once the exclusive prerogative of *domaine réservé* landscape has gained increasing importance in international law in recent years since the introduction of cultural landscapes within the unesco world heritage convention and particularly since the adoption of the european landscape convention etc emphasis has shifted beyond a scenic preservationist approach towards a more dynamic human centred one the focus is not only on outstanding landscapes but also on the everyday and degraded landscapes where most people live and work landscape is land shaped by people after all and its protection management and planning have a number of implications for democracy human rights and spatial justice despite these links however there has been little legal scholarship on the topic how does international law which deals for the most part with universality deal with something so region specific and particular as landscape what is the legal conception of landscape and what are the various roles played by international law in its protection amy strecker assesses the institutional framework for landscape protection analyses the interplay between landscape and human rights and links the etymology and theory of landscape with its articulation in law

an exploration of depictions and use of water within renaissance italy and especially in the work of polymath leonardo da vinci both a practical necessity and a powerful symbol water presents one of the most challenging problems in visual art due to its formlessness clarity and

mutability in renaissance italy it was a nearly inexhaustible subject of inquiry for artists engineers and architects alike it represented an element to be productively harnessed and a force of untamed nature watermarks places the depiction and use of water within an intellectual history of early modern italy examining the parallel technological and aesthetic challenges of mastering water and the scientific and artistic practices that emerged in response to them focusing primarily on the wide ranging work of leonardo da vinci 1452 1519 at once an artist scientist and inventor leslie geddes shows how the deployment of artistic media such as ink and watercolor closely correlated with the engineering challenges of controlling water in the natural world for da vinci and his peers she argues drawing was an essential form of visual thinking geddes analyses a wide range of da vinci s subject matter including machine drawings water management schemes and depictions of the natural landscape and demonstrates how drawing as an intellectual practice a form of scientific investigation and a visual representation constituted a distinct mode of problem solving integral to his understanding of the natural environment throughout geddes draws important connections between works by da vinci that have long been overlooked the artistic and engineering practices of his day and critical questions about the nature of seeing and depicting the almost unseeable during the early modern period

first published in 2004 the river orcia flows westwards out of a majestic valley in central italy cuts a ravine through the northern flanks of monte amiata and descends through rolling hills to the coastal plain the maremma on its upper reaches a thousand years ago the first farms regulated by the mezzadria contract were created a share cropping system which established a stable farm population in the countryside with half the produce going to an urban landlord class there were some variations in its organization and when in the 19th century the mezzadria was finally established on the hills and newly drained swamps of the maremma the farms were much more commercially oriented and grouped into very large estates the collapse of the mezzadria also created major fractures in rural society the three main theoretical issues with which this book is concerned capitalist agriculture technological change and rationality

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
