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the pre columbian culture of the mississippi woodlands has received surprisingly little attention from historians studying this culture which was in many respects highly advanced opens an entirely new perspective on what we are used to thinking of as american history this essay by a distinguished historian and teacher is aimed at world history classes and other classes that cover the americas before the arrival of the europeans

for thousands of years before the arrival of christopher columbus and the europeans the vast american landscape was home to millions of native americans whose ancestors still remain on the land today they formed a wide variety of regional cultures dotting the unspoiled environs stretching from the stark red rock formations of the southwest to the thick forestlands of the northeast through descriptive and captivating text enhanced by detailed images and informative sidebars readers will examine how each indian culture group adapted to their unique surroundings and turned nature into home as they built their houses hunted for food raised their children and worshiped their gods

if you were a boy growing up in pre columbian america you would learn how to hunt grow crops or fish for your dinner if you were a girl you d learn how to skin animals and use the hides to make clothing or twist the fibers of plants to make yarn you might also be a builder taking bark and sewing it to saplings to make a shelter called a wigwam even though you wouldn t go to school you d learn everything you needed to know to become a happy and healthy member of society older members of the clan would teach you find out how the many cultures across the land from the thules and the iroquois to the people of the great plains lived loved and celebrated life in the americas before european settlement

most historical narratives about africans in america begin with jamestown virginia where enslaved angolans were sold in 1619 however

this book commences with blacks as explorers in the americas before christopher columbus arrival the point here is to demonstrate that slavery robbed africa of its heritage and impoverished the continent once africans landed in america as slaves state laws denied them civil rights and humane treatment the hopelessness brutalization and alienation of blacks aroused the conscientiousness of humanitarian groups to seek the repatriation of freed men to their ancestry homeland in africa away from anglo americans this became a risky rescue mission which put the acs in direct opposition with anti colonizationists this book highlights the complicity of the precarious endeavor and the founding of the first african republic on the continent
