this book is a historical theological commentary on the approved postconciliar eucharistic prayers of the roman rite the author father enrico mazza traces each prayer to its root time and gives the reader the cultural theological climate of those times before analyzing the theological principles as translated in the prayers today

this volume assembles in one place many of the documents needed by pastoral ministers and students of the liturgy each document is preceded by an outline of the text also included is a cumulative index of material found in this volume and in the liturgy documents a parish resource volume 2

inception of christianity and the same has been true in our own day as bishops and translators have worked for a number of years now on the forthcoming english translation of the third edition of the roman missal this moment offers catholics a fresh opportunity for liturgical catechesis and formation which was not possible in the years immediately after the second vatican council beginning with a short history of how the roman rite evolved over the centuries and the implementation of the vatican ii liturgical reforms keith pecklers traces the shift in the principles and process of liturgical translation over the past forty years from the latin typical editions into vernacular languages building on that historical background this volume then treats the new general instruction on the roman missal and significant changes in the texts which english speaking catholics around the world will be using for the foreseeable future when they pray at mass

beginning in 1997 the work of translating these rituals was a daunting task as no one had previously delved into the vatican archives especially with permission and been able to translate some of the earliest text from their original languages then make sure the proper context is applied to bring it into the modern english language platform countless hours were spent researching compiling and then translating from aramaic egyptian and even greek then double checking them behind the direct latin to english translations over the course of time the research found the rights and blessings for every church condoned action such as blessings for radio stations and even aircraft the blessings for anything classed as holy blessings for everyday items such as breads fire and even beer the full rite of exorcism no edits and all of the parts hollywood leaves out when doing a film no other version of the roman rituals has ever been presented so complete and full

the death of the italian jesuit matteo ricci in china in 1610 was the occasion for demonstrations of european rituals appropriate for a catholic priest and also of chinese rituals appropriate to the country hosting the jesuit community rather than burying ricci immediately in a plain coffin near the church according to their european practice the jesuits followed chinese custom and kept ricci s body for nearly a year in an air tight chinese style coffin and asked the emperor for burial ground outside the city walls moreover at ricci s funeral itself on their own initiative the chinese performed their funerary rituals thus starting a long and complex cultural dialogue in which they took the lead during the next century the interweaving of rituals explores the role of ritual specifically rites related to death and funerals in cross cultural exchange demonstrating a gradual interweaving of chinese and european ritual practices at all levels of interaction in seventeenth century china this includes the interplay of traditional and new rituals by a christian community of commoners the grafting of christian funerals onto established chinese practices and the sponsorship of funeral processions for jesuit officials by the emperor through careful observation of the details of funerary practice nicolas standaert illustrates the mechanics of two way cultural

interaction his thoughtful analysis of the ritual exchange between two very different cultural traditions is especially relevant in today's world of global ethnic and religious tension his insights will be of interest to a broad range of scholars from historians to anthropologists to theologians

the studies in this volume share a focus on religion in the ancient mediterranean world how ritual myth spectatorship and travel reflect the continual interaction of human beings with the richly fictive beings who defined the boundaries of groups access to the past and mobility across land and seascapes they share as well the methodological exploration of the intersection between human science the integration of numerous disciplines around the study of all aspects of human life from the biological to the cultural and the study of the past in so doing they continue a long dialogue that engages with critical models derived from specializations within history philology archaeology sociology and anthropology and addresses increasingly the potentialities and pitfalls of quantitative and digital analyses many of the threads in this long conversation inform these chapters the comparative project human social evolution disciplinary reflexivity religion as an embedded functional and structural system and the role for agency networks and materiality

the founding of the roman catholic church in melanesia and micronesia 1850 to 1875 is the result of father ralph wiltgen's years of archival work in rome and at the headquarters of religious orders who worked in micronesia and melanesia it follows his first historical book on the subject the founding of the roman catholic church in oceania 1825 to 1850 but narrows the focus the first book dealt with the whole of oceania and emphasized developments in polynesia this book concentrates on melanesia and micronesia from 1850 to 1875 the period immediately before the work of large numbers of missionaries of the sacred heart marists and divine word missionaries assumed great momentum in the period between 1875 and 1914 micronesia is a huge area of the world made up

of numerous culturally and politically distinct groups of atolls ranging over about 1 400 miles from the northwest to the southeast its peoples speak scores of mutually unintelligible though related languages on such island groups as the marshalls the gilberts nauru and kiribati far more heavily populated is melanesia another huge area of the pacific where as many as one thousand distinct languages are spoken in an arc of islands extending from just below the equator in a boomerang shape from today s indonesian controlled papua and independent papua new guinea on the island of new guinea in the northwest all the way along the solomon island chain to 25 south latitude to the southeast in this book wiltgen shows himself the undisputed master of the archives of the propaganda fide the vatican s chief mission agency and the religious orders that provided missionaries all of which is supplemented by his attention to the lives of key people of the period he shows the propaganda now prodding missionary orders to take on the difficult work of evangelizing these areas and on other occasions struggling to keep up with and understand fast moving events and the colorful characters both ecclesiastical and among colonial administrators rogue sea captains and indigenous leaders wiltgen lets the contemporary records speak for themselves though one can imagine his arched brow and mischievous grin as he selects exactly the right quote to describe now an act of missionary heroism and now an act of self promotion it is a masterful book making available the early history of one of catholicism s greatest missionary successes helping the reader understand both the idealism of the vision and the way in which concrete events and people affected the outcome
