the holocaust has been the focus of countless films in the united states great britain and europe and its treatment over the years has been the subject of considerable controversy when finally permitted to portray the atrocities filmmakers struggled with issues of fidelity to historical fact depictions of graphic violence and how to approach the complexities of the human condition on all sides of this horrific event in hollywood and the holocaust henry gonshak explores portrayals of the holocaust from the world war ii era to the present in chapters devoted to films ranging from the great dictator to inglouriousbasterds this volume looks at how these films have shaped perceptions of the shoah the author also questions if hollywood given its commercialism is capable of conveying the holocaust in ways that do justice to its historical trauma through a careful

consideration of over twenty five films across genres including *Life is Beautiful*, *Cabaret*, *The Reader*, *The Boy from Brazil* and *Schindler's List*. This book provides an important look at the social, political and cultural contexts in which these movies were produced by also engaging with the critical responses to these films and their role in the public's ongoing fascination with the Holocaust. This book suggests that viewers take a closer look at how such films depict this dark period in world history. Hollywood and the Holocaust will be of interest to cultural critics, historians and anyone interested in the cinema's ability to render these tragic events on screen.

Nearly eighty years have passed since the Holocaust. There have been hundreds of memoirs, histories and novels written about it, yet many fear that this important event may fall into oblivion as Holocaust survivors pass away. Their legacy of suffering, tenacity and courage could be forgotten. It is up to each generation to commemorate the victims, preserve their life stories and hopefully help prevent such catastrophes. These were my main motivations in writing this book, *Holocaust Memories*, which includes reviews of memoirs, histories, biographies, novels and films about the Holocaust. It was difficult to choose among the multitude of books on the subject that deserve our attention. I made my selections based partly on the works that are considered to be the most important on the subject, partly on wishing to offer some historical background about the Holocaust in different countries and regions that were occupied by or allied themselves with Nazi Germany, and partly on my personal preferences, interests and knowledge. The Nazis targeted European Jews as their main victims, so my book focuses primarily on them. At the same time, since the Nazis also targeted other groups they considered dangerous and inferior, I also review books about the sufferings of the Gypsies, the Poles and other groups that fell victim to the Nazi regimes. In the last part, I review books that discuss other genocides and crimes against humanity, including the Stalinist mass purges, the Cambodian massacres by the Pol Pot regime and the Rwandan genocide. I want to emphasize that history can indeed repeat itself, even if in different forms and contexts. Just as the Jews of Europe were not the only targets of genocide, fascist regimes were not its only perpetrators.

Taking early 21st century Britain as a case study, *Rethinking Holocaust Film Reception: A British Case Study* presents an intervention into the scholarship on the representation of the Holocaust on film. Based on a study of audience responses to select films, Stefanie Rauch demonstrates that the reception of films about the Holocaust is a complex process that we cannot understand through textual analysis alone but by also paying attention to individual reception processes. This book restores the agency of viewers and takes

seriously their diverse responses to representations of the holocaust it demonstrates that viewers interpretative resources play an important role in film reception viewers regard holocaust films as a separate genre that they encounter with a set of expectations the author highlights the implications of britain s lessons focused approach to holocaust education and commemoration and addresses debates around the supposed globalization of holocaust memory by unpacking the peculiar britishness of viewers responses to films about the holocaust a sense of emotional connection or its absence to the holocaust and its memory speaks to divisions along ethnic generational and national lines

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
