It's harder to kill people when there's a peace process on Ulster. Loyalist Alan Black is kept awake every night by his neighbour McCorrick's dog barking to add to his difficulties. McCorrick refuses to acknowledge that he even owns a dog, let alone one that is creating a disturbance in a Northern Ireland he barely recognises where politics has proved just to be the continuation of war by other means. A disconsolate Alan sets out to rid himself of the incessant noise as he seeks help from authority figures. He finally, as a very last resort, turns to the only voice he can really trust: Eamonn Holmes. Coinciding with the 100th anniversary of the partition of Ireland and the foundation of Northern Ireland, *Yes So I Said Yes* is a blackly comic, ferocious dystopian satire about what it's like to feel alone in a place where everyone else is conspiring to erase you and your history. This edition was published to coincide with the production at London's Finborough Theatre in November 2021.

From the opera house and movie palace to the modern multiplex, the big screen in Delaware is more than a century old. Hollywood legend Cary Grant visited the Playhouse Theater in 1955, fondly recalling his days on its stage as a child actor. Clint Eastwood came to Wilmington for a secret test screening of his film *The Gauntlet* at the Branmar Cinema. The groundbreaking history of star wars includes a Delaware theater that was one of only forty-five in the country to open the film. Author Michael J. Nazarewycz recounts the cinematic history of Delaware's movie theaters.

New Mexico's theatrical ties span over one hundred years. The Fountain Theatre, once a Civil War hospital and headquarters, produced plays, opera, and vaudeville performances until 1929 when the venue started airing talkies. Today it holds the title of oldest operating theatre in New Mexico. Albuquerque Drive-In attendees enjoyed personal screens for each car at the Circle Autoscope. And Rio Grande Theater operated for over seventy years before showing its final screening of *U.S. Marshals* in 1998. Author Jeff Berg details the land of enchantment's iconic movie houses.

This collection provides a representative set of theatrical performances popular on the nineteenth-century British stage. All are newly edited critical editions that account for variant sources, reflecting the process of rehearsal, licensing, and production. Detailed introductions and extensive notes explain the texts' relationship to repertoires, the circulating discourses of intelligibility that

constantly recombine in performance the plays address the topical concerns of slavery imperial conquest capitalism interculturalism uprisings at home and abroad modernist aesthetic innovation and the celebration of collective identities adaptations from novels travelogues and other plays are discussed along with the theatrical history that sustained these works on the stage

the second volume of the world encyclopedia of contemporary theatre covers the americas from canada to argentina including the united states entries on twenty six countries are preceded by specialist introductions on theatre in post colonial latin america theatres of north america puppet theatre theatre for young audiences music theatre and dance theatre the essays follow the series format allowing for cross referring across subjects both within the volume and between volumes each country entry is written by specialists in the particular country and the volume has its own teams of regional editors overseen by the main editorial team based at the university of york in canada headed by don rubin each entry covers all aspects of theatre genres practitioners writers critics and styles with bibliographies over 200 black white photographs and a substantial index this is a unique volume in its own right in conjunction with the other volumes in this series it forms a reference resource of unparalleled value

over the course of the 20th century west virginia contained an impressive diversity of movie theatres ranging from multipurpose auditoriums in company towns to early nickelodeons and from ornate urban picture palaces to neighborhood movie houses and suburban drive ins in the state s working class areas as well as in upscale districts where industry barons lived residents came together to find amusement and relaxation in these invaluable venues many of these theatres have since disappeared from the landscape while others sit vacant or have been converted for other uses some however have been reopened or restored they proudly provide their communities with entertainment today whether showing films or hosting the performing arts they serve as catalysts for local revitalization and as success stories showcasing the value of historic preservation

three timeless tales retold for the stage by one of the uk s most renowned writers of plays for children charles way winner of the writers guild best children s play award his plays appeal to audiences of all ages and are translated into several languages and performed internationally each of the three plays explores the journey from childhood to adulthood but each takes a specific angle sleeping beauty is driven by the notion of duality everyone and everything in the play has a complimentary aspect king and queen

castle and forest bright witch and dark witch etc gryff half dragon half human is the physical embodiment of the idea of duality and is at war with himself this is both dramatic since it provides the conflict needed for the drama and thematically rich since it explores what all of us but more precisely children feel as they grow up cinderella is a play about a journey from darkness to light from sickness to health everyone in the play is under the influence of some kind of loss and the play explores these feelings and the sometimes painful route one must take to accommodate them and move on in life it s a moving and beautiful play that also manages to be tremendously funny and the introduction of mozart as a character whose music charts the whole journey toward light and joy is a theatrical coup where cinderella has music at its core beauty and the beast has dance this is a play about overcoming fear and the subconscious world is represented through imagery and movement the play begins with a startling dream sequence and then segues into the drawing room world of a jane austen novel before moving to the wilds of dartmoor throughout this journey one is never sure if the play is in dreamtime or not and way connects this feeling to the very act of theatre itself as ever the themes are explored through dramatic action and the result in beauty and the beast is a script of rare brevity that allows actors and directors room to explore the profound nature of the story

the story of downtown chicago its early development later struggles and current restoration is mirrored in the history of the theatres that occupied its streets this vivid chronicle tells the tale of the windy city s theatres from mid nineteenth century vaudeville houses to the urban decline and renewal of the twentieth and twenty first centuries discussed are the rebuilding efforts after the great chicago fire of 1871 the first nickel theaters showing moving pictures the ornate silent movie palaces the move to talkies the challenges of the great depression and the introduction of television and urban decline today chicago has preserved some of its most historic movie palaces landmarks of cultural vibrancy in its reawakened downtown with nearly 200 photographs from the theatre historical society of america this work brings to life all of the theatres that have enlivened chicago s entertainment district reflecting the transformation of downtown chicago itself

broadway musicals of the 1900s saw the emergence of george m cohan and his quintessentially american musical comedies which featured contemporary american stories ragtime flavored songs and a tongue in cheek approach to musical comedy conventions but when the austrian import the merry widow opened in 1907 waltz driven operettas became all the rage in the complete book of

now i m dead there ll be changes i won t keep rolling over i won t wag my tail at every insult and injury kathleen duggan has rushed home to ireland upon hearing the news that her mother maisie has died only when she gets back to the house she finds that her mother is alive and well almost however after a routine car accident maisie believes that she is now dead and wandering around the homestead awaiting her funeral still able to talk to her childish adult son and her violent temperamental husband she will no longer be silenced by the male dominated pugnacious atmosphere that has kept her quiet all these years so when kathleen comes back for the funeral maisie expects to find her final resting place safe from the threat of domestic violence once and for all the remains of maisie duggan received its world premiere on the peacock stage of the abbey theatre dublin in autumn 2016

silent films were of course never silent at all however the sound that used to accompany the screen picture in the early days of cinema has been neglected as an area of study altman explores the various musical narrative and even synchronized sound systems that enriched cinema before jolson spoke

in nigeria a frightened child puts an old roll of film into the hands of dublin bound teacher sister martha in dublin ex con larry with a wounded backside has to get out of the city to rob a convent meanwhile scarab oil plans to unleash its new clean fuel of the future the film roll martha is carrying attracts the urgent interest of some very powerful and ambitious people a play written for two actors and filled with memorable characters little thing big thing is the latest production from the innovative and outstanding irish theatre company fishamble

you haven't asked but yes you both may stay in our house for the time being and use our things I figure it'll take a war to settle it all a compelling story of two families one palestinian one israeli forced by history into an intimacy they didn't choose in 1948 palestinian couple said and safiyya fled their home during the nakba now in the aftermath of the 1967 six day war the borders are open for the first time in twenty years and they dare to return to their home in haifa they are ready to find someone else living where they once did but nothing can prepare them for the encounter they both desire and dread with the son they had to leave behind ghassan kanafani's classic novella returning to haifa has been adapted for the stage by naomi wallace and ismail khalidi the play premiered at the finborough theatre london in february 2018 to coincide with the seventieth anniversaries of both the nakba or catastrophe the mass dispossession of the palestinians in 1948 and the foundation of the state of israel

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
