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this is the never before published extended version of wolfe s short story in memory of his father the four lost men is the first publication of the long version of wolfe s story of familial and national reflection set during world war i wolfe supplies a moving portrait of his dying father as well as a rich mediation on american history and ambitions on the verge of america s entry into a broadening global conflict discussion of the title characters presidents garfield arthur harrison and hayes provides opportunity for assessment of the mood and promise of the nation as well as reflection on the obstacles that had obscured paths toward untapped american potential garfield arthur harrison and hayes the four republican presidents who followed grant during the reconstruction and post reconstruction eras were

all civil war generals and self made men though none experienced a particularly distinguished term in office these presidents are iconic figures in the stories and political musings of the narrator s dying father in his efforts to understand their importance to his father the teenaged narrator comes to appreciate the act of storytelling that redefines these men in his father s memory and in turn redefines his father in the his own memory originally published as a short story of 7 000 words in scribner s magazine in 1934 and later abridged by 1 000 words for reissue in the 1935 anthology from death to morning wolfe s expanded tale is published here for the first time in its intended form and full length of some 21 000 words editors arlyn and matthew j bruccoli have employed the same methods to reestablish this text as they used to wide acclaim in their centennial edition of o lost the story of a buried life the unabridged version of wolfe s look homeward angel the reestablishment of the long version of four lost men opens an undeveloped area of scholarship into wolfe s short fiction and serves as a model for restoring other such works

the untold story of the last odyssey of the heroic age of antarctic exploration sir ernest Shackleton s 1914 antarctic endeavor is legend but for sheer heroism and tragic nobility nothing compares to the saga of the Ross Sea party this crew of explorers landed on the opposite side of Antarctica from the Endurance with a mission to build supply depots for Shackleton s planned crossing of the continent but their ship disappeared in a gale leaving ten inexperienced ill equipped men to trek 1 356 miles in the harshest environment on earth drawing on the men s own journals and photographs the lost men is a masterpiece of historical adventure a book destined to be a classic in the vein of Into Thin Air

a story seemingly drawn out of a Hollywood action script gripping stuff Canada s history just before midnight on February 13 1950 three engines of a US Air Force B-36 intercontinental bomber caught fire over Canada s northwest coast the crew jumped and the plane ditched somewhere in the Pacific Ocean almost four years later the wreck of the bomber was found accidentally in a remote location in the coastal mountains of British Columbia three hours flying time in the opposite direction of where it was supposed to have crashed after years of silence the United States finally admitted to losing its very first nuclear bomb the incident was its first Broken Arrow the code name for accidents involving nuclear weapons but was the bomb dropped and exploded over the inside passage or was it blown up at the aircraft s resting place in the mountains this cold war era tale follows the last flight of bomber 075 and attempts to unravel the real story behind more than fifty years of secrecy misdirection and misinformation

these are the first steps along the path to conquest tread lightly born Esparan but raised in isolation Thomas Galanth wavers between blood and upbringing called

north to defend the family he never knew he must inspire espar to rally lest the invading northlander forces conquer the land between the ice oceans and outland plains but tohmas is not the naive commander his enemies or his allies expect war is in his blood he will not be deterred though remnants of a crushed rydan clan seek his head for a secret crime and the northlander chief readies a legendary dragon wing axe for his throat his allies are no less eager to spill his blood the princes of espar bicker for supremacy unaware that the greatest threat to them all is tohmas himself

often described as an emergency homelessness in america is becoming a chronic condition that reflects an overall decline in the nation s standard of living and the general state of the economy this is the disturbing conclusion drawn by martha burt in over the edge a timely book that takes a clear eyed look at the astonishing surge in the homeless population during the 1980s assembling and analyzing data from 147 u s cities burt documents the increase in homelessness and proposes a comprehensive explanation of its causes incorporating economic personal and policy determinants her unique research answers many provocative questions why did homelessness continue to spiral even after economic conditions improved in 1983 why is it significantly greater in cities with both high poverty rates and high per capita income what can be done about the problem burt points to the significant catalysts of homelessness the decline of manufacturing jobs in the inner city the increased cost of living the tight rental housing market diminished household income and reductions in public benefit programs all of which exert pressures on the more vulnerable of the extremely poor she looks at the special problems facing the homeless including the growing number of mentally ill and chemically dependent individuals and explains why certain groups minorities and low skilled men single men and women and families headed by women are at greatest risk of becoming homeless burt s analysis reveals that homelessness arises from no single factor but is instead perpetuated by pivotal interactions between external social and economic conditions and personal vulnerabilities from an understanding of these interactions over the edge builds lucid realistic recommendations for policymakers struggling to alleviate a situation of grave consequence for our entire society

published between 1889 and 1891 this nine volume masterpiece chronicles american history during the administrations of jefferson and madison

once again the soldiers officers and commanders tell the story in this third volume of kevin campbell s comprehensive work on the gettysburg campaign journey to armageddon the hardships comradery short rations and the dance with the enemy s bullets and shells are all here blistering sun drenching rains chocking dust sticky mud played out horses and men and the high level often inharmoniousness communications between army commanders and their governments are presented in these pages fortunately not all is despair and doom included are the sometimes humorous interactions with the civilians met along their journey and the acrimony that frequently filled encounters between hungry soldiers and the administrators of the villages and towns they passed through the tales told by these hardy men about the events of their existence are significant elements within the story of the gettysburg campaign which author kevin campbell tells in a clear and concise prose most historians who write of the great crusade gloss over these events in favor of the more prominent proceedings in and around gettysburg these often ignored events and much more are incorporated into his complete treatment of the union and confederate armies on their journey to armageddon
