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what can the fantasy of the twilight saga teach us about reality cindy biondi gobrecht says i never liked vampire stories and here i am a self proclaimed twi hard the stories are about more than vampires the saga is about love devotion sacrifice heartache courage and faith to name a few these are things i can relate to in my own life and my christian faith the characters in twilight are heroic in relation to these qualities i aspire to be heroic through my faith in christ

in a departure from current theologically focused scholarship on ghanaian theologian kwame bediako this book places him within the wider historical continuum of twentieth century ghana and reads him as a leading christian scholar within the african study of african religions the book traces a variety of influences and figures within this emerging african discourse in ghana including aspects of missions and colonial history and the voices of poets politicians prophets and priests locating bediako within this complex twentieth century matrix this intellectual history draws upon his published and key unpublished works including his first masters and doctoral dissertations on négritude literature an abiding influence on his later christian thought and an essential foundation for interpreting this scholar this book also reads the akrofi christaller institute of theology mission and culture as text by bediako revealing essential components of his intellectual and spiritual itinerary revealed in the institute s community and curriculum this approach challenges narrowly focused theological scholarship on bediako while highlighting critical

methodological divisions between african western confessional and non confessional approaches to the study of religion in africa in doing so it highlights the rich complexity of this emerging african discourse and identifies bediako as a pioneering african christian intellectual within this wider field

the book also features cross references throughout a bibliography accompanying each entry an elaborate appendix listing biographies according to particular categories of interest and a comprehensive index book jacket

this work is an attempt at a verbal connexion between the greek and the english texts of the new testament the plan proposed was this to present in alphabetical succession every word which occurs in the greek new testament with the series of passages quoted from the english translation in which each such word occurs the word or words exhibiting the greek word under immediate consideration being printed in italic letters schmid s concordance to the new testament was taken as the basis introduction to the first edition

this study explores the reception history of the lord s prayer in the ghanaian context after presenting the current state of research in the lord s prayer from an exegetical perspective this book discusses a wide field of hermeneutical approaches such as inculturation biblical hermeneutics mother tongue biblical hermeneutics african feminist biblical hermeneutics liberation biblical hermeneutics and post colonial biblical hermeneutics taking the discussions of these approaches together it was realised that the general hermeneutical setting in ghana and africa as whole is reader centred i e the readers play an active role in the hermeneutical process and the results of the hermeneutical process are aimed at the readers contexts and the transformation of those contexts

in recent decades african scholarship has stressed the importance of regional oral traditions in academic learning with this broad knowledge base in african studies significant categories of socio religious learning have been closely studied this volume focuses on the notion of spirit as understood by the akan people of west africa clifford owusu gyamfi is a systematic theologian from ghana who lives in switzerland mth from the university of lausanne and phd from the university of geneva
