this book explores past expressions of the jewish interest in hinduism in order to learn what hinduism has meant to jews living mainly in the 12th through the 19th centuries india and hinduism though never at the center of jewish thought claim a place in its history in the picture jews held of the wider world of other religions and other human beings each chapter focuses on a specific author or text and examines the literary context as well as the cultural context within and outside jewish society that provided images and ideas about india and its religions overall the volume constructs a history of ideas that changed over time with different writers in different settings it will be especially relevant to scholars interested in jewish thought comparative religion interreligious dialogue and intellectual history

the number of paths to the one infinite is necessarily infinite according to hinduism it is this recognition of many paths each valid in itself that gives to hinduism its immense variety hinduism is thus like a huge river with an innumerable tributaries it contains within it the influence of many cultures the culture of the arya dravidian and the tribal peoples the culture of the later invaders the influence of buddhism jainism etc to which hinduism gave birth and of islam and christianity which came from outside can be traced at various stages of the evolution of hindu thought the hindu scheme of life thus leaves a man free to think for himself while providing him with a background in the form of a long tradition hailing from the vedic times many people would prefer to be guided by a flexible schemes of life which hinduism represents than by a seat of rigid unalterable dogmas which lose their importance with the passing of time moreover hinduism is a continuous process and is still in the making

vasubandhu is one of the most prominent figures in the development of mahayana buddhism in india his name can be found in any history of buddhism or of india in the gupta period however hardly any of his works has been translated into english the seven treatises presented here are complete works with a most varied range of topics and serve at least as an introduction to his thought this collection of translations includes the vada vidhi a work on logic the panca skandhaka prakarana which deals with the aggregates making up personality the karmasiddhi prakarana which in explaining psychic continuity also attacks many features of earlier buddhist psychology the famous vimsatika and trimsika which take buddhist psychology into hitherto unexplored areas the madhyanta vibhaga bhasya one of the most profound books for mahayana realization and the tri svabhava nirdesa which shows a way for ridding consciousness of ensnaring mental constructions a glossary of key words is included as are the texts of those works which survive in sanskrit each translation is prefaced by an explanatory introduction and is followed by notes these include also references to other indian philosophical systems and occasional comparisons with modern western psychological systems particularly where the latter seem inadequate in comparison with vasubandhu s yogacara
