courses that take a comparative approach to specific policy areas such as welfare health and education with a focus on enabling students to draw their own comparisons it is the ideal choice for lecturers across the world new to this edition new and improved chapter structure places conceptual discussion before the empirical analysis leading to a stronger emphasis on big picture questions throughout increased attention to contemporary relevant policy issues such as migration climate change and security quantitative and descriptive data has been systematically updated

this comprehensive handbook examines public policy evaluation in democracies focusing on the political dimension of the evaluation process it argues that policy evaluation can be an emancipatory tool reducing social inequalities and exclusion and offers novel suggestions on how evaluations can be used to improve democratic policymaking

drawing on comparative politics and social network analysis this book examines how the domestic institutional and organizational settings as well as the network governance patterns determine variation in administrative responses to eu's common agricultural policy cap in two european union eu member states denmark and greece these two small member states represent the north and south dimensions of the eu the north south dimension in relation to administrative structures respond differently to eu common policies and to common agricultural policy specifically which has not been studied in the europeanization literature even though the study of administrative responses to eu common policies is important as it has been especially noticeable during the current financial crisis europeanisation studies concentrate on either large western european states france germany and uk or small western northern states these studies produced detailed knowledge on specific countries and policy areas but they ignored the agricultural policy area and the importance of small southern member states by comparing a small southern with a small northern state since the accession to the eu this book aims to fill this gap in the literature

moreover by linking the findings of the two cases to the member states that joined the eu in the 2004 fifth enlargement and in other policy areas it allows a better understanding of similar responses either adaptation or inertia this book represents an important contribution to the theoretical and empirical literature on europeanisation and the common agricultural policy cap it systematically tackles an under studied question does europeanisation of policies lead to administrative change and convergence among the member states the domestic administration of the eu cap has remained domestically designed and monitored resulting in divergence among the member states and gaps and imbalances in the performance of eu cap decisions the cap is of more general interest because it combines regulatory and market intervention policy instruments the analysis proceeds through in depth comparative historical case studies of denmark and greece which uses a sophisticated combination of quantitative and qualitative methodologies the authoritative and informative analysis is structured by a focus on three key domestic factors there is differentiated administration of common policies and while administration succeeds and adapts in one state it does not necessarily do so in others leading to differences in implementation performance this book should provide a stimulus for further research wyn grant university of warwick the last 40 years have been crucial for the european agriculture the common agricultural policy fulfilled its primary objective which led europeans to shift its objectives and cope with the shortcomings created by the success of the policy itself manage surpluses and narrow the gap between farmers due to price mechanism as well as adapt the policy following the successive enlargements and follow the developments in the global economy in which we live nowadays dr chatzopoulou gives us a very accurate image on how differently actors of the agricultural economy farmers cooperatives and the administrations both in greece and denmark behave but also how different is the structure of the sector in these two countries in denmark almost everything is based upon a consensus where there does not exist a law on cooperatives and where the administration and the sector work together to adapt or to influence the decisions to take at european level on the other hand in greece farmers struggle to make their voice heard in the absence of professional organizations the cooperatives are bound to work in the framework of a specific and strict law and the administration was not shown very cooperative with the sector

these two realities are very well illustrated by the author and many lessons are to be learnt through this study but above all the author gives us a fair idea of how complex is the process of europeanisation in a europe union composed of sovereign member states with different history culture social organization and different legal systems vaggelis divaris former european commission principal administrator dg agriculture and rural development

planning theorists normally focus on issues of contest and critique the field of planning theory is thereby replete with studies of conflict collaboration and criticism considerably less critical attention is afforded to policy approaches that emerge evolve and are widely adopted in the apparent absence of discord this book addresses this knowledge gap a case study of the emergence of green infrastructure policy in ireland is used to both inform and illustrate a theory of policy entitlement this interpretive approach focuses on meaning making in context to explain the counter intuitive processes through which a new policy concept can emerge and reprofile planning activities by producing the seemingly pre existing objective reality to which such policy is then applied and the discipline re orientated this approach accounts for how a new planning concept can appear to resolve problematic policy ambiguity by suspending disagreement on issues where dispute could be expected this book will be of interest to those studying planning theory and the policy process as well as those concerned with the undertheorized but swift rise to prominence of green infrastructure planning

introducing the institutional logics perspective to street level analysis this book examines how street level workers deal with the institutional logics that guide their organization whether they follow or challenge them while doing so the book develops a theoretical framework to study street level workers institutional agency within organizations from different institutional backgrounds the book conceptualizes street level workers as institutional entrepreneurs and presents an original process model to capture deinstitutionalization efforts in street level discourse this ordinal model accounts for embedded agency and institutional entrepreneurship as well as for more gradual moves towards deinstitutionalization through the hybridization of institutional logics the author tests the model empirically using interview data and discusses how street level workers diverge from the institutional logic of their organization in almost two thirds of their statements indicating a tendency towards institutional entrepreneurship the book finally combines two literature strands institutionalism and implementation research showing how street level workers may be perceived as institutional entrepreneurs this book will appeal to students scholars and researchers of political science public policy public administration and organizational studies as well as to practitioners and policy makers interested in a better understanding of institutional entrepreneurs street work and the institutional logics perspective
