

Roger Hickman Reel Music

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reel music provides a thorough introduction to the basic terms and concepts students need

to explore the significance of music in combination with film and dramatic performance covering both popular and symphonic film scores from the late nineteenth century to 2004 reel music avoids overwhelming students with an unmanageable number of films and composers focusing instead on only the most significant works organized chronologically by era the text examines film history in relation to trends in other artistic mediums such as the development of rock and roll and in the context of world and national events such as the cold war space exploration and vietnam publisher description

the oxford handbook of music and medievalism brings together international scholars from a wide range of disciplines to provide a snapshot of the diverse ways in which medievalism the retrospective immersion in the images sounds narratives and ideologies of the european middle ages powerfully transforms many of the varied musical traditions of the last two centuries

this book explores the role of music in the some five hundred feature length films on the middle ages produced between the late 1890s and the present day haines focuses on the tension in these films between the surviving evidence for medieval music and the idiomatic tradition of cinematic music the latter is taken broadly as any musical sound occurring in a film from the clang of a bell off screen to a minstrel singing his song medieval film music must be considered in the broader historical context of pre cinematic medievalisms and of medievalist cinema s main development in the course of the twentieth century as an american appropriation of european culture the book treats six pervasive moments that define the genre of medieval film the church tower bell the trumpet fanfare or horn call the music of banquets and courts the singing minstrel performances of gregorian chant and the music that accompanies horse riding knights with each chapter visiting representative films as case studies these six signal musical moments that create a fundamental visual aural core central to making a film feel medieval to modern audiences originate in medievalist works predating cinema by some three centuries

beginning with the era of synchronized sound in the 1920s music has been an integral part of motion pictures whether used to heighten the tension of a scene or evoke a subtle

emotional response scores have played a significant if often unrealized role in the viewer's enjoyment in the invisible art of film music. Laurence Macdonald provides a comprehensive introduction for the general student, film historian, and aspiring cinematographer, arranged chronologically from the silent era to the present day. This volume provides insight into the evolution of music in cinema and analyzes the vital contributions of scores to hundreds of films. Macdonald reviews key developments in film music and discusses many of the most important and influential scores of the last nine decades, including those from modern times: *Gone with the Wind*, *Citizen Kane*, *Laura*, *A Streetcar Named Desire*, *Ben-Hur*, *Lawrence of Arabia*, *The Godfather*, *Jaws*, *Ragtime*, *The Mission*, *Titanic*, *Gladiator*, *The Lord of the Rings*, *Brokeback Mountain*, and *Slumdog Millionaire*. Macdonald also provides biographical sketches of such great composers as Max Steiner, Alfred Newman, Franz Waxman, Bernard Herrmann, Elmer Bernstein, Henry Mancini, Maurice Jarre, John Barry, John Williams, Jerry Goldsmith, Dave Grusin, Ennio Morricone, Randy Newman, Hans Zimmer, and Danny Elfman. Updated and expanded to include scores produced well into the twenty-first century, this new edition of *The Invisible Art of Film Music* will appeal not only to scholars of cinema and musicologists but also any fan of film scores.

Film Music in the Sound Era: A Research and Information Guide offers a comprehensive bibliography of scholarship on music in sound film, 1927–2017. Thematically organized, sections cover historical studies, studies of musicians and filmmakers, genre studies, theory and aesthetics, and other key aspects of film music studies. Volume 1, *Histories, Theories, and Genres*, covers overviews, historical surveys, theory and criticism, studies of film genres, and case studies of individual films. Volume 2, *People, Cultures, and Contexts*, covers individual people, social and cultural studies, studies of musical genre, pedagogy, and the industry. A complete index is included in each volume.

A well-researched and thorough book examining what the author finds to be a unique facet of film music of the late 1940s and early 1950s, *Soundtrax: Lavish Musical Soundtracks*

contributed a special grandeur to the new widescreen stereophonic sound movie experience of postwar biblical epics such as *Samson and Delilah*, *Ben-Hur*, and *Quo Vadis*. In *Epic Sound*, Stephen C. Meyer shows how music was utilized for various effects, sometimes serving as a vehicle for narrative plot and at times complicating biblical and cinematic interpretation. In this way, the soundscapes of these films reflected the ideological and aesthetic tensions within the genre and more generally within postwar American society. By examining key biblical films, Meyer adeptly engages musicology with film studies to explore cinematic interpretations of the Bible during the 1940s through the 1960s, a major contribution to the field of film music studies and ought to be widely read by musicologists with an interest in film. between 1895 and 1929 more than 15 000 motion pictures were made in the united states we call these works silent films but they were accompanied by an enormous body of music including works adapted or arranged from pre existing works as well as newly composed pieces for theater orchestras organists or pianists while many films and pieces are lost a considerable amount of material remains extant and available for use in research and performance music for silent film a guide to north american resources is a unique resource on north american archives and english language materials available in for those interested

in this repertoire part i contains information about archives of primary source materials including full and compiled scores sheet music published anthologies of music interviews with cinema musicians periodicals and instruction books part ii surveys the english language scholarship on silent film music in articles book chapters essay collections and monographs through 2015 the book is fully indexed for ease of access to these important sources on film music

this collection of original essays presents new scholarship on nearly three dozen feature length films including silent films animated films films in black and white and films in technicolor along with other shorter examples of cinematic medievalism written by contributors from around the globe with a wide variety of backgrounds the essays in this volume take a critical approach to one of the most popular forms of medievalism this book presents a full century of cinematic depictions of the middle ages with new examinations of works such as the seventh seal god s fool la passion de jeanne d arc saladin the victorious dante s inferno an animated epic and a knight s tale among others

cinema including elmer bernstein bernard herrmann alfred newman john williams and hans zimmer 100 greatest film scores will be of interest to fans of movie music everywhere

released in 1954 on the waterfront is considered one of the greatest films of all time winning eight academy awards including best picture and placing in the top 20 on the american film institute's 100 films survey the film's oscar nominated score represented a rare venture into film music composition by leonard bernstein one of the towering figures of classical music in the 20th century in leonard bernstein's on the waterfront a film score guide anthony bushard examines this landmark work a score that continues to influence composers of film and classical music alike the book begins with a biographical survey of bernstein's work followed by an exploration of bernstein's compositional method a look at the context of the film and an analysis of the score itself though other volumes have focused on bernstein's overall career bushard's book is the first to look specifically at the score of this film a welcome examination of one of bernstein's most accomplished works leonard bernstein's on the waterfront a film score guide highlights the invaluable contributions of this great composer and will be appreciated by fans of classical music and film scores

only person to be nominated for an academy award in every decade from the 1950s to the 2000s over a career spanning 54 years he composed landmark scores in every available genre epics jazz westerns dramas and comedies and his credits read like list of the greatest films of his time the ten commandments the magnificent seven to kill a mockingbird the man with the golden arm the great escape ghostbusters to name just a few this biography written by elmer s son peter interweaves exclusive interviews oral histories not otherwise available estate archival materials and personal experiences elmer bernstein lived a colorful life he was a first generation american he was blacklisted and he was a fearless advocate for film music not afraid to take on anyone in pages of trade papers the book looks at many of his landmark scores in depth collaborations with various producers and directors and his success in navigating the rough and tumble of hollywood there is much to his story a cycle of struggle success frustration failure and reinvention repeated many times over his career which connected the old hollywood with the modern era

focusing on twenty first century western films including all major releases since the turn of the century the essays in this volume cover a broad range of aesthetic and thematic aspects explored in these films including gender and race as diverse contributors focus on the individual subgenres of the traditional western the gunfighter the cavalry vs native american conflict the role of women in westerns etc they share an understanding of the twenty first century western may be understood as a genre in itself they argue that the films

discussed here reimagine certain aspects of the more conventional western and often reverse the ideology contained within them while employing certain forms and clichés that have become synonymous internationally with westerns the result is a contemporary sensibility that might be referred to as the postmodern western
