a book of great value for every daughter and every mother useful for sons too benjamin spock m d from the introduction the goal of this book is to help readers achieve that separation so that they can either find a way to be friends with their mothers or at least recognize and accept that their mothers did the best they could even if it wasn't good enough and to stop blaming them among the issues to be covered to understand how a daughter's attachment to her mother more so than her relationship with her father colors all her other relationships and to analyze why it is more difficult for daughters than sons to separate from their mothers as well as why daughters are more subject than sons to a mother's manipulation to recognize the difference between a healthy and a destructive mother daughter connection and to define clearly the bad mommy in order to help readers who have trouble acknowledging their childhood losses to begin to comprehend them to conjugate what i call the bad mommy taboo why our culture is more eager to protect the sanctity of maternity than it is to protect emotionally abused daughters to describe the evolution of the unpleasable mother in all likelihood she was bereft of maternal love as a child and to recognize the huge and often poignant stake she has in keeping her grown daughter dependent and off balance to illustrate the consequent controlling behavior in some cases cloaked in fragility or good intentions of such mothers which falls into general patterns including the doormat the critic the smotherer the avenger the deserter to understand that the daughter has a similar stake in either being a slave to or hating her mother the two sides of her dependency and immaturity to illustrate the responsive behavior and survival mechanisms of daughters which is determined in part by such variables as birth rank family history and temperament and which also falls into patterns including the angel the superachiever the cipher the troublemaker the defector to show how to redefine the mother daughter relationship so that each can learn to see and accept the other as she is today appreciating each other's good qualities and not being snared by the bad finally to demonstrate that a redefined relationship with one's mother adult to adult frees you from the past whether that redefinition ultimately results in real friendship affectionate truce or divorce

this guide should be of interest to parents whose children study or are considering studying an instrument or taking music lessons it should also be of use to music teachers

rejected the orthodoxy of their religious inheritance in favor of a more humanistic approach and in the process discovered a renewed spirituality that they hoped would address the concerns of a world yearning for something to believe in while the humanistic psychologists confronted the world's problems through the lens of psychology other thinkers such as the evolutionary biologist Julian Huxley approached them through different though equally humanistic perspectives others still such as Paul Tillich Martin Buber and Pierre Teilhard de Chardin confronted the times through a religious lens the influence of the centuries long Jewish tradition of scholarship and social justice and the frequent examples of friendship and professional cooperation between the secular and the religious worlds provide critical subthemes for the lasting appeal of humanistic psychology

increasing numbers of disillusioned and thoughtful persons find they can no longer maintain a simplistic concept of theism be it Christian Jewish or Islamic but the shock that comes with loss of faith and the challenges of learning to restructure one's life if one has been a believer can seem overwhelming aftermath gives a sound foundation for building a meaningful life without God

rediscovering love is written as a guide for those people who refuse to accept the idea that the best days of their relationship are behind them and who have the courage and willingness to try and repair or strengthen their partner relationship learning why relationships deteriorate and helping the reader take a hard interpersonal look at ways they may be sabotaging their relationships creates a pathway toward new levels of communication and tools for improving the quality of an existing or new relationship

it is a story that moves us to tears an american couple travels across the world to rescue a child from the hopelessness of a foreign orphanage bringing their new son or daughter to a life of love and family but does this transition always go smoothly adoptive parents hope their child will easily fit into the family and quickly become emotionally connected to the parents or siblings but child psychologists and adoption experts say this connection is the most difficult aspect of international adoption in countries where international adoptions are common china russia or romania orphanages commonly represent the available children to their new parents as healthy kids who just need a little love in many cases this is a gross misrepresentation children who spend time in institutionalized care may have experienced trauma and therefore may not attach easily to their new family parents anxious to bring these children into their homes and their hearts struggle seriously with this issue although these children will eventually adapt in a healthy fashion the road to emotional health and harmony can be a rocky one becoming a family tackles this intricate issue head on it provides parents with effective strategies for ensuring that their adopted child adjusts as quickly and seamlessly as possible practical and accessible this book will help parents identify severe problems before the adoption significantly reduce the risk of future difficulty improve the damage already done to the child s otherwise normal healthy development and dramatically help unfold the child into a family ready to give love security and a new life
