workers of america upwa roger horowitz emphasizes local leaders and meatpacking workers in chicago kansas city sioux city and austin minnesota and closely examines the unionizing of the workplace and the prominent role of black workers and women in upwa in clear anecdotal style horowitz shows how three major firms in u s meat production and distribution became dominant by virtually eliminating union power the union s decline he argues reflected massive pressure by capital for lower labor costs and greater control over the work process in the end the victorious firms were those that had been most successful at increasing the rate of exploitation of their workers who now labor in conditions as bad as those of a century ago the definitive study of unionism in the meatpacking industry for the period since the 1920 s james r barrett author of work and community in the jungle chicago s packinghouse workers 1894 1922 a volume in the series the working class in american history edited by david brody alice kessler harris david montgomery and sean wilentz supported by the illinois labor history society

pamela nadell s biographical dictionary and sourcebook is a landmark contribution to american jewish and religious history for the first time a great american jewish religious movement is portrayed with amplitude authority and personality in the most revolutionary era in two millenia of jewish history this surely is an important volumn mores rischin professor of history san francisco state university conservative judaism in america a biographical dictionary and sourcebook is the first extensive effort to document the lives and careers of the most important leaders in conservatism s first century and to provide a brief history of the movement and its central institutions it includes essays on the history of the movement and on the evolution of its major institutions the jewish theological seminary of america the rabbinical assembly and the united synagogue of america it also contains 135 biographical entries on the leading figures of conservative judaism appendices and a complete bibliography on sources of study

the book addresses the complex relationships among learning education and the community it examines the significance of the community for the individual s development and the potential that learning and education have for the development of the community the volume gathers together the findings of a number of quantitative and qualitative studies conducted on different samples theoretical discussions set in

comparative international contexts although the studies employ slovenian samples and analyse situations in this country the contributions address issues that are of concern to the global research community moreover they respond to international debates and engage in the dialogue between the local partial and the global universal the book is unique in its embeddedness in the intellectual continental european tradition that has been characterised by the failed historical experience of attempting collective unity through the community understood as a common identity in former yugoslavia

while the massive flow of immigrants to the northeast was taking place a number of jews were finding their way to america through the port of galveston texas the descendants of these immigrants now scattered throughout the united states are hardly aware that their ancestors participated in a unique attempt to organize and channel jewish immigration from their recruitment in eastern europe to their settlement in the american west these immigrants were supervised by a network of agents and representatives the project known as the galveston movement brought over ten thousand jews to the united states between the years 1907 and 1914 in galveston ellis island of the west a thorough

analysis of the various problems promotional organizational political ideological and financial besetting the galveston movement and of the movement's attempts to solve these problems serves as the basis for an important case study of an experiment at channeling immigration accounts of individual immigrants told in their own words or in the words of those who welcomed them provide fascinating glimpses into a story which well deserves to be told

the first substantial history of the jews in the industrial south this is the first substantial history of the jews in any inland town or city of the industrial south the author starts with the reconstruction period when the community was established and he carries the story down into the 1970's first there were the germans the pioneers who built the community then came the east european emigres who had to cope not only with the problem of survival but the disdain if not the hostility of the already acculturated central european settlers who had forgotten their own humble beginnings after world war i came the fusion of the two groups and the need to cooperate religiously and to integrate their cultural social and philanthropic institutions binding them together and speeding the rise of a total jewish community was the ever present fear of anti jewish prejudice and the peculiar problem a real one of steering a course between the christian whites and the christian blacks

lodge and other boston brahmins launched their anti immigrant campaign in 1921 vice president calvin coolidge declared that biological laws had proven the inferiority of southern and eastern europeans the restrictive law was enacted three years later in his trademark lively and authoritative style okrent brings to life the rich cast of characters from this time including lodge s closest friend theodore roosevelt charles darwin s first cousin francis galton the idiosyncratic polymath who gave life to eugenics the fabulously wealthy and profoundly bigoted madison grant founder of the bronx zoo and his best friend h fairfield osborn director of the american museum of natural history margaret sanger who saw eugenics as a sensible adjunct to her birth control campaign and maxwell perkins the celebrated editor of hemingway and fitzgerald a work of history relevant for today the guarded gate is a masterful sobering thoughtful and necessary book that painstakingly connects the american eugenicists to the rise of nazism and shows how their beliefs found fertile soil in the minds of citizens and leaders both here and abroad

this book traces the origins and development of social work as we now know it providing an ambitious synthesis of historical and international material it explores the different faces of social work whether defined by social policy developments professionalization changes in client group or shifts in practice orientation this is a unique book undertaken by an author with a strong international reputation and as such it promises to be a landmark for years to come in the social work literature
