steven kettell analyzes the development of exchange rate policymaking from a marxist perspective he examines and provides a new means of understanding three key policymaking episodes in britain the return to the gold standard in 1925 membership of the european exchange rate mechanism from 1990 1992 and the possibility of joining the single european currency the alternative means of understanding these policy episodes provides a basis for making wider generalizations about the political economy of exchange rate policymaking

this book revisits and re defines the policy style concept and explores the long standing debate in british political science concerning how best to characterise the british policy style the book highlights several trends that suggest that the british policy style has shifted towards the impositional end of the policy style spectrum bringing it more in line with the traditional westminster model of governing however these changes also reflect a more frenetic policy style which might increase the number of policy blunders and failures in british government unless means are found to access and manage the specialist expertise that interest groups possess

this book explores how the policy making process is changing in the very volatile conditions of present day mainland china taiwan and hong kong it considers the overall background conditions the need to rebalance in mainland china after years of hectic economic growth governance transition and democratic consolidation in taiwan and governance crisis in hong kong under a regime of uncertain legitimacy it examines the various actors in the policy making process the civic engagement of ordinary people and the roles of legislators mass media and bureaucracy and discusses how these actors interact in a range of different policy cases throughout the book contrasts the different approaches in the three different jurisdictions and assesses how the policy making process is changing and how it is likely to change further

this book takes stock of learning theories in the european union eu integration literature and

assesses what insights the concept of learning has added to our understanding of the European integration processes given the European integration dynamics since 2000 including enlargement and new governance approaches and instruments learning and learning related theories have gained major EU significance the book addresses the less noticed micro level patterns of behavioural change that deserve more visibility in the EU's theoretical toolbox it focuses on the conditions under which EU actors in various decision making processes learn or do not learn in asking this question it raises issues about the EU's nature do the EU conditions that favour learning outweigh the EU conditions that inhibit learning is the EU system too complex for learning processes to have a discernible concrete impact to assess the degree that the EU system and its member states learn the authors selected for this volume are all explicitly comparative in their approach and have been encouraged to look at differences across political systems in doing so the authors study how EU member states EU institutions and other groups and organisations pursue learning across the multi level EU policy process this book was previously published as a special issue of *Journal of European Public Policy*

leading political scientists analyze how Congress tackles and fails to tackle national challenges from health care to immigration

this study examines the preliminary impacts of Indonesia's decentralization process on the administration and management of forest resources in Ketapang District West Kalimantan the case study is based on field work carried out in mid 2000 using a rapid appraisal methodology the report covers the impacts of decentralization in three areas in particular customary adat communities oil palm and rubber plantations and conservation issues related to Gunung Palang National Park in each of these areas the authors examine struggles among competing interest groups that have arisen under decentralization the study finds that with the shift of administrative authority to the district level the district government in Ketapang took measures to generate local sources of revenues by issuing large numbers of small scale timber extraction permits and to legalize the transport of timber that had otherwise been harvested illegally the study also finds that the very limited flow of formal revenues from the Gunung Palang National Park to the district government has encouraged an escalation of illegal logging within the park's boundaries it is recommended that the Ketapang district government become more involved in administering the national park to ensure that economic interests of both the district government and local communities are accommodated in the park's management

public health policies had a profound impact on urban life in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries yet relatively few people took an active interest in the formulation of these policies in this book marjaana niemi examines the impact of different political aims and pressures on scientific health policies through the analysis of public health programmes in two case studies one in birmingham and the other in gothenburg by examining early twentieth century campaigns concerned with infant welfare and the prevention of tuberculosis the book provides illuminating insights into the relationship between public health and the regulation of urban life not only does the book analyse the processes whereby different political aims became embedded in these apolitical health campaigns but it also highlights the important part that the campaigns played in urban politics and governance the political aims which public health campaigns advanced are explored by comparing health policies in britain and sweden where officials were part of one public health community enjoying close links attending the same conferences and contributing to the same journals the problems they dealt with were often similar and in both countries health authorities claimed scientific grounds for their programmes yet the policies they pursued were often strikingly different through examination of two different national approaches the book does justice to the full complexity of the policy making process and illuminates the wide range of factors that affected municipal policies

although the kyoto protocol an international agreement to address global climate change has been regarded by many as an unsuccessful treaty both politically and environmentally it stands as one of the world's few truly global agreements why did such a diverse group of countries decide to sign and or ratify the treaty why did they choose to do so at different times and in different ways what explains their foreign policy behavior amy below's book builds off the increasing significance of climate change and uses the kyoto protocol as a case study to analyze foreign policy decision making in latin america below's study takes a regional perspective in order to examine why countries in latin america made disparate foreign policy choices when they were faced with the same decision the book looks at the decisions in argentina mexico and venezuela via a process tracing method below uses information obtained from primary and secondary documents and elite interviews to help reconstruct the processes and augments her reconstruction with a content analysis of conference of the parties speeches by presidents and country delegates the book complies with convention in the field by arguing that systemic national and individual level factors simultaneously impact foreign policy decisions but makes the additional claim that role theory most accurately accounts for relationships between variables environmental politics and foreign policy decision making in latin america considers a variety of factors on individual national and international levels of analysis and show that the foreign policy decisions are best viewed through the prism of role theory the book also draws conclusions about the value of role theory in general and about environmental foreign policy decisions

handbook of decision making includes the wisdom of the long theological and philosophical traditions of human society as well as a systematic exploration of the implications of contemporary evolutionary theories common patterns in decision making styles are identified as well as the common variations that different contexts may generate the text covers the multiplicity of mainstream decision making styles such as cost benefit analysis and linear programming it also explains alternative and emerging methods such as geographic information systems q methodology and narrative policy analysis practical applications are discussed using decision making practices in budgeting public administration and governance drug trafficking and information systems

there are two dominant approaches to political decision making in general and foreign policy decision making in particular rational choice and cognitive psychology the essays here introduce and test the poliheuristic theory of decision making that integrates elements of both schools the poliheuristic theory is able to account for the outcome and the process of decisions and integrates across levels of analysis individual dyad and group the collection focuses on both elements of the theory itself and also looks at how the theory can be used to better understand political decisions that were made in the past

a comprehensive reference work which provides a way to access research on urban politics and policy in the united states experts in the field guide readers through major controversies while evaluating and assessing the subfields of urban politics and policy each chapter follows the same basic organization with topics such as methodological and theoretical issues current states of the field and directions for future research for students this work provides a starting place to guide them to the most important works in a particular subfield and a context to place their work in a larger body of knowledge for scholars it serves as a reference work for immediately familiarity with subfields of the discipline including classic studies and major research questions for urban policymakers or analysts the handbook provides a wealth of information and allows quick identification of existing academic knowledge and research relevant to the problem at hand

this book aims at gauging whether the nature of us foreign policy decision making has changed after the cold war as radically as a large body of literature seems to suggest and develops a new framework to interpret presidential decision making in foreign policy it locates the study of risk in us foreign policy in a wider intellectual landscape that draws on contemporary debates in historiography international relations and presidential studies

based on developments in the health and environment literature the book identifies the president as the ultimate risk manager demonstrating how a president is called to perform a delicate balancing act between risks on the domestic political side and risks on the strategic international side every decision represents a risk vs risk trade off in which the management of one target risk leads to the development countervailing risks the book applies this framework to the study three major crises in us foreign policy the cuban missile crisis the seizure of the us embassy in tehran in 1979 and the massacre at srebrenica in 1995 each case study results from substantial archival research and over twenty interviews with policymakers and academics including former president jimmy carter and former senator bob dole this book is ideal for postgraduate researchers and academics in us foreign policy foreign policy decision making and the us presidency as well as departments and institutes dealing with the study of risk in the social sciences the case studies will also be of great use to undergraduate students
