eclipse the most shocking child abuse cases in history for years david and louise had kept their children in increasing isolation trapping them in a sinister world of torture fear and near starvation in the first major account of the case investigative journalist john glatt delves into the disturbing details and recounts the bravery of the thirteen siblings in the face of unimaginable horror
