the book of revelation firstly reveals christ 1 1 and secondly the testimony of jesus 1 2 in other words this book is concerned with christ and the church in revelation christ and the church are revealed in a unique and particular way several aspects of christ such as the vision of him as the high priest in the midst of the churches caring for them in love yet with a judging attitude 1 13 16 the vision of him as the lion lamb in the midst of god's throne and of the four living creatures and in the midst of the 24 elders of the universe opening the seven seals of god's universal administration 5 1 6 1 and the vision of him as another mighty angel coming down from heaven to take possession of the earth 10 1 8 18 1 have never been unveiled as they are in the book of revelation in this book the revelation of christ is unique and ultimate in addition to this ultimate revelation of christ the book of revelation also unveils many unique aspects of the church as the testimony of jesus the lampstands in chapter one the great multitude of the redeemed in chapter seven the bright woman with her man child in chapter 12 the harvest with its firstfruits in chapter 14 the overcomers on the sea of glass in chapter 15 the bride ready for marriage and the fighting army of christ in chapter 19 and the new jerusalem in chapters 21 and 22 are all the testimony of jesus which is the spirit the substance the disposition and the characteristic of the prophecy in this book 19 10 the central content of this book is an unveiling of god's economy concerning christ and the church presenting the ultimate and consummate revelation of christ with his full salvation and the church as his loving bride the new jerusalem in this book we find the full and adequate conclusion not only to the writings of john and to the new testament but also to the entire divine revelation

the theme of the book of revelation is derived from its opening sentence the revelation of jesus christ john the beloved disciple is the recipient of this revelation but jesus christ the alpha and the omega is its author the major corpus of this letter to the seven churches of asia minor has jesus christ as its principal subject christ's message to the seven churches of the apocalypse revelation transcends the barriers of time and space whatever criticisms and commendations were pronounced upon the churches of asia

minor the same are applicable to all churches which presently dispense similar attitudes and characteristics the message of the apocalypse while couched in visions and symbols and numbers is simply this the final judgment of god will be pronounced upon satan and sin and his redeemed children will be victorious over the power and dominion of satan it is my hope that you will be challenged to read and study about the seven churches in the book of revelation utilize the bibliography as a guide to additional resources on the subject

writers have analyzed the letters to the seven churches in revelation chapters 2 and 3 from various perspectives resonant or not allegorical or literal a widely taught historical view holds that the seven churches represent the overall history of the church age from pentecost to the present but a practical perspective recognizes that any of the seven churches in revelation can represent any particular local gathering at any time in the church age this study christ the judge of the seven churches of revelation provides down to earth explanations of christ s messages to the seven churches of asia minor it takes a literal conservative approach but not necessarily a traditional one this examination intertwines relevant passages of scripture with the messages to the churches highlighted with numerous practical applications it should serve as a valuable resource for anyone desiring to gain a better and fresh understanding of the first three chapters of revelation

volume 47 of the collected works is composed of two books by watchman nee on the subject of the church and authority in the church the orthodoxy of the church is based on a bible study conducted by watchman nee during the period between 1942 and 1948 this section of volume 47 has been previously published as a separate title authority and submission based on a series of messages given by watchman nee in his training at kuling mountain in 1948 through 1949 contains two distinct but related parts in 1988 the living stream ministry published the first part under the title authority and submission covering the general subject of spiritual authority and submission volume 47 of the collected works includes a second previously untranslated part covering the matter of being god s deputy authority
