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fictional war narratives often employ haunted battlefields super soldiers time travel the undead and other imaginative elements of science fiction and fantasy this encyclopedia catalogs appearances of the strange and the supernatural found in the war stories of film television novels short stories pulp fiction comic books and video and role playing games categories explore themes of mythology science fiction alternative history superheroes and weird war

the final volume of the pirate histories of doctor who this chronicle brings us up to the modern era with explorations of doctor who animation from short fan films of the 1970s to the modern bbc re animations of

in 1881 a weary doctor wounded while serving in the military in afghanistan returned to london only to be introduced to a most unusual young man who was already making a name for himself as the world's first consulting detective at that time the young man and his unique colleague were only just in their late twenties unaware of their legendary futures but they would go on to become two of the most famous and recognizable figures in the world sherlock holmes and dr john h watson in 1887 holmes and watson's first investigation as a team a study in scarlet was published the sign of four followed in 1890 and then in 1891 the world was electrified with the publication of the adventures of sherlock holmes in the newly formed strand magazine and the world would never be the same through the remainder of the nineteenth century and all the way through the twentieth holmes and watson's fame would grow we're now well into the twenty first century yet the much loved duo are just as popular today if not even more so in 2015 the mx book of new sherlock holmes stories burst upon the scene featuring stories set within the canon's correct time period written by the very best of today's sherlockian authors from around the world that first anthology spread over three huge volumes contained sixty three stories and was the largest collection of its kind assembled at the time response was immediately and overwhelmingly positive and soon there were calls from fans for additional collections over 150 contributors so far have joined together from around the world to produce well over three hundred new adventures to honour sherlock holmes the man described by watson as the best and wisest whom i have ever known we now proudly present parts xiii xiv and xv three volumes which break the record of the initial triple offering with an incredible sixty six new adventures featuring the eternal duo watson and holmes part xiii in the popular mx series of new sherlock holmes stories features contributions from derrick belanger mark mower brenda seabrook david marcum robert stapleton s f bennett edwin a enstrom m j h simmonds andrew bryant tim gambrell tracy revels hugh ashton sean m wright marino c alvarez paul hiscock arthur hall kevin p thornton stephen seitz jim french david friend shane simmons peter coe verbica and mark wardecker with a poem by jacquelynn morris and forewords by will thomas roger johnson melissa grigsby steve emecz and david marcum

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when sydney newman conceived the idea for doctor who in 1963 he envisioned a show in which the doctor and his companions would visit and observe but not interfere with events in history that plan was dropped early on and the doctor has happily meddled with historical events for decades this collection of new essays examines how the doctor s engagement with history relates to britain s colonial past nostalgia for village life norse myths alternate history and the impact of historical decisions on the present

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64 new traditional holmes adventures in three simultaneously published volumes in 2018 mx publishing presented parts xi and xii of this acclaimed and ongoing series some untold cases now that theme is revisited with 64 new sherlock holmes adventures that explore those many tantalizing references to some of holmes's other cases as mentioned in the canon somewhere in the vaults of the bank of cox and co at charing cross there is a travel worn and battered tin dispatch box with my name john h watson m d late indian army painted upon the lid it is crammed with papers nearly all of which are records of cases to illustrate the curious problems which mr sherlock holmes had at various times to examine dr john h watson so wrote dr watson in the problem of thor bridge and ever since sherlockians have been seeking to know more about these tales

from the legendary tin dispatch box while watson's original literary agent only edited the pitifully few sixty stories that make up the original canon there have since been literally thousands of traditional adventures about the true sherlock holmes and yet there will never be enough throughout the original holmes canon there were hints and teases of other intriguing cases the giant rat of sumatra the abernethy tragedy the manor house case watson mentions well over one hundred of these which have collectively come to be known as the untold cases now once again mx publishing brings us sixty four of these adventures in three simultaneously published volumes with all royalties going to support the stepping stones school at undershaw one of sir arthur conan doyle's former homes join us as we return to baker street and discover more authentic adventures of sherlock holmes described by the estimable dr watson as the best and wisest whom i have ever known each volume contains forwards by otto penzler roger johnson stepping stones school steve emecz and david marcum as well as stories by the following contributors will murray 2 stories tim gambrell 2 stories craig janacek i a watson jane rubino paul hiscock hugh ashton mike chinn shane simmons dacre stoker and leverett butts david marcum matthew j elliot paul d gilbert tracy j revels margaret walsh arthur hall barry clay steven philip jones jan van koningsveld and marcia wilson and a poem by john linwood grant

since its inception in november 1963 the british science fiction television series doctor who has exerted an enormous impact on the world of science fiction over 1 500 books have been written about the show the series follows the adventures of a mysterious time lord from the distant planet gallifrey who travels through time and space to fight evil and injustice along the way he has visited rome under the rule of nero played backgammon with kublai khan and participated in the mythic gunfight at the o k corral predating the star trek phenomenon by three years doctor who seriously dealt with continuing characters adult genre principles and futuristic philosophies critical and historical examinations of the ideas philosophies conceits and morals put forth in the doctor who series which ran for 26 seasons and 159 episodes are provided here also analyzed are thematic concepts genre antecedents the overall cinematography and the special effects of the long running cult favorite the various incarnations of doctor who including television stage film radio and spin offs are discussed in addition the book provides an extensive listing of print internet and fan club resources for doctor who

the tardis lands the doctor and martha in the lake district in 1909 where a small village has been terrorised by a giant scaly monster the search is on for the elusive beast of westmorland and explorers naturalists and hunters from across the country are descending on the fells king edward vii himself is on his way to join the search with a knighthood for whoever finds the beast but there is a more sinister presence at work in the lakes than a mere monster on the rampage and the doctor is soon embroiled in the plans of an old and terrifying enemy and as the hunters become the hunted a desperate battle of wits begins with the future of the entire world at stake an adventure featuring the tenth doctor as played by david tennant and his companion martha

with the doctor wanting to repair the tardis in peace and quiet barbara ian and susan decide to get some experience of living in the nearby village of salem but the doctor knows about the horrors destined to engulf the village and determines that they should leave his friends are not impressed his granddaughter susan has her own ideas and is desperate to return whatever the cost but perhaps the doctor was right perhaps susan's actions will lead them all into terrible danger and cause the tragedy that is already unfolding to escalate out of control an adventure set in the 17th century salem witch trials featuring the first doctor as played by william hartnell and his companions susan ian and barbara

premiering the day after the jfk assassination doctor who humbly launched one of the entertainment world's first super brands we begin with a look at tv programming of the day and the original pitch documents before delving into the daleks which almost didn't make the cut but inspired many monsters to follow after three years first doctor william hartnell left prompting the bbc to recast their hit rather than end it giving us the first regeneration and making tv history we follow the succession of doctors including third doctor jon pertwee exiled to earth and targeted by the master and see how the program reflected the feminism of the 1970s while gaining mainstream popularity with fourth doctor tom baker until declining support from the

bbc eventually led to cancelation fan outcry saved the series only for it to suffer a repeat cancelation yet many continued to enjoy the whoniverse in syndication novels audio dramas and doctor who magazine paul mcgann impressed many as the eighth doctor in a 1996 tv movie but it failed to reignite the series a new age dawned in 2005 with ninth doctor christopher eccleston and a serious special effects budget before tenth doctor david tennant helped rocket the series to international popularity and a new era of spinoffs with eleventh doctor matt smith the show became a bona fide success here in america following the program s fiftieth anniversary whovians will meet the twelfth doctor ushering in yet another era for the unstoppable time lord featuring discussions of concepts and characters with insights from producers writers and actors from across the years here is a rich behind the camera investigation into the dazzling multiverse of doctor who
