with this volume jane chance concludes her monumental study of the history of mythography in medieval literature her focus here is the advent of hybrid mythography the transformation of mythological commentary by blending the scholarly with the courtly and the personal chance s in depth examination of works by the major writers of the period including dante boccaccio and christine de pizan demonstrates how they essentially co opted a thousand year tradition their intricate narratives of identity mixed

commentary with poetry reinterpreted classical gods and heroes to suit personal agendas and gave rise to innovative techniques such as inglossation the use of a mythological figure to comment on the protagonist within an autobiographical allegory in this manner through allegorical authorial projection of the self the poets explored a subjective world and manifested a burgeoning humanism that would eventually come to full fruition in the renaissance no other work examines the mythographic interrelationships between these poets and their unique and personal approaches to mythological commentary

where theory and practice meet is a collection of nineteen papers in translation studies unlike many similar books published in recent decades which are mostly non translation oriented veering to issues with little or no relevance to translation this book focuses on the translation process on theory formulation with reference to actual translation on getting to grips with translation problems and on explaining translation in language which can be understood by the general reader perceptive and wide ranging the book covers language pairs that include chinese english french german italian spanish latin and classical greek and discusses among other things translations of dante s la divina commedia translations of shakespeare s hamlet goethe s prometheus as a case of untranslatability the challenge of translating garcilaso de la vega s primera gloga into chinese john minford s translation of martial arts fiction and lin shu s translation of alexandre dumas s la dame aux camélias

an eclectic history of human curiosity a great feast of ideas and a memoir of a reading life from an internationally celebrated reader and thinker curiosity has been seen through the ages as the impulse that drives our knowledge forward and the temptation that leads us toward dangerous and forbidden waters the question why has appeared under a multiplicity of guises and in vastly different contexts throughout the chapters of human history why does evil exist what is beauty how does language inform us what defines our identity what is our responsibility to the world in alberto manguel s most personal book to date the author tracks his own life of curiosity through the reading that has mapped his way manguel chooses as his guides a selection of writers who sparked his imagination he dedicates each chapter to a single thinker scientist artist or other figure who demonstrated in a fresh way how to ask why leading us through a full gallery of inquisitives among them thomas aquinas david hume lewis carroll rachel carson socrates and most importantly dante manguel affirms how deeply connected our curiosity is to the readings that most astonish us and

the essays collected here join in and contribute to the current reflection on dante s vitality today in a critical multidisciplinary vein their intervention comes at a particularly sensitive juncture in the history of dante s global reception and cultural reuse dante today is as alive as ever a cultural icon no less than a cultural product dante s imaginative universe enjoys a pervasive presence in popular culture the multiformity of approaches represented in the collection matches the variety of the material that is analyzed the volume documents dante s presence in genres as different as graphic novels and theater productions children s literature advertisements and sci fi narratives rock and rap music video and boardgames satirical vignettes and political speeches school curricula and prison teaching initiatives each chapter combines a focused attention to the specificity of the body of evidence it treats with best analytical practices the volume invites collective reflection on the many different rules of engagement with dante s text

opens the field of dante studies to further transnational studies of the divine comedy s circulation translation and global influence this fascinating book examines how dante was repurposed by argentine politicians and authors who were concerned with the construction of argentine national identity in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries sottong s work is informed by the theories of eric hobsbawm benedict anderson and nicolas shumway who coined the concepts of invented traditions imagined communities and guiding fictions respectively sottong has applied these notions to the case of argentina which after the war of independence from spain 1810 1818 had to develop its own national cultural identity in this volume she investigates dante s transnational influence in argentina why did argentine authors consistently call upon dante in their attempts to develop argentine literature what are the textual and thematic characteristics of dante s divine comedy that make it an ideal vehicle for literary appropriation what are the historical and cultural factors that account for dante s enduring popularity in italy and beyond how did the strong presence of italians in argentina influence cultural production in the developing nation and how are the re writings of dante in the argentine canon in dialogue with one another what sottong found remarkably was that rewriting dante was a way for argentine authors to voice their views on the direction that should be taken to develop argentine letters dante became something of a literary guide as argentine intellectuals navigated the complex labyrinth of their national identity the consistent rewriting of the divine comedy in the argentine context testifies to the fact that great works of literature can be revived during different periods and even reappropriated by various peoples to foster mythologies of inclusion or exclusion related to national identity

this book contributes to the literature on organized crime by providing a detailed account of the various nuances of what happens when criminal organizations misuse or penetrate legitimate businesses it advances the existing scholarship on attacks infiltration and capture of legal businesses by organized crime and sheds light on the important role the private sector can play to fight back it considers a range of industries from bars and restaurants to labour intensive enterprises such as construction and waste management to sectors susceptible to illicit activities including transportation wholesale and retail trade and businesses controlled by fragmented legislation such as gambling organized criminal groups capitalize on legitimate businesses beleaguered by economic downturns government regulations natural disasters societal conflict and the covid 19 pandemic to survive some private companies have even become the willing partners of criminal organizations thus the relationships between licit businesses and organized crime are highly varied and can range from victimization of businesses to willing collusion and even exploitation of organized crime by the private sector albeit with arrangements that typically allow plausible deniability in other words these relationships are highly diverse and create a complex reality which is the focus of the articles presented here this book will appeal to students academics and policy practitioners with an interest in organized crime it will also provide important supplementary reading for undergraduate and graduate courses on topics such as transnational security issues transnational organized crime international criminal justice criminal finance non state actors international affairs comparative politics and economics and business courses

originally published in 1975 the writer as liar examines the literary game of falsehood as it is portrayed in the decameron the book examines how boccaccio s collection of tales has a frame story its own built in key to the art of story telling its internal logic of truth and falsehood as well as its moments of self parody pure narrative intrigue and sophisticated sexual symbolism the book formulates the argument that boccaccio s story telling is seen as an artfully malicious operation depending for its success not on some abstract concept of narrative originality or the accurate depiction of human psychology but on the combinative assemblage of narrative blocks which are manipulated by a craftsman who must lie and cheat with raw material in order to produce a living work therefore depicting the artist as a liar

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
