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this study examines questions about historians and their work why do we study history how do we construct our knowledge of the past what are the limitations of historical evidence and what different kinds of history are being written today

this classic introduction to the study of history invites the reader to stand back and consider some of its most fundamental questions what is the point of studying history how do we know about the past does an objective historical truth exist and can we ever access it in answering these central questions john tosh argues that despite the impression of fragmentation created by postmodernism in recent years history is a coherent discipline which still bears the imprint of its nineteenth century origins consistently clear sighted he provides a lively and compelling guide to a complex and sometimes controversial subject while making his readers vividly aware of just how far our historical knowledge is conditioned by the character of the sources and the methods of the historians who work on them the fifth edition has been revised and updated throughout with the addition of new sections on global history comparative history postcolonialism women s and gender history oral history and memory lucid and engaging this new edition retains all the user friendly features that have helped to make this book a favourite with both students and lecturers including marginal glosses illustrations suggested further reading and boxed guides to key events and people

tracing the origin of work with the impotent poor under the poor laws to social workers current responsibilities towards vulnerable people this book introduces the reader to the way in which the identification of particular social problems at the end of the nineteenth century led to the emergence of a wide range of separate occupational groups and voluntary workers which were sometimes but increasingly referred to as social workers using an extended single chronological historical narrative and analysis which draws heavily on original archival sources and contemporary literature it addresses the changes which took place as part of the welfare state and the identification of common roles and responsibilities by social workers which led to the formation of the british association of social workers in 1970 the expansion of roles and responsibilities in social services departments and voluntary societies is analysed and their significance for the development of social work is evaluated by highlighting the changes and continuities in these roles and responsibilities this book will be of interest to all academics students and practitioners working within social work who wish to know more about the origins of their discipline and the current state of the profession today

research within the disciplines is designed to help reference librarians and students studying to become librarians gain that deeper understanding of disciplinary differences that allows them to comfortably solve information needs rather than merely responding to questions and practical knowledge about how to work with researchers in a library setting the book has three chapters that cover the disciplines at the broadest level humanities social sciences and sciences plus supplemental chapters that focus on associated disciplines research in history business and engineering research using government sources and across disciplines interdisciplinary and critical information literacy for the second edition of research within the disciplines several chapters have been added that together give a broader and deeper overview of research across all subject areas research practices of creative and performing artists and of clinical scientists research in international documents research strategies for foreign language materials and visual literacy across the disciplines major shifts in technology have been accounted for that have changed how we do research and have expanded the range of resources available to researchers in all disciplines all of the

chapters have been rewritten or heavily revised this is much more a new book than a new edition

this series aims at bridging the gap between historical theory and the study of historical memory as well as western and non western concepts for which this volume offers a particularly good example it explores cultural differences in conceptualizing time and history in countries such as china japan and india as well as pre modern societies

in december 1941 the war department sent two transports and a freighter carrying 103 p 40 fighters and their pilots to the philippines to bolster gen douglas macarthur s far east air force they were then diverted to australia with new orders to ferry the p 40s to the philippines from australia through the dutch east indies but on the same day as the second transport reached its destination on january 12 1942 the first of the key refueling stops in the east indies fell to rapidly advancing japanese forces resulting in a break in their ferry route and another change in their orders this time the pilots would fly their aircraft to java to participate in the desperate allied defense of that ultimate japanese objective except for the pilots from the philippines almost all of the other pilots eventually assigned to the five provisional pursuit squadrons ordered to java were recent graduates of flying school with just a few hours on the p 40 only forty three of them made it to their assigned destination the rest suffered accidents in australia were shot down over bali and darwin or were lost in the sinking of the uss langley as it carried thirty two of them to java even those who did reach the secret field on java wondered if they had been sacrificed for no purpose as the japanese air assault

intensified daily the allied defense collapsed only eleven japanese aircraft fell to the p 40s author william h bartsch has pored through personal diaries and memoirs of the participants cross checking these primary sources against japanese aerial combat records of the period and supplementing them with official records and other american dutch and australian accounts bartsch s thorough and meticulous research yields a narrative that situates the java pursuit pilots experiences within the context of the overall strategic situation in the early days of the pacific theater
