this book analyzes the dynamic macroeconomic effects of public capital in industrialized countries the issue of whether public capital is productive has received a great deal of recent attention yet existing empirical analyses have been limited to a small set of countries this book presents a new database that provides internationally comparable capital stock estimates for 22 oecd countries for the 1960 2001 period building on this database the book estimates the dynamic effects of public capital using a variety of econometric methods the results suggest that public capital is productive in oecd countries on average the theoretical analysis based on a dynamic general equilibrium model shows that the effects of public capital depend crucially on the way the government chooses to finance additional spending

this paper examines sources of economic growth in east asia the conventional growth accounting approach to estimating the sources of economic growth requires unrealistically strong assumptions about either competitiveness of factor markets or the form of the underlying aggregate production function the paper outlines a new approach utilizing nonparametric derivative estimation techniques that does not require imposing these restrictive assumptions the results for east asian countries show that output elasticities of capital and labor tend to be different from the income shares of these factors the paper also explores the compensating potential of private intergenerational transfers

both keynes s general theory and orthodox economics seek to understand how competitive markets work but they diverge sharply with respect to the nature and properties of the competitive equilibrium the reason as keynes himself pointed out is that the general theory recognises that the future consequences of current decisions are fundamentally uncertain which contra the orthodox view radically affects decision
