denationalizing identities explores the relationship between performance and ideology in the global sinosphere wah guan lim s study of four important diasporic director playwrights gao xingjian stan lai sheng chuan danny yung ning tsun and kuo pao kun shows the impact of theater on ideas of chineseness across china taiwan hong kong and singapore at the height of the cold war the bamboo curtain divided the two chinas across the taiwan strait meanwhile hong kong prepared for its handover to the people s republic of china and singapore rethought chinese education as geopolitical tensions imposed ethno nationalist identities across the region these four dramatists wove together local foreign and chinese elements in their art challenging mainland china s narrative of an inevitable communist outcome by performing cultural identities alternative to the ones sanctioned by their own states they debunked notions of a unified chineseness denationalizing identities highlights the key role theater and performance played in circulating people and ideas across the chinese speaking world well before cross strait relations began to thaw

patriotism do you have it how does one express it is it worth it the singapore trilogy consisting of are you there singapore one year back home and changi has raised questions since the seventies about nationhood that we are still asking today influential in steering early english language theatre in singapore away from its colonial roots robert yeo conceived of characters that are believably local in speech thought and behaviour and provided a dramatic platform for the dialogue of politically sensitive issues yeo's trilogy continues to link to an exciting time of sociopolitical flux in singapore's history and engages by provoking us to explore the meaning of being singaporean this edition of these three landmark playscripts is accompanied by a new introduction from the playwright as well as a reappraisal by nah dominic and adeeb fazah who restaged the entire trilogy in one single condensed adaptation in march 2021

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explores the vibrant relationships between theatre cultural politics and social attitudes in a country whose history has many lessons for western scholars

although children s theatre has been a part of american culture from early times historians have not always included it in the documentation of our theatrical heritage sometimes more the product of the educator and the social worker than the producer or the theatre artist theatre with and for young people has been neglected in traditional theatre history studies yet as early as 1792 charles stearns began creating his plays and dialogues for school children the traditions and success of eighteenth century school drama inspired social workers to explore similar activities in their playground and settlement house work and at the end of the nineteenth and the beginning of the twentieth century professional producers began experimenting more vigorously with the commercial possibilities of children as audience this book is a collection of essays by leading authorities in the field on various aspects of the historical development of children s theatre in the united states the discussions focus on the marked differences that have occurred from group to group and examine the ways in which children s theatre began to find definition as theorists and writers such as winifred ward and charlotte choppening strove to articulate the differences between the child as participant in creative drama and the child as audience member the introduction provides a review of early concepts and the evolution of present day thought and the essays illuminate facets of the rich and varied history of american theatre with and for children this trailblazing study will serve as the beginning of a fuller understanding of the field and a challenge to others to document the missing pieces
