this edition firmly anchors the novel in its cultural moment both highlighting the imperial history against which it was written and offering a robust sampling of its reception history this new edition is rich nuanced and urgently needed patricia matthew montclair state university on the surface persuasion is a simple story of love loss and reunion but the realities of early nineteenth century life become poignantly clear in jane austen s brilliant hands though never overtly political as norton s third critical edition of persuasion demonstrates austen is surprisingly adept at treating global concerns and understanding the triumphs and tragedies of the turbulent changes that marked her world rebecca posusta university of colorado colorado springs

although history records that the british nineteenth century was obsessed with order conventionality and conformity there were many victorians from all walks of life across lines of class race and gender who

resisted social mores and sometimes the laws themselves in a variety of ways and to varying degrees some expressed dissension through music art literature and social protest others were more subtle like manipulative wives who gained what they wanted while seemingly remaining docile and submissive some rebellion fermented into social and political movements the revolt of still others was extremely executed by serial killers criminals and suicides contemporary readers can learn from these rebels and discern what values and ways that were uniquely victorian should be retained and those that should be rejected after having observed their outcomes to that end this collection of essays offers a study for both novice and expert on victorian rebels

the author argues that renaissance humanism created a system of bigotry and eroded the practice of christianity and that shakespeare attempted to expose and condemn that shift the book examines six of his plays titus andronicus the merchant of venice hamlet othello king lear and macbeth and explores how they satirized humanism s grounding in aristotle s philosophy of slavery and supremacy shakespeare used characters like hamlet and aaron the moor to attack that bigotry and his stance against racism and humanism revealed his catholic faith

this third norton critical edition of hardy's final novel has been revised to reflect the breadth of responses it has received over the last fifteen years the text of the novel is again based on hardy's final revision for the 1912 wessex edition the norton critical edition also includes expanded footnotes by ralph pite further drawing out hardy's web of allusions and comprehensively indicating the material culture in which he embeds this narrative a selection of hardy's poems four of them new to the third edition that emphasizes the biographical contexts from which parts of *Jude the Obscure* arose eighteen critical responses including eleven modern essays eight of them new to the third edition simon gatrell michael hollington elaine showalter victor luftig and mary jacobus are among the new voices a chronology and revised and expanded selected bibliography

there is no better introduction to the ambitions and contradictions of the english renaissance than doctor faustus christopher marlowe's remarkable tragedy of intellectual overreaching marlowe's play tells the story of faustus a famous medieval german scholar bored by all the disciplines he has mastered he turns to magic ultimately summoning the demon mephistopheles who arranges for faustus to make a deal with the devil faustus's soul in exchange for mephistopheles's service and twenty four years of magical power this norton critical edition of the play features the two early versions of marlowe's play the a text from 1604 and b text from 1616 each with detailed annotations it also includes a rich array of supplementary materials that provide background and criticism in sources and contexts there are primary documents from marlowe's era including a letter charging marlowe with heresy records of early performances of the play and a generous selection from marlowe's source an early english translation of the german prose history of doctor faustus there are also modern scholarly accounts of marlowe's biography of the relation of the variant two texts and of the history of renaissance magic and religion in the section of criticism early and contemporary critics provide suggestive analyses of the play through various lenses each revealing the play's complicated relation to the social political and religious worlds in which the play was written and engaged by audiences and readers

in the dominant world view of the western middle ages natura evoked divine power as manifested in creation nature was an all pervasive force synonymous with god and his visible handiwork but also a cosmic principle associated with fate and predestination in the neoplatonic tradition this volume of student essays tackles nature in a range of physical and metaphysical guises always centred on its representation in medieval english literature it contains studies of the visible natural world in elegiac homiletic and apocalyptic literature but it also addresses other faces of nature from the naked human form to the medieval reception of ancient ideas about free will and closes with a comparative analysis of the nature of wisdom in old english and the lord of the rings

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
