and michael gorman whose works and example invite professional and critical self examination here budd challenges us to confront the uneasy truth of whether libraries still represent people s will and intellect or the cabalistic enclaves of an old guard through intellectually rich and engaging entrees into ethics democracy social responsibility governance and globalization he makes the case that librarians who fail to grasp the importance of their heritage will never truly respond to societal change or the needs of the individual user

while there is already a huge research literature marked by the sociology of technology the analyses gathered in this volume try to go beyond classical sociological approaches rather the idea is that crossing traditional boundaries will lead to new results when it comes to understanding the effects of technologies this idea is based on the assumption that the implementation of technology in daily life is no longer directly associated with binaries such as technology nature object subject alienated and creative activities social determination and self determination material culture and social practices or interactive communication and mediated communication in fact technology gains social relevance as it is uniquely embedded into cultural practices so far this argument holds espe cially true for analyses within the sociology of culture ethnome thodology and related fields while these fields have primarily dealt with old technologies like communication skills body performances or trained craftsmanship their fundamental argument should be extended to the more advanced technologies and to the use of latest high tech

this volume offers a comprehensive review of experimental methods in economics its 21 chapters cover theoretical and practical issues such as incentives theory and policy development data analysis recruitment software and laboratory organization the handbook includes separate parts on procedures field experiments and neuroeconomics and provides the first methodological overview of replication studies and a novel set valued equilibrium concept as a whole the combination of basic methods and current developments will aid both beginners and advanced experimental economists

rhetorical scholarship has for decades relied solely on culture to explain persuasive behavior while this focus allows for deep explorations of historical circumstance it neglects the powerful effects of biology on rhetorical behavior how our bodies and brains help shape and constrain rhetorical acts not only is the cultural model incomplete but it tacitly endorses the fallacy of human exceptionalism by introducing evolutionary biology into the study of rhetoric this book serves as a model of a biocultural paradigm being mindful of biological and cultural influences allows for a deeper view of rhetoric one that is

aware of the ubiquity of persuasive behavior in nature human and nonhuman animals and even some plants persuade to survive to live love and cooperate that this broad spectrum of rhetorical behavior exists in the animal world demonstrates how much we can learn from evolutionary biology by incorporating scholarship on animal signaling into the study of rhetoric the author explores how communication has evolved and how numerous different species of animals employ similar persuasive tactics in order to overcome similar problems this cross species study of rhetoric allows us to trace the origins of our own persuasive behaviors providing us with a deeper history of rhetoric that transcends the written and the televised and reveals the artifacts of our communicative past
