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traces the history and development of the anti war movement in america profiling key figures and events in the movement that have had a significant impact on how americans view war

between 1965 and 1973 hundreds of thousands of ordinary americans participated in one of the most remarkable and significant people s movements in american history through marches rallies draft resistance teach ins civil disobedience and non violent demonstrations at both the national and local levels americans vehemently protested the country s involvement in the vietnam war rethinking the american anti war movement provides a short accessible overview of this important social and political movement highlighting key events and key figures the movement s strengths and weaknesses how it intersected with other social and political movements of the time and its lasting effect on the country the book is perfect for anyone wanting to obtain an introduction to the anti war movement of the twentieth century

written by veterans of the vietnam war and participants in the organized opposition to it this book examines how the activities of america s most important anti war movement affected the lives of its citizens and its government relying on oral histories and recently available archival material the authors consider the movement s strategies and tactics its leaders and its rank and file and describe the difficulties encountered by peace activists in their efforts to build politically effective organizations what emerges from this collection is that the millions of americans who fought against the government s policies in southeast asia participated in one of the most potent and complex oppositional movements in modern history

in this book ian taylor examines how a social movement the anti iraq war movement in the uk engaged with the media as a part of their campaigning against the invasion and occupation of iraq moving beyond content analysis to draw upon interviews with locally based journalists and activists taylor examines how locally based anti war groups engaged with their local press as

well as how those groups were reported on by the local press in their respective areas in the process of exploring these ideas the book takes on questions like how did local journalists assess the legitimacy of the anti war movement how why and to what extent did opponents of the war pursue local press coverage what bearing did the social composition of the movement have on the way they set about engaging with the media how did the local press handle the controversy surrounding opposition to military action against iraq media relations of the anti war movement makes a unique contribution to research on the interactions between social movements and the media and plugs a major gap in the literature on the iraq war and the media

in this first comprehensive comparison of left wing violence in the united states and west germany jeremy varon focuses on america s weather underground and germany s red army faction to consider how and why young middle class radicals in prosperous democratic societies turned to armed struggle in efforts to overthrow their states based on a wealth of primary material ranging from interviews to fbi reports this book reconstructs the motivation and ideology of violent organizations active during the 1960s and 1970s varon conveys the intense passions of the era the heat of moral purpose the depth of utopian longing the sense of danger and despair and the exhilaration over temporary triumphs varon s compelling interpretation of the logic and limits of dissent in democratic societies provides striking insights into the role of militancy in contemporary protest movements and has wide implications for the united states current war on terrorism varon explores weatherman and raf s strong similarities and the reasons why radicals in different settings developed a shared set of values languages and strategies addressing the relationship of historical memory to political action varon demonstrates how germany s fascist past influenced the brutal and escalating nature of the west german conflict in the 60s and 70s as well as the reasons why left wing violence dropped sharply in the united states during the 1970s bringing the war home is a fascinating account of why violence develops within social movements how states can respond to radical dissent and forms of terror how the rational and irrational can combine in political movements and finally how moral outrage and militancy can play both constructive and destructive roles in efforts at social change

this book offers a dispassionate strategic examination of the vietnam conflict that challenges the conventional wisdom that south vietnam could not survive as an independent non communist entity over the long term regardless of how the united states conducted its military political effort in indochina

party in the street explores the interaction between political parties and social movements in the united states examining the collapse of the post 9 11 antiwar movement against the wars in iraq and afghanistan this book focuses on activism and protest in the united states it argues that the electoral success of the democratic party and president barack obama as well as antipathy toward president george w bush played a greater role in this collapse than did changes in foreign policy it shows that how people identify with social movements and political parties matters a great deal and it considers the tea party and occupy wall street as comparison cases

this book explores why new social movement tactics spread to some places and not others

agitation with a smile offers a reappraisal of howard zinn s political thought and situates his efforts in a contemporary context looking toward the nature of activism and dissent in the future this is the first book to provide a substantive account and assessment of zinn s philosophy and approach to collective action and to a larger extent democracy the contributors to this book explore the most effective mechanisms by which to arouse public support for seemingly radical positions and how current technological advancements may alter our perception of zinn s activism the book is a valuable guide to a new generation of activists and scholars of politics in gauging the lasting relevance and legacy of zinn s ideals concepts and methodology the text is neither fawning nor unduly critical unlike many discussions of zinn in popular culture rather the contributors engage the various complexities and tensions present throughout zinn s work and subject them to contemporary assessment this is a multidisciplinary and international approach to howard zinn s intellectual and activist canon

largely unexamined until recently the asian american movement has been active for more than two decades william wei traces to the late 1960s the initial genesis of an asian american identity culture and activism through which members of this pan asian group could assert their right to belong to and be respected as responsible members of this society although its antecedents were the civil rights and black power movements the asian american movement actually resulted from the protests against the vietnam war and the emergence of a generation of college aged chinese and japanese americans in this definitive study of the asian american movement wei fills an important gap in our knowledge of ethnic social movements and the struggle to achieve american cultural democracy lacking a nationally known leader but confronted by many shared issues and concerns the asian american movement was essentially a middle class reform effort to achieve racial equality social justice and political empowerment it focused on ethnic solidarity and self empowerment through political activism educational and community development and cultural expressions while the movement was most visible on the west coast notably at the third world strike at san francisco state college in 1968 it became a vital force simultaneously on campuses and in asian american communities throughout the country wei evaluates the movement s effort to develop a unique but cohesive ethnic identity and the internal struggles between reformist and revolutionary approaches to social change he analyzes the asian american women s movement the alternative press asian american studies programs community based organizations andmaoist sects his study concludes with an examination of asian american involvement in electoral politics and the quest for political empowerment interviews with many of the key participants in the movement and photographs of asian american demonstrations and events enhance wei s portrayal of the development and breadth of the movement and the conflicts within it exploring regional differences issues of ethnicity class and gender and the transition from radical to electoral politics wei s comprehensive study is the first book to examine systematically the coming to consciousness and mobilization of asian americans
