- 4 Odds Ratio and Relative Risk Odds ratio and relative risk are measures of association used in categorical data analysis They quantify the strength of the relationship between two variables Example An odds ratio could be calculated to compare the odds of developing a disease among people exposed to a risk factor versus those who are not exposed
- 5 Data Visualization for Categorical Data Data visualization plays a critical role in understanding and communicating
