gertrude stein s ultimate collection encapsulates the avant garde spirit of her literary

this third volume of the pan african chronology set covers 1914 through 1929 a time of two seminal events world war i and the black awakening in world war i people of african descent fought for both sides earning distinction on the battlefields of france as well as in the jungles and deserts of africa the black awakening a period from 1919 through 1929 marked the dawning of global awareness of the contributions of african people to the culture of the world the book is arranged by year and events of each year are grouped by region it also has two special biographical divisions for w e b dubois and marcus garvey

challenging the conventional trope that french environmentalism arose after wwii

caroline ford argues that a broad environmental consciousness emerged in france much earlier in response to war natural disasters and imperialism the bourgeoisie along with politicians engineers naturalists writers and painters took up environmental causes

the question for twentieth century china has been the integration of tradition and modernity in this collection of essays written over a period of some twenty years 1987 2006 chen lai reflects on the question in an informative and original way he reads behind the political slogans and engages with the thought both of max weber talcott parsons and western sociology and representative chinese thinkers notably feng youlan and liang shuming while the focus is on china the book also appeals to anyone interested in this fascinating question of how to modernise whilst retaining the positive values of tradition chen lai s unique and balanced grasp of society marks him out as the foremost thinker in china on this topic today

collected here for the first time these writings demonstrate the range and precision of philip rieff s sociology of culture rieff addresses the rise of psychoanalytic and other spiritual disciplines that have reshaped contemporary culture

in this book one of the world s leading social theorists presents a critical alarmed but also nuanced understanding of the post traditional world we inhabit today jeffrey alexander writes about modernity as historical time and social condition but also as ideology and utopia the idea of modernity embodies the enlightenment s noble hopes for progress and rationality but its reality brings great suffering and exposes the destructive impulses that continue to motivate humankind alexander examines how twentieth century theorists struggled to comprehend the janus faced character of modernity which looks backward and forward at the same time weber linked the triumph of worldly asceticism to liberating autonomy but also ruthless domination describing flights from rationalization as systemic and dangerous simmel pointed to the otherness haunting modernity even as he normalized the stranger eisenstadt celebrated axial age transcendence but acknowledged its increasing capacity for barbarity parsons heralded american community but ignored modernity s fragmentations rather than seeking to resolve modernity s contradictions alexander argues that social theory should accept its janus faced character it is a dangerous delusion to think that modernity can eliminate evil civil inclusion and anti civil exclusion are intertwined alexander enumerates dangerous frictions endemic to modernity but he also suggests new lines of social amelioration and emotional repair

this introduction to historic preservation goes well beyond the secretary of the interior s standards for rehabilitation and shows how wood stone masonry and metal were used in the past and how adaptive re use can be employed to bring modern amenities to historic structures the book covers all aspects of the exterior and interior building fabric including windows roofing doors porches and electrical and mechanical systems for both residential and small scale commercial buildings richly illustrated with photographs showing typical elements of historic buildings decay mechanisms and remediation

techniques the book also contains a variety of useful case studies and features a companion website that offers dozens of additional images and resources

covering a period of more than 45 years this is the first collection of the writings of international figure Lloyd George a premier public intellectual who was once found guilty of heresy by the Presbyterian church with never before seen material this compendium demonstrates the remarkable consistency in the thought of this increasingly influential thinker provocative and heartfelt this compilation provides a fascinating coverage of the engagement of religion and the modern world

the book provides valuable insights into the history culture and voices of America by offering an in depth analysis of the diverse facets of socio cultural dynamics of America this book traces the history of American poetry drama fiction social and literary criticism from the early 17th century through the turn of the 21st century individualism and self reliance American these themes are focused in the book the dream of American people is depicted very effectively the book has two parts in part I there are 10 chapters covering all the major themes of American literature including modernism and post modernism racism and search for identity in African American literature the part II covers critical responses post colonialism has become one of the most exciting rapidly expanding and challenging areas of literary and cultural studies today hence the book includes the chapter modernism and post modernism dealing with the major themes of poetry drama and fiction the book aims at fascinating the readers with a broad spectrum of perspectives which have much contemporary relevance in the arena of post colonial literature today this book is useful for all undergraduate and postgraduate students who are studying American literature

as the butch doyenne of the Parisian salons Gertrude Stein captures the heart of Picasso in that context and gives insights on how Picasso worked as an artist and why cubism came about in the way that it did also this portrait of Picasso contains pretty clear description of cubism and reveals a lot about relationship between Picasso and Stein

without revealing a lot of actual events in either of their lives gertrude stein 1874 1946 was an american novelist poet playwright and art collector best known for *three lives* the making of americans and *tender buttons* stein moved to paris in 1903 and made france her home for the remainder of her life picasso and cubism were an important influence on stein s writing her works are compared to james joyce s *ulysses* and to marcel proust s *in search of lost time*

at a time when china is once again facing a major turning point in its direction i firmly believe that my academic dispute with wang hui is in no way a personal or left right dispute wang hui s grand narrative about the chinese revolution and the chinese century is meant to provide a new legitimate basis for one party to rule forever to place world history in the value system of the chinese revolution and to shape the chinese revolution and its regime into the ultimate source and ultimate judge of universal justice in the world there is no doubt that wang hui s new theoretical proposition is not only far from the basic idea of liberalism but also far from the political democratic position that the western left wing tradition has always insisted on since liberal scholars have automatically given up head on confrontation with wang hui it is time to end wang hui s theories which have never been subjected to comprehensive and systematic academic criticism in china s intellectual and intellectual spheres for nearly thirty years therefore at such a time it would be an unforgivable dereliction of duty for liberals to fail to take the initiative as raymond aron did to undertake the historical mission of criticizing barbaric ideologies totalitarianism and statism and to hold fast to the basic virtues given to intellectuals by providence as arendt said the storm of ideas is not characterized by knowledge but by the ability to distinguish good from evil beauty from ugliness and this may indeed prevent disaster in that rare moment of crisis

long before the arrival of western emissaries and powers east asian peoples and states were deeply involved in world affairs in this sweeping account warren i cohen explores four millennia of international relations from the vantage points of china japan korea and southeast asia writing incisively and authoritatively for readers at all levels cohen paints a broad but revealing portrait of east asia s place in the world he defines the region s boundaries widely looking beyond china japan and korea to include southeast asia and extends the scope of international relations to consider the vital role of cultural and economic exchanges cohen examines the system of chinese domination in the ancient world the exchanges between east asia and the islamic world chinese sea voyages to arabia and east africa and the emergence of a european defined international system he chronicles the new imperialism of the 1890s the ascendancy of japan the trials of world war ii the drama of the cold war and the transformations of east asian states toward the close of the twentieth century by showing that east asia has often been preeminent on the world stage this book not only recasts the past but also adds crucial historical perspective on international politics today this second edition of *east asia at the center* features new material on the first decades of the twenty first century

similarity and difference in modern medicine generic drugs are now familiar objects in clinics drugstores and households around the world we like to think of these tablets capsules patches and ointments as interchangeable with their brand name counterparts why pay more for the same and yet they are not quite the same they differ in price in place of origin in color shape and size in the dyes binders fillers and coatings used and in a host of other ways claims of generic equivalence as physician historian jeremy greene reveals in this gripping narrative are never based on being identical to the original drug in all respects but in being the same in all ways that matter how do we know what parts of a pill really matter decisions about which differences are significant and which are trivial in the world of therapeutics are not resolved by simple chemical or biological assays alone as greene reveals in this fascinating account questions of therapeutic similarity and difference are also always questions of pharmacology and physiology of economics and politics of morality and belief generic is the first book to chronicle the social political and cultural history of generic drugs in america it narrates the evolution of the generic drug industry from a set of mid twentieth century schlock houses and counterfeiters into an agile and surprisingly powerful set of multinational corporations in the early twenty first century the substitution of bioequivalent generic drugs for more expensive brand name products is a rare success story in a field of failed attempts to deliver equivalent value in health care for a lower price greene s history sheds light on the controversies shadowing the success of generics problems with the generalizability of medical knowledge the fragile role of science in public policy and the increasing role of industry marketing and consumer logics in late twentieth century and early twenty first century health care
