the future of theatre history studies requires consideration of theatre as a global phenomenon the challenge of world theatre history offers the first full scale argument for abandoning an obsolete and parochial eurocentric approach to theatre history in favor of a more global perspective this book exposes the fallacies that reinforce the conventional approach and defends the global perspective against possible objections it moves beyond the conventional nation based geography of theatre in favor of a regional geography and develops a new way to demarcate the periods of theatre history finally the book outlines a history that recognizes the often connected developments in theatre across eurasia and around the world it makes the case that world theatre history is necessary not only for itself but for the powerful comparative and contextual insights it offers to all theatre scholars and students whatever their special areas of interest

the second volume of the world encyclopedia of contemporary theatre covers the americas from canada to argentina including the united states entries on twenty six countries are preceded by specialist introductions on theatre in post colonial latin america theatres of north america puppet theatre theatre for young audiences music theatre and dance theatre the essays follow the series format allowing for cross referring across subjects both within the volume and between volumes each country entry is written by specialists in the particular country and the volume has its own teams of regional editors overseen by the main editorial team based at the university of york in canada headed by don rubin each entry covers all aspects of theatre genres practitioners writers critics and styles with bibliographies over 200 black white photographs and a substantial index this is a unique volume in its own right in conjunction with the other volumes in this series it forms a reference resource of unparalleled value

this book highlights the transdisciplinary legacy of cheikh anta diop's epistemology demonstrating its continuing impact on contemporary afriology which is also known as black studies diop's works in the second half of the 20th century were foundational to the discipline of afriology exposing a stain of cultural and racial bias in eurocentric egyptology diop argued that ancient egyptian civilization in fact had deep cultural and linguistic connections with african societies south of the sahara this book argues that transdisciplinarity was at the heart of diop's arguments as his work drew from history anthropology linguistics sociology economics linguistics osteology and physics this book argues that even now transdisciplinary approaches remain essential to the discipline of afriology sometimes referred to as black studies africana studies pan african studies african global studies or african american studies in this book the contributors consider how diopian transdisciplinary epistemic approaches continue to combat racial bias and restore the global historical and cultural significance of africa highlighting the significance of africa's usable past as outlined by diop this book is an important read for researchers across african studies afriology black studies history world civilizations intercultural studies africa focused think tanks and policy makers across the african world

major characters now die on popular shows weekly while many shows kill off characters for pure shock value death on game of thrones produces seismic shifts in power dynamics and resurrected bodies that continue to fight this collection of new essays explores how power death gender and performance intertwine in the series

combines updates and expands two earlier salem press reference sets critical survey of drama rev ed english language series published in 1994 and critical survey of drama foreign language series published in 1986 this new 8 vol set contains 602 essays of which 538 discuss individual dramatists and 64 cover broad overview topics the dramatist profiles contain more than 310 photographs and drawings

the subject of stage directions in hamlet those brief semiotic codes that are embellished by historical theatrical and cultural considerations produces a rigorous examination in the fifteen essays contained in this collection this volume encompasses essays that are guardedly inductive in their critical approaches as well as those that critique modern productions that attempt to achieve shakespearean effect through a modern aesthetic the volume also includes essays that enunciate the production of stage business as a cultural interplay between productions and social agencies outside the theater

this book examines the appropriation of theatre and theatrical performance by ideologies of humanism in terms that continue to echo across the related disciplines of literary drama theatre and performance history and studies today from aristotle onward theatre has been regulated by three strains of critical poesis the literary segregating theatre and the practices of the spectacular from the humanizing work attributed to the book and to the internality of reading the dramatic approving the address of theatrical performance only to the extent that it instrumentalizes literary value and the theatrical assimilating performance to the conjunction of literary and liberal values these values have been used to figure not only the work of theatre but also the propriety of the audience as a figure for its socializing work along a privileged dualism from the aestheticized ensemble harmonizing actor character and spectator to the essentialized drama to the politicized assembly theatre understood as an agonistic gathering

the book also offers a poetics of the central stage and suggests a new way of writing about performance
