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nothing but freedom examines the aftermath of emancipation in the south and the restructuring of society by which the former slaves gained beyond their freedom a new relation to the land they worked on to the men they worked for and to the government they lived under taking a comparative approach eric foner examines reconstruction in the southern states against the experience of haiti where a violent slave revolt was followed by the establishment of an undemocratic government and the imposition of a system of

forced labor the british caribbean where the colonial government oversaw an orderly transition from slavery to the creation of an almost totally dependent work force and early twentieth century southern and eastern africa where a self sufficient peasantry was dispossessed in order to create a dependent black work force measuring the progress of freedmen in the post civil war south against that of freedmen in other recently emancipated societies foner reveals reconstruction to have been despite its failings a unique and dramatic experiment in interracial democracy in the aftermath of slavery steven hahn s timely new foreword places foner s analysis in the context of recent scholarship and assesses its enduring impact in the twenty first century

freedom s soldiers tells the story of the 200 000 black men who fought in the civil war in their own words and those of eyewitnesses

some were slaves who endured their last years of servitude before escaping from their masters some were soldiers who fought for the freedom of their brethren and for equal rights some were reporters who covered the defeat of their oppressors here for the first time are collected the testimonies of african americans who witnessed the civil war they include the great abolitionist frederick douglass on the meaning of the war martin r delany on his meeting with lincoln to gain permission to raise an army of african americans susie king taylor on her life as a laundress and nurse to a union regiment in the deep south elizabeth keckley mary todd lincoln s seamstress on abraham lincoln s journey to richmond after its fall elijah p marris on rising from slave to union sergeant while fighting for his freedom in kentucky letters from black soldiers to black newspapers and much more

unearths an unexpected bloom of liberty in an ex slave s journal

elisa joy white investigates the contemporary african diaspora communities in dublin new orleans and paris and their role in the interrogation of modernity and social progress beginning with an examination of dublin s emergent african immigrant community white shows how the community s negotiation of racism immigration status and xenophobia exemplifies the ways in which idealist representations of global societies are contradicted by the prevalence of racial ethnic and cultural conflicts within them through the consideration of three contemporaneous events the deportations of nigerians from dublin the aftermath of hurricane katrina in new orleans and the uprisings in the paris suburbs white reveals a shared quest for social progress in the face of stark retrogressive conditions

in *Ugly Freedoms* Elisabeth R. Anker reckons with the complex legacy of freedom offered by liberal American democracy outlining how the emphasis of individual liberty has always been entangled with white supremacy settler colonialism climate destruction economic exploitation and patriarchy these ugly freedoms legitimate the right to exploit and subjugate others at the same time Anker locates an unexpected second type of ugly freedom in practices and situations often dismissed as demeaning offensive gross and ineffectual but that provide sources of emancipatory potential she analyzes both types of ugly freedom at work in a number of texts and locations from political theory art and film to food toxic dumps and multispecies interactions whether examining how Kara Walker's *Sugar* sculpture a subtlety or the marvelous *Sugar Baby* reveals the importance of sugar plantations to liberal thought or how the impoverished neighborhoods in the *Wire* blunt neoliberalism's violence Anker shifts our perspective of freedom by contesting its idealized expressions and expanding the visions for what freedom can look like who can exercise it and how to build a world free from domination

a fascinating study of freedom and slavery told through the life of an escaped slave who built a life in the hudson valley in 1793 james f brown was born a slave and in 1868 he died a free man at age 34 he ran away from his native maryland to pass the remainder of his life as a gardener to a wealthy family in the hudson valley two years after his escape and manumission he began a diary which he kept until his death in freedom s gardener myra b young armstead uses the apparently small and domestic details of brown s diaries to construct a bigger story about the transition from slavery to freedom in this first detailed historical study of brown s diaries armstead utilizes brown s life to illuminate the concept of freedom as it developed in the united states in the early national and antebellum years that brown an african american and former slave serves as such a case study underscores the potential of american citizenship during his lifetime

reconstruction is one of the most complex overlooked and misunderstood periods of american history the thirteen essays in this volume address the multiple struggles to make good on president abraham lincoln s promise of a new birth of freedom in the years following the civil war as well as the counter efforts including historiographical ones to undermine those struggles the forms these struggles took varied enormously extended geographically beyond the former confederacy influenced political and racial thought internationally and remain open to contestation even today the fight to establish and maintain meaningful freedoms for america s black population led to the apparently concrete and permanent legal form of the three key reconstruction amendments to the u s constitution as well as the revised state constitutions but almost all of the latter were overturned by the end of the century and even the former are not necessarily out of jeopardy and it was not just the formerly enslaved who were gaining and losing freedoms struggles over freedom citizenship and rights can be seen in a variety of venues at times gaining one freedom might endanger another how we remember reconstruction and what we do with that memory continues to influence politics especially the politics of race in the contemporary united states offering analysis of educational and professional expansion legal history armed resistance the fate of black soldiers international diplomacy post 1865 and much more the essays collected here draw attention to some of the vital achievements of the reconstruction period while reminding us that freedoms can be won but they can also be lost
