grace ann hovet contends in this study of novels written by middle class white
american women from 1850 to the contemporary period that their portrayals of
the development of female identity adds a great deal of supporting evidence
to the assertion of several influential psychologists social scientists and
philosophers that while identity is surely shaped in part by culture and social
structures it is also unique to each individual in the words of mark tappan in
narratives and story telling an inner self defines itself through an ongoing
dialogue between the internally persuasive discourse of individual
consciousness and the authoritarian enforced discourse of the dominant
culture and institutions 1991 18 in the novels considered here much of the inner

discourse is performed the female protagonist understands that she is expected to act out the accepted feminine role as a consequence the inner self expresses itself through the conscious manipulation of the image for this reason professor hovet argues that tableaux vivants provide an apt central metaphor for the development of female identity in these novels these living pictures consist of individuals usually women carefully costumed and posed to replicate famous scenes from history and the arts in the nineteenth century these tableaux evolved in the united states into an extremely popular parlor game or entertainment interlude in middle class social gatherings in the novels lily barts portrayal of joshua reynolds's mrs lloyd in edith whartons the house of mirth provides the most vivid example but the novels also make it clear that tableaux vivants were a part of everyday life as young women learned to pose before others as the model of feminine beauty or as the angel in the house this study adds to those of susan fraiman lori merish and nancy armstrong that describe the relationship of novels to the development of middle class subjectivity in particular it explains the process by which a female subjectivity evolved in the united states from the mid nineteenth to late twentieth century employing a historical continuum professor hovet selected for study novels that she saw as most influential in the culture of the united states because of their ongoing popularity and continued presence in the culture literary historians consider susan warners the wide wide world 1850 to be america's first best seller little women 1869 has been one of the most read and loved novels at least among young female readers for more than a century and has been made into at least four well known movies with stars the caliber of katherine hepburn and winona ryder harriet beecher stowes my wife and i 1871 was hugely successful in an intensely competitive serial fiction market kate chopins the awakening 1899 has become a mainstay in literature and womens studies classrooms and has been made into at least two movies end of august and grand isle edith whartons the house of mirth 1905 was not only popular among middle class readers of the time but has become known to mass culture through the 2000 movie version margaret mitchells gone with the wind 1936 and its movie version generated the term blockbuster harper lees to kill a

mockingbird has been one of the most widely read books of the twentieth century and the movie starring gregory peck is now a cultural icon marilyn french's the women's room 1977 remains a cause celebre and mona simpson's anywhere but here 1986 was reprinted six times within two months of its publication and became a movie starring susan sarandon the study also tries to show how depictions of female identity surfaced tensions and anxieties in the dominant social discourse all the novels in this analysis are so called crossover novels the term crossover has become common in culture studies particularly in analyses of the way some works reach a large enough audience to breach the walls that t

the first biography of the extraordinary essayist critic and short story writer elizabeth hardwick author of the semiautobiographical novel *sleepless nights* born in kentucky elizabeth hardwick left for new york city on a greyhound bus in 1939 and quickly made a name for herself as a formidable member of the intellectual elite her eventful life included stretches of dire poverty romantic escapades and dustups with authors she eviscerated in the new york review of books of which she was a cofounder she formed lasting friendships with literary notables including mary mccarthy adrienne rich and susan sontag who appreciated her sharp wit and relish for gossip progressive politics and great literature hardwick s life and writing were shaped by a turbulent marriage to the poet robert lowell whom she adored standing by faithfully through his episodes of bipolar illness lowell s decision to publish excerpts from her private letters in the *dolphin* greatly distressed hardwick and ignited a major literary controversy hardwick emerged from the scandal with the clarity and wisdom that illuminate her brilliant work most notably *sleepless nights* a daring lyrical and keenly perceptive collage of reflections and glimpses of people encountered as they stumble through lives of deprivation or privilege a splendid intelligence finally gives hardwick her due as one of the great postwar cultural critics ranging over a broad territory from the depiction of women in

donald j greiner s provocative new study evaluates the fiction of ten contemporary female novelists to ask questions about gender relations in american fiction looking closely at the reaction of female writers to what greiner describes as a central paradigm of american literature men bonding in the wilderness in an attempt to escape women and the social restrictions they represent greiner contends that female novelists have not only adopted the venerable model but also adapted it so that women venture into the wilderness while excluding men from the quest greiner first shows how such contemporary white male novelists as frederick busch john irving and larry woiwode modify the literary model established by cooper melville and twain to include women in the bonding process he then argues that recent female novelists are not so eager to allow males into the wilderness or to bond with them rather than facilitate a closing of the gender gap many contemporary female writers insist on separating the sexes greiner frames his analysis with discussions of prominent feminist literary theorists and feminist psychologists including carolyn heilbrun rachel brownstein nancy chodorow janice raymond and judith kegan gardiner from close readings of recent novels by gloria naylor marianne wiggins joan didion diane johnson marilynne robinson mona

simpson hilma wolitzer meg wolitzer joan chase and lisa alther greiner finds three significant differences in the way contemporary female novelists employ the quest plot the patriarchal text is not repudiated but revised to accommodate female characters who readily accept the traditional masculine call to the quest once outside the bounds of society female bonds do not always hold males are excluded from the bonding process to contrast the gender exclusivity favored by contemporary female writers greiner ends his study with a discussion of bonding as portrayed by contemporary male novelist douglas ungar

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
