the halifax explosion of 1917 is a defining event in the canadian consciousness yet it has never been the subject of a sustained analytical history astonishingly until now no one has consulted the large federal government archives that contain first hand accounts of the disaster and the response of national authorities canada's recently established navy was at the epicentre of the crisis armstrong reveals the navy's compelling and little known story by carefully retracing the events preceding the disaster and the role of the military in its aftermath he catches the pulse of disaster response in official ottawa and provides a compelling analysis of the legal manoeuvres rhetoric blunders public controversy and crisis management that ensued his disturbing conclusion is that federal officials knew of potential dangers in the harbour before the explosion took no corrective action and kept the information from the public as a result a halifax naval officer was made a scapegoat and the navy received lasting and mostly undeserved vilification this is a provocative read not only for military and naval devotees but for anyone who wants to understand one of the events that shaped canada in the twentieth century

in 1988 after years of failed negotiations over the status of the northwest passage brian mulroney gave ronald reagan a globe pointed to the arctic and said ron that s ours we own it lock stock and icebergs a simple statement it summed up a hundred years of official policy since the nineteenth century canadian governments have claimed ownership of the land and the icy passageways that make up the arctic archipelago unfortunately for ottawa many countries including the united states still do not recognize these as internal canadian waters crucial to understanding the complex nature of canadian arctic sovereignty is an understanding of its history lock stock and icebergs draws on recently declassified canadian and american archival material to chart the origins and development of canadian arctic maritime policy uncovering decades of internal policy debates secret negotiations with the united states and long classified joint defence projects adam lajeunesse traces the circuitous history of canada s arctic maritime sovereignty

a wide ranging look at the history of the canadian navy from its beginnings in 18th century exploration and trade to its astonishing expansion during the second world war through to its current roles in operations with united nations and nato forces

from 1942 to 1944 15 german submarines destroyed or severely damaged 27 ships including three canadian warships a u s army troop transport and the newfoundland ferry caribou more than 250 lives were lost it was the only battle of the twentieth century to take place within canada s boundaries and the only battle to be fought almost exclusively by canadian forces under canadian rather than alliance high command and for more than 40 years the battle was characterized as a canadian defeat but was it a defeat drawing on new material from wartime records including ultra top secret allied decryptions of german naval radio communications roger sarty shows that canada mounted a successful defence with far fewer resources and in the face of much greater challenges than previously known he draws vivid pictures of the intense combat on canada s shores and the interplay of the st lawrence battle with war politics in ottawa washington and london at the same time he weaves a second story how researchers reassembled the scattered war records in canada britain the united states and germany and brought the long forgotten battle to life for new generations of canadians and international audiences

submariners are a tight knit group of men bound together by training and experience and with a language all their own that language is perhaps a little vulgar but never intentionally demeaning and a little irreverent but still worldly this work is an attempt to preserve and explain some of these curious guys who so proudly wear a shiny metal pin that looks like a strange pair of fish on their left breast this process of accumulating this new language begins in boot camp and is added to with every change of duty station the sailor undergoes it is heard aboard the boats and unknowingly by family members who can t understand terms like head deck and overhead and who think sos is a distress signal

james douglas s story is one of high adventure in pre confederation canada it weaves through the heart of canadian and pacific northwest history when british columbia was a wild

land vancouver didn t exist and victoria was a muddy village part black and illegitimate douglas was born in british guiana now guyana in 1803 to a scottish plantation owner and a mixed race woman after schooling in scotland the fifteen year old douglas sailed to canada in 1819 to join the fur trade with roads non existent he travelled thousands of miles each year using the rivers and lakes as his highways he paddled canoes drove dogsleds and snowshoed to his destinations douglas became a hard nosed fur trader married a part cree wife and nearly provoked a war between britain and the united states over the san juan islands on the west coast when he was in his prime he established victoria and secrured the western region of british north america from the russian empire and the expansionist americans eventually douglas became the controversial governor of the colonies of vancouver island and british columbia and oversaw the frenzied fraser and cariboo gold rushes

this book offers a fresh perspective on north american history and the key role played by halifax and victoria in ensuring that canada emerged as an independent country in the 20th century brian elson focuses on the significance of the bases for the all powerful british navy at halifax and victoria through the 19th century and the first world war as he explains halifax gave the royal navy the land base they needed to project british power along the whole east atlantic coast of north america victoria s esquimault did the same thing for the pacific coast during the 1800s the united states grew dramatically adding huge swaths of lands west south and north that had belonged to france spain mexico and russia while pushing aside native peoples more than once the american government came into conflict with britain over british territory in north america there were threats of war and annexation and american popular support for absorbing canada was strong in this book bryan elson shows how the british presence in halifax and later in victoria stood in the way of us designs on canada american leaders knew that the british navy with its bases on both coasts had the power to cut them off from the rest of the world with a naval blockade the american threat to canada was effectively countered by the british presence in these two cities the two bastions played their most important role in the early years of the first world war as bryan elson explains in 1914 the united states stood aside while the british empire including canada took on germany in this situation the british navy including the canadian navy s

first east coast warship mounted a show of force by stopping all incoming and outgoing traffic from the port of new york this lasted until the us finally opted into the war on the side of britain in 1917 meanwhile on the west coast the equimault naval base was buttressed by the extraordinary action of the b c provincial government which at the start of the war bought two new submarines from a shipyard in seattle for the fledgling canadian navy
