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the existence and persistence of regional disparities between european regions require context tailored policies to promote structural change this book explores the congruence between place based development and regional competitiveness in the eu context drawing on a range of social science disciplines this book unpicks the complexity of regional transformation processes aiming to enhance the applicability and transferability of theoretical approaches to innovation and place based regional development in diverse european territorial settings the contributors have a particular focus on less favoured regions and on the application of smart specialisation a strategic approach to innovation based regional development to the issues at hand the book comes at a critical moment meeting the growing demand of academics practitioners and policymakers with an interest in promoting regional economic growth and well being

this report analyses the objectives targeting instruments and inter governmental role sharing used by 26 regional cluster programmes in 14 oecd countries

planning canadian regions is the first book to consolidate the history evolution current practice and future prospects for regional planning in canada as planners grapple with challenges wrought by globalization the evolution of massive new city regions and the pressures for sustainable and community economic development a deeper understanding of canada s approaches is invaluable hodge and robinson identify the intellectual and conceptual foundations of regional planning and review the history and main modes of regional planning for rural regions economic development regions resource development regions and metropolitan and city regions they draw lessons from canada s past experience and conclude by proposing a new paradigm addressing the needs of regional planning now and in the future emphasizing regional governance greater inclusiveness and integration of physical planning with planning for economic sustainability and natural ecosystems planning canadian regions will be a much needed text for students and teachers of regional planning and an indispensable reference for planning practitioners it will also find a receptive audience in such disciplines as urban planning environmental studies geography political science public administration and economics

life cycle approaches to sustainable regional development explains the ways life cycle methodologies and tools can be used to strengthen regional socio economic planning and development in a more sustainable manner the book advocates the adoption of systematic and long term criteria for development decision making taking into account the full life cycle of materials and projects it describes life cycle practices from both a scientific and a practitioner point of view highlighting examples and case studies at regional level the applications are relevant to key economic sectors as well as for internal planning and administrative procedures it concludes with a synthesis chapter that distills the key

messages from the authors into practical guidance points on how best to use such approaches to enhance sustainability in regional development the book is essential reading for regional and urban planners who are integrating life cycle thinking into their policy regimes as well as for researchers working to further evolve life cycle methodologies
