it is estimated that around 50 000 brigade lads served in the first world war during which many honors and distinctions were awarded the brigade contributed two service battalions of the king s royal rifle corps whose members were comprised entirely of past and present members of the church lads brigade these were known as pals battalions the story of the battalion centers around the experiences of eight men who served and some who died in the battles of the somme arras and the lys in the latter half of the nineteenth century influential christians were worried about the poor spiritual and physical development of young people it was at that time that brigade groups began to spring up all over the uk walter mallock gee who was secretary of the junior branch of the church of england temperance society and a volunteer army officer founded the church lads brigade in 1891 by 1908 the membership of the brigade stood at about 70 000 in 1 300 companies when the call to arms came from field marshal horatio herbert kitchener in 1914 thousands of britain s youth flocked to join the armed forces members of the church lads brigade joined up in their droves at recruiting stations all over great britain two battalions were formed entirely from serving and ex members of the church lad s brigade the 16th service battalion and later the 19th service battalion both sponsored by the church lads brigade became known as the churchmen s battalion in 1914 no one could have imagined the horrendous stories that would unfold from the bloody massacre at so many notorious battles across belgium and the fields of flanders ypres passchendale somme arras lys and the brutal decimation of the battalion during the hell of the fighting at high wood no one could have imagined the discomfort and disease brought on by living in a trench full of water for days on end or over the top through acres of knee high mud more than 24 of the church lads brigade were awarded a victoria cross for their bravery but by 1918 many of those gallant young lads would not return home this is their story the author and the publishers acknowledge that some material in this title has been taken from the website 1914 1918 net without permission or acknowledgement and are grateful to the copyright holder chris baker for granting this permission retrospectively

spain and the great powers in the twentieth centuryexamines the international context to and influences on spanish history and politics from 1898 to the present day spanish history is necessarily international with the significance of spain s neutrality in the first

world war and the global influences on the outcome of the spanish civil war taking the defeat in the spanish american war of 1898 as a starting point the book includes surveys on the crisis of neutrality during the first world war foreign policy under the dictatorship of primo de rivera the allies and the spanish civil war nazi germany and franco s spain spain and the cold war relations with the united states this book traces the important topic of modern spanish diplomacy up to the present day

the awareness that the churches shaped out of the european reformations are in an advanced process of unraveling is becoming increasingly sensed by many this book proposes a way of addressing this unraveling based on the experiences and knowledge of people who have always had to struggle with the unraveling of their own communities and worlds it takes us outside the circular conversations of the euro tribal churches into dialogue with people who have been marginalized to see how they have learned to reenter their formative stories to discover ways of remaking themselves in the unraveling the book then turns these discoveries into ways the churches can engage their own massive unraveling

biographies of frederick the great generally emphasise the military and diplomatic events of his reign and neglect to discuss fully the significance of his economic policy in this series of essays dr henderson deals with various aspects of the prussian economy in frederick the great s reign he describes frederick s commercial policy the reconstruction of prussia after the seven years war and the state of the prussian economy in 1780 s showing that alone among his contemporaries frederick left his country with a far more flourishing economy than it had been when he ascended the throne the role of the private entrepreneur in prussia at this time is illustrated by surveys of the careers of the

merchants splitgerber and gotzkowsky who promoted the expansion of prussia s armament silk and porcelain industries this book was first published in 1963

the military toll of world war i is widely known millions of britons were mobilised many thousands killed or wounded and the landscape of british society changed forever but how was the conflict experienced by the people of surrey on the home front surrey heritage s project surrey in the great war a county remembers has over the four year centenary commemoration explored the wartime stories of surrey s people and places the project s discoveries are here captured through text case studies and images this book chronicles the mobilisation of surrey men the training of foreign troops in the county objection to military service defence against invasion voluntary work and fundraising the experiences of women and children shortages industrial supply to the armed forces and the commemoration of surrey s dead drawing heavily on the rich archives of surrey heritage it is an engaging exploration of a county in the shadow of the first globalised war between industrialised nations

prohibition was imposed by eager temperance movements organizers who sought to shape public behavior through alcoholic beverage control in the 19th and early 20th centuries the success of reformers efforts resulted in national prohibition in america from 1920 to 1933 but it also resulted in a thriving illegal business in the manufacture and distribution of illegal liquor the history of prohibition and the resulting illegal drinking is frequently told through the lens of crime and violence in chicago and other major east coast cities often neglected are the effects of prohibition on the western part of the united states and how westerners rose to the challenge of avoiding the consequences of illegal drinking illegal liquor was imported from abroad made in stills using strange ingredients that were sometimes poisonous to the unlucky drinker this

history includes stories ranging from serious to quirky and provides an entertaining account of how misguided efforts resulted in numerous unintended consequences

years before the dust bowl exodus raised america s conscience to the plight of its migratory citizenry an estimated one to two million homeless unemployed americans were traversing the country searching for permanent community often mistaken for bums tramps hoboes or migratory laborers these transients were a new breed of educated highly employable men and women uprooted from their middle and working class homes by an unprecedented economic crisis the homeless transient in the great depression investigates this population and the problems they faced in an america caught between a poor law past and a social welfare future the story of the transient is told from the perspective of the federal state and local governments and from the viewpoint of the social worker the community and the transient in narrowing the focus of the study from the national to the state level joan crouse offers a close and sensitive examination of each the choice of new york as a focal point provides an important balance to previous literature on migrancy by shifting attention from the southwest to the northeast and from a preoccupation with rejection on the federal level to the concerted effort of the state to deal with the non resident poor in a humane yet fiscally responsible manner
