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a history of celebrity from byron to beckham love it or hate it celebrity is one of the dominant features of modern life and one of the least understood fred inglis sets out to correct this problem in this entertaining and enlightening social history

of modern celebrity from eighteenth century london to today s hollywood vividly written and brimming with fascinating stories of figures whose lives mark important moments in the history of celebrity this book explains how fame has changed over the past two and a half centuries starting with the first modern celebrities in mid eighteenth century london including samuel johnson and the prince regent the book traces the changing nature of celebrity and celebrities through the age of the romantic hero the european fin de siècle and the gilded age in new york and chicago in the twentieth century the book covers the jazz age the rise of political celebrities such as mussolini hitler and stalin and the democratization of celebrity in the postwar decades as actors rock stars and sports heroes became the leading celebrities arguing that celebrity is a mirror reflecting some of the worst as well as some of the best aspects of modern history itself inglis considers how the lives of the rich and famous provide not only entertainment but also social cohesion and like morality plays examples of what and what not to do this book will interest anyone who is curious about the history that lies behind one of the great preoccupations of our lives some images inside the book are unavailable due to digital copyright restrictions

a bestselling history of medicine enriched with a new foreword concluding essay and bibliographic essay erwin h ackerknecht s a short history of medicine is a concise narrative long appreciated by students in the history of medicine medical students historians and medical professionals as well as all those seeking to understand the history of medicine covering the broad sweep of discoveries from parasitic worms to bacilli and x rays and highlighting physicians and scientists from hippocrates and galen to pasteur koch and roentgen ackerknecht narrates western and eastern civilization s work at identifying and curing disease he follows these discoveries from the library to the bedside hospital and laboratory illuminating how basic biological sciences interacted with clinical practice over time but his story is more than one of laudable scientific and therapeutic achievement ackerknecht also points toward the social ecological economic and political conditions that shape the incidence of disease improvements in health ackerknecht argues depend on more than laboratory knowledge they also require that we improve the lives of ordinary men and women by altering social conditions such as poverty and hunger this revised and expanded edition includes a new foreword and concluding biographical essay by charles e rosenberg ackerknecht s former student and a distinguished historian of medicine a new bibliographic essay by lisa haushofer explores recent scholarship in the history of medicine

this complete revision and updating of professor robins classic text offers a comprehensive account of the history of linguistic thought from its european origins some 2500 years ago to the present day it examines the independent development of linguistic science in china and medieval islam and especially in india which was to have a profound effect on european and american linguistics from the end of the eighteenth century the fourth edition of a short history of linguistics gives a

greater prominence to the work of wilhelm von humboldt because of the lasting importance of his work on language in relation to general eighteenth century thinking and of its perceived relevance in the latter half of the twentieth century to several aspects of generative grammatical theory the final section covering the twentieth century has been rewritten and divided into two new chapters so as to deal effectively with the increasingly divergent development of descriptive and theoretical linguistics that took place in the latter half of this century readable and authoritative professor robins introduction provides a clear and up to date overview of all the major issues in the light of contemporary scholarly debate and will be essential reading for undergraduate and graduate students of linguistics alike
