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this classic 1938 mystery could only have come from the fevered imagination of harry stephen keeler behind that mask is a direct sequel to his 1932 novel finger finger and although it concludes successfully the story begun in volume one readers should definitely have finished finger finger before starting this one you have been warned

from the reviews this huge book written in several years by one of the few mathematicians able to do it appears as a precise and impressive study not very easy to read of this bothsided question that replaces in a coherent way without being encyclopaedic a large library of books and papers scattered without a uniform language instead of summarizing the author gives his own way of exposition with original complements this requires no preliminary knowledge the purpose which the author explains in his introduction i e a deep probabilistic interpretation of potential theory and a link between two great theories appears fulfilled in a masterly manner m breLOT in metriKA 1986

the book is devoted to studies of quasi stationary phenomena in nonlinearly perturbed stochastic systems new methods of asymptotic analysis for nonlinearly perturbed stochastic processes based on new types of asymptotic expansions for perturbed renewal equation and recurrence algorithms for construction of asymptotic expansions for markov type processes with absorption are presented asymptotic expansions are given in mixed ergodic for processes and large deviation theorems for absorption times for nonlinearly perturbed regenerative processes semi markov processes and markov chains applications to analysis of quasi stationary phenomena in nonlinearly perturbed queueing systems population dynamics and epidemic models and for risk processes are presented the book also contains an extended bibliography of works in the area it is an essential reference for theoretical and applied researchers in the field of stochastic processes and their applications and may be also useful for doctoral and advanced undergraduate students

the most interesting part of china from a geographical and ethnological point of view is the westgeographically because its recesses have not yet been thoroughly explored and ethnologically because a great part of it is peopled by races which are non chinese and one at least of which though nominally owing allegiance to the great khan is in reality independent it was my fortune to be stationed in western china from 1882 to 1884 and during these three years i was enabled in the performance of my duties to collect information regarding the country and its people and it is in the hope that this information may not be unacceptable that i venture to lay the following pages before the public reports of the journeys which i made in western china during the above years have already appeared in the shape of parliamentary papers but written as they were without any idea of publication and intended as mere trade notes strung together from day to day on the march they are not sufficiently connected to present a fair picture of this remote region that part of western china with which i am personally acquainted and with which i propose to deal lies to the south and embraces the provinces of ssu chuan kuei chow and yun nan which interesting in themselves have become of considerable importance since the extension of the indian empire to the frontier of china and the absorption of tonquin by the french the way thither the great highway to the west is the river yang tsze by the agreement of chefoo of september 1876 the port of ichang situated on the north bank of the yang tsze about a thousand miles from the sea was opened to foreign trade and foreign steam navigation and by the same agreement the residence of a consular officer at the city of chung king in ssu chuan to watch the conditions of british trade was provided for it was to take up this post that i left wuhu towards the end of october 1881 on arrival at hankow i discovered that the steamer which had for some years been employed to run to ichang was undergoing extensive repairs at shanghai to better fit her for the navigation of the upper yang tsze and that another and larger steamer belonging to the same company had just returned from ichang with little hope owing to the sudden fall of the river of being then able to make another trip a large quantity of cargo however which had accumulated at hankow induced the company much against the captains will to send the steamer forward again but drawing only nine feet she was unable after a days journey to push her way through six feet of sand and water and had to return after about a months delay the smaller steamer arrived at hankow and laden to six feet reached ichang with considerable difficulty on the 17th of december the trip having occupied eight days on this section of the river navigation commences at daybreak and unless there is good moonlight ceases at dark owing to the shifting sands which constitute the bed of the river the channel is constantly changing and it is not uncommon to find the passage which the steamer took on the up passage completely barred on the

down trip the consequence is that soundings have constantly to be taken and delay is the result this refers to the winter months only when the river is low as during high water little difficulty exists and the distance has been covered in fifty hours the selection of ichang as an open port has frequently been called in question and it has been pointed out that sha shih a town farther down the river and one of the six calling stations for steamers would have been a preferable choice much may be said for sha shih which is the principal terminus of the junk traffic between ssu chuan and the eastern provinces of china but statistics clearly prove that ichang has after all been a success

this is a serious book examining the original sounds and meanings of languages right back to the stone age up until now believed to be impossible but it can also be seen as tracing the overwhelming sexual orientation of human thinking for the last six hundred thousand years or more when we were only hominids squatting round the camp fires at the mouths of our caves to keep the sabre toothed tigers out it was here that our original bare bottomed language committees first got to grips with meanings and their audible representation the committees were convened as a result of the taming of fire the high tech of the day it was a cosy environment in a cold and hostile world and the unaccustomed warmth led to an outburst of amorous inclinations and the need to express them in words ka they thought echoic of the strike of flint on flint and so striking and so the tenderising of raw meat for which they had already been making quote hand axes quote for at least half a million years it is from ka ka for tenderising with a hand axe that our cooking comes the flame did it for you flint knapping left a lot of quote debetage quote or waste flakes whence ka ka also came to mean waste including today human waste metaphor led to odd bedfellows all this evidence is decoded from an exhaustive forty year research into over a hundred languages many of them dead ones where like flies in amber our original lithic stone age language roots are still embedded there is nothing salacious in the tale it simply tells it as it is and was and it is not going to go away this short version is abstracted from a major work of over 600 pages and there is nothing in it which the ordinary man in the street and his sister can not easily follow it ranks quite highly in the order of useless information but it has its indirect usage if you understand how all our languages have actually come about the product of human whimsy you will be that much less likely to believe some of the sillier alternative views put forward by ideologically inclined placemen lastly how has lithic language been cracked the answer lies in quote semantic triangulation quote believe it or not all our languages today over 6000 bear traces of the original meanings given to the sounds as we first learned to articulate them and it is possible to work backwards using the current meanings in numerous languages to home in on the original source meanings which are

common to the current ones then we can see if they make sense as a first guess by our stone age hominid forebears of what they thought of as the quote natural quote meanings of the sounds they didn't do thinking very much that is how they all guessed the same or nearly the same so we are probably on the right track language was all spun by human whimsy over a few hundred millennia from only a baker's dozen original articulated sounds the english language alone reached a million words last year

this is the first of two volumes of research on discourse particles focusing exclusively on the languages of asia from the perspective of formal as well as non formal semantics and pragmatics within linguistics there has been a great deal of interest in discourse particles especially within semantics and pragmatics the term discourse particles has been used to cover a broad range of phenomena including such things as sentence final particles discourse adverbs and other related phenomena however most research in the area particularly within formal semantics and pragmatics focuses on a restricted set of languages and there is little consensus on the proper formal treatment of particles partly due to the limited range of data available in recent years there has been extensive development of the formal approach to discourse particles which often treats these words as devices for marking information updates it is also vital to extend this data to non western languages like japanese korean or chinese this edited volume includes chapters on japanese mandarin tagalog kinaragang Dusun Malay Singlish Thai and Vietnamese the chapters are informed by recent theoretical work in formal semantics and pragmatics relating to the meaning of particles the collection contributes to our theoretical understanding of the meaning of discourse particles and to empirical knowledge of discourse particles in the languages of asia it will be of interest to postgraduate students and scholars of semantics and pragmatics

a long time ago i started writing a book about markov chains brownian motion and diffusion i soon had two hundred pages of manuscript and my publisher was enthusiastic some years and several drafts later i had a thousand pages of manuscript and my publisher was less enthusiastic so we made it a trilogy markov chains brownian motion and diffusion approximating countable markov chains familiarly me b d and acm i wrote the first two books for beginning graduate students with some knowledge of probability if you can follow sections 3.4 to 3.9 of brownian motion and diffusion you're in the first two books are quite independent of one another and completely independent of the third this last book is a monograph which explains one way to think about chains with instantaneous states the results in it are supposed to be

new except where there are specific disclaimers it is written in the framework of markov chains most of the proofs in the trilogy are new and i tried hard to make them explicit the old ones were often elegant but i seldom saw what made them go with my own i can sometimes show you why things work and as i will argue in a minute my demonstrations are easier technically if i wrote them down well enough you may come to agree
