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watson traces gertrude stein s 1874 1946 growing fascination with the cognitive and political ramifications of conversation and how that interest influenced her writing over the course of her career

after the second world war gertrude stein asked a friend s support in securing a visa for richard wright to visit paris i ve got to help him she said you see we are both members of a minority group the brief little noted friendship of stein and wright began in 1945 with a letter over the next fifteen months the two kept up a lively correspondence which culminated in wright s visit to paris in may 1946 and ended with stein s death a few months later gertrude stein and richard wright began their careers as marginals within marginalized groups and their desire to live peacefully in unorthodox marriages led them away from america and into permanent exile in france still the obvious differences between them in class ethnic and racial origins and in artistic expression beg the question what was there to talk about this question opens a window onto each writer s meditations on the influence of racial ethnic national origins on the formation of identity in a modern and post modern world the intuitive and intellectual affinities between stein and wright

are illuminated in several works of nonfiction stein's paris france and wright's pagan spain are meditations on expatriation and creativity their so called homecoming narratives stein's everybody's autobiography and wright's black power examine concepts of racial and national identity in a post modernist world respectively in lectures in america and white man listen stein and wright outline the ways in which the poetics and politics of modernism are inextricably bound at the close of the twentieth century the meditations of stein and wright on the protean quality of individual identity and its artistic social and political expression explore the most prescient and pressing issues of our time and beyond

this book shows that modernist literature creatively negotiated the same issues of data processing that cybernetics technologies would later tackle

offers pedagogical techniques for teaching the prose poetry plays and libretti of gertrude stein in college literature and composition classrooms including consideration of race gender sexuality narrative diversity identity and visual arts includes information on reference works and online resources gives syllabus suggestions for undergraduate and graduate courses

this title reads into a relationship that made strange bedfellows of modernism and fascism it tells how in 1941 jewish american writer and avant garde icon gertrude stein embarked on one of the strangest intellectual projects of her life translating for an american audience the speeches of marshal philippe pétain

apocalypse and after examines the development of modernism into postmodernism through the works of three major american poets modernism's struggle to develop a new global strategy was to a great extent a response to the catastrophe of world war i while the postmodern resort to fragmentary tactics stems from modernist strategy's implications in world war ii and the atomic bomb the final chapter adumbrates the emergence of a paramodernism characteristic of our own time the book is innovative in its many readings of specific poems and in its larger assessments of the poets careers while the method of analysis it develops is particularly noteworthy for its ability to relate nuances of formal innovation to the writers diverse political contexts and programs

remaking the conquering heroes shows that american policymakers and army officers had to confront and take control over a lawless us military in the aftermath of world war ii money laundering theft racial antagonism between black and white gis unregulated sex and high rates of venereal disease threatened to undermine american authority in occupied germany as much as soviet american conflict willoughby argues that it was the creative if disorganized reaction of american officials in germany that helped create both a foreign policy framework and more inclusive familial military establishment capable of consolidating and extending us power during the cold war

examineshow surrealism enriches our understanding of stein's writing through its poetics of oppositions gertrude stein's surrealist years brings to life stein's surrealist sensibilities and personal values borne from her wwii anxieties not least of which originated in a dread of anti semitism stein's earlier works such as tender buttons and lucy church amiably tend to prioritize formal innovations over narrative building and overt political motifs however ery shin argues that stein's later works engage more with storytelling and life writing in startling ways most emphatically and poignantly through the surrealist lens beginning with the autobiography of alice b toklas and continuing in later works stein renders legible her war torn era's jarring dystopian energies through narratives filled with hallucinatory visions teleportation extreme coincidences action reversals doppelgangers dream sequences spanning both sleeping and waking states and great whiffs of the occult such surrealist gestures are predicated on stein's return to the independent clause and by extension to plot characterization and anecdotes by summoning the marvelous in a historically situated world stein joins her surrealist contemporaries in their own ambivalent crusade on behalf of historiography besides illuminating stein's art and life the surrealist framework developed here brings readers deeper into those philosophical ideas invoked by war topics of discussion emphasize how varied jewish experiences were in hitler's europe how outliers like stein can be included in the surrealist project surrealism's theoretical bind in the face of wwii and the age old question of artistic legacy

definitions of modernism have been debated throughout the twentieth century but both during the height of the modernist era and since little to no consideration has been given to the work of minority writers as part of this movement considering works by writers ranging from b a botkin t s eliot waldo frank and jean toomer to pedro pietri and allen ginsberg these essays examine the disputed relationships between modernity modernism

and american cultural diversity in so doing the collection as a whole adds an important new dimension to our understanding of twentieth century literature

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
