emphasis on the correct description of psychological phenomena shows what is likely to live on as classic contributions to psychology this certainly holds for his own work on figure and ground which after almost a century is still universally known and admired by psychologists he was indeed a consummate psychological observer the book argues for the importance of description in psychology
