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an invaluable modelers guide to the bf 109 g and k variations when the bf 109 was first designed in 1934 by a team led by willy messerschmitt and robert lusser its primary role was that of a high speed short range bomber interceptor the bf 109 was also designed to take advantage of the most advanced aerodynamics of the time and embodied structural techniques which were an advance on its contemporaries in the years of the blitzkrieg the bf 109 was the only single engined fighter operated by the luftwaffe until the appearance of the fw 190 the g series or gustav was introduced in mid 1942 its initial variants g 1 through g 4 differed only in minor details from the bf 109f most notably in being powered by the more powerful 1475 ps db 605 engine the final production version of the bf 109 was the k series or kurfurst powered by the db 605d engine with up to 2 000 ps output and introduced in the autumn of 1944 though externally akin to the late production bf 109g series a large number of detail internal and aerodynamic improvements were incorporated to the design that improved its effectiveness and remedied existing flaws keeping the fighter competitive with the latest allied and soviet fighters

one of the most significant innovations in modern warfare has been the appearance and development of air power a technology which demanded technical and financial investment on a whole new scale and which ultimately changed the fundamental nature of war itself this book covers the history and development of the german air force from 1935 to 1945 with descriptions and illustrations of almost all of the luftwaffe s airplanes including fighters jet fighters dive bombers ground attackers medium and heavy bombers jet bombers seaplanes flying boats and carrier planes transport and gliders reconnaissance and training aircrafts helicopters and many futuristic projects and other rarities

from the nascent days of the spanish civil war to the desperate final defence of the stricken reich the messerschmitt bf 109 was the luftwaffe s signature fighter from the very beginning of its combat career it came to symbolize what could be achieved with a modern monoplane fighter aircraft instilling fear and respect into allied pilots wherever it was encountered 35 000 of the ubiquitous messerschmitts were eventually built making it the most produced fighter in history this is the first air vanguard volume to cover the bf 109 detailing models a d featuring stunning aerial photos the title explores in depth the technical characteristics and combat performance of the early bf 109s including their combat debut in the spanish civil war their employment in the invasion of poland and showing how the type became one of the most famous names in aviation history

featuring a series of increasingly complex construction projects this title details the early and pre war variants of this key aircraft including the bf 109s that flew in the spanish civil war poland france and the battle of britain the messerschmitt bf 109 was the most prominent german fighter type of world war ii over 35 000 were built and it served in many different variants and roles throughout the course of the war it was the true workhorse of the german luftwaffe throughout the war and continued in front line service with some european countries for many years afterwards with detailed text and photography throughout this guide also discusses the numerous kits available of this famous fighter

the collector s guide to 3rd reich tableware addresses this much overlooked collectible area in detail it extensively documents the items with over 600 photos graphics some 470 pages and over 50 000 words of text primarily to illuminate the relevance of the collectibles to the history makers and organizations that generated them mr yannes previous books on 3rd reich spoons and later cutlery culminate in this seminal work a must for both collectors and history buffs interested in the 3rd reich

the dramatic story of franz von werra famously the only axis pow to succeed in escaping and make it home during the second world war is told in the 1957 movie the one that got away the film details von werra s interrogation by raf intelligence in 1940 presenting an enlightening but compressed version of his treatment following his capture in the battle of britain the script revealed a little of the tactics of his raf interrogators which so impressed von werra that he was quick to tell the luftwaffe high command upon his return to germany in 1941 of course von werra was just one of many luftwaffe airmen captured during 1939 and 1940 many if not all were subject to processing and interrogation having been taken prisoner information was gleaned through private discussions between senior officers and some lower ranks obtained via covert microphones as well as interrogation stool pigeons

however these tactics had been developed in the first months of the war and with the battle of Britain producing vast quantities of POWs the new tactics were honed on these unsuspecting guinea pigs the German airmen most of whom at this stage of the war believed that victory was inevitable provided air intelligence both wittingly and unwittingly with a treasure trove of information which covered not only technical and tactical intelligence but also possible war crimes morale and more air intelligence used tactics that any modern interrogator would recognise the RAF also built up quite a library of information much of it coming from what we now call open source material this included newspapers magazines radio broadcasts and information from previous prisoners carefully collated and analysed in time air intelligence built up a detailed picture of pilots aircraft units and the general social situation around a unit or airfield community this book examines the development of air intelligence and its interrogation of Luftwaffe airmen from 1939 to the end of the 1940 providing a fascinating insight into a little known part of both the battle of Britain and the Blitz

the focke wulf fw 190 was a versatile and formidable luftwaffe fighter dominating multiple wwii fronts the focke wulf fw 190 was arguably the luftwaffe s most outstanding piston engine fighter of the second world war virtually dominating the skies over europe for more than a year after its initial introduction into service in the summer of 1941 continual development and improvements then kept it at the forefront of operations in the theaters of northern europe the mediterranean and the eastern front for the remainder of the war while maintaining a competitive edge over many other types as well as gaining and retaining the grudging respect of those allied pilots who faced it in combat despite being designed as a fighter the bmw 801 powered fw 190 sub types performed practically every role possible for a single engine single seat aircraft including offensive and defensive day fighter day and night fighter bomber ground attack reconnaissance platform night fighter and trainer the fw 190a also served in the hungarian air force during the later stages of the second world war the turkish air force from mid 1942 to 1948 and post war with the french where the sncac aircraft company rebuilt over fifty fw 190a 5 a 6s under the designation nc 900 for service with the new armée de l air despite having standard factory applied camouflage and markings schemes many fw 190s were also finished in a variety of on unit and seasonal and or operational theater schemes which add to the aircraft s story

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
