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from a master of historical fiction the story of john wesley powell s perilous river journey through the grand canyon in 1869 is a great american adventure 352 pp

scotty s family owns a lodge near their silver mine in the colorado rockies summers at the lodge are idyllic for scotty and his cousin mickey the grown ups are dealing with the complications of business and adult dysfunction but the boys are more interested in the complications of puberty especially when rosalind the teenage daughter of family friends is

on hand to read this quiet rich evocation of adolescent watchfulness is to experience what it is like to be fourteen years old waiting for something to happen aware of everything but oblivious to as much of it as possible readers will be reminded of such modern masters as william maxwell and john updike

in revoyr s best novel to date four backpackers in the sierra nevada find more adventure than they ever imagined one of the san francisco chronicle s 100 recommended books of 2015 los angeles is home to many great storytellers but nina revoyr is one of its finest scribes lost canyon pulses with both beauty and terror and the struggles of these characters their physical and mental reckonings are enough to make readers sweat without getting off the couch los angeles times what makes this latest from revoyr the age of dreaming more than a suspenseful tale of survival and personal growth is the slowly worked out differences of race and class well articulated throughout an absorbing read with good social context library journal four people on a backpacking trip in the sierra nevada find more adventure than they ever imagined they are drawn to the mountains for reasons as diverse as their own lives gwen foster a counselor for at risk youth is struggling with burnout from the demands of her job and with the loss of one of her teens real estate agent oscar barajas is adjusting to the fall of the housing market and being a single parent todd harris an attorney is stuck in a lucrative but unfulfilling career and in a failing marriage they are all brought together by their trainer tracy cole a former athlete with a taste for risky pursuits when the hikers start up a pristine mountain trail that hasn t been traveled in years all they have to guide them is a hand drawn map of a remote mysterious place called lost canyon at first the route past high alpine lakes and under towering snowcapped peaks offers all the freedom and exhilaration they d hoped for but when they stumble onto someone who doesn t want to be found the group finds itself faced with a series of dangerous conflicts moral dilemmas confrontations with nature and an all out struggle for survival moving effortlessly between city and wilderness lost canyon explores the ways that race class and culture shape experience and perception it examines the choices good people must face in desperate situations set in the grand wild landscape of california s mountains lost canyon is a story of brewing social tensions and breathtaking adventure that will keep readers on the edge of their seats

western fans today may not recognize the name ernest haycox 1899 1950 but they know his work john ford turned one of his stories into the iconic film stagecoach and the whole western literary genre still follows conventions that haycox deftly mastered and reshaped in this new book about haycox's literary career richard w etulain tells the engrossing story of his rise through the ranks of popular magazine and serial fiction to become one of the western's most successful creators after graduating from the university of oregon in 1923 with a degree in journalism haycox began his quest to break into new york's pulp magazine scene submitting dozens of stories before he began to make a living from his writing by the end of the 1920s he had become a top writer for western story short stories and adventure among other popular weeklies and monthlies ernest haycox and the western traces haycox's path from rank beginner to crack pulp writer to regular contributor to collier's and the saturday evening post etulain shows how haycox experimented with techniques to deepen and broaden his westerns creating more introspective protagonists hamlet heroes introducing new types of heroines the brunette vixen the blonde puritan and weaving greater historical realism into his plots after reaching the height of success with his best selling custer novel bugles in the afternoon 1944 haycox moved away from the financially rewarding but artistically constricting western formula only to achieve his final coup with the earthbreakers a historical novel about the end of the oregon trail published posthumously in

1952 reconstructing the career of a popular literary giant ernest haycox and the western restores haycox to his rightful place in the history of western literature

regarded by many fans as one of zane grey s most powerful novels the call of the canyon is filled to the brim with adventure and romance in the novel grey draws a sharp contrast between the decadent decline his protagonist sees in the cities of the east coast and the hardworking pioneers forging new opportunities in the west

carley burch leaves her high society life in new york city to reclaim her fianci glen kilbourne who had moved to the wild west to recover from world war i she braves fierce ruffians brutal elements and lack of civilization carley must adapt to the rigorous life of the west but will she be able to convince glenn to return to his home in new york will she be in time before a rival temptress steals glenn away

the only novel by an author of recognized standing that stages its crucial scenes in the grand canyon of the colorado from the slums of new york to the canyon country to washington s high politics and back to the canyon the action shifts rapidly there s a he man for hero comparable to still jim who suggests roosevelt in his fearless handling of big problems a beautiful desert heroine an inimitable negro servant and other flesh and blood men and women the blending of adventure romance and humor against the superb background of the western out doors makes an utterly satisfying story

post apocalyptic society he knows that to survive he must abandon his morals and conscience and become like those surrounding him but when he meets thais morals and conscience win over conformity and he risks his rank and life to help her they escape the city and set out together on a long dangerous journey to find safety in shreveport louisiana struggling to survive in a world without electricity food shelter and clean water atticus and thais shed their fear of growing too close and they fall hopelessly in love but can love survive in such dark times or is it fated to die with them

hatchet meets long way down in this heartfelt and gripping novel in verse about a young girl s struggle for survival after a climbing trip with her father goes terribly wrong one year after a random shooting changed their family forever nora and her father are exploring a slot canyon deep in the arizona desert hoping it will help them find peace nora longs for things to go back to normal like they were when her mother was still alive while her father keeps them isolated in fear of other people but when they reach the bottom of the canyon the unthinkable happens a flash flood rips across their path sweeping away nora s father and all of their supplies suddenly nora finds herself lost and alone in the desert facing dehydration deadly snakes venomous scorpions and worst of all the beast who has terrorized her dreams for the past year if nora is going to save herself and her father she must conquer her fears defeat the beast and find the courage to live her new life don t miss dusti bowling s new novel dust available for preorder now
