streamline communication and improve customer engagement Action As a result we exceeded our initial launch sales target by 20 and received consistently positive customer feedback Result This collaboration demonstrated my ability to lead and motivate a team towards success while fostering a positive and productive work environment Key Takeaways This example clearly defines the situation task action and result The performance statement exceeded our initial launch sales target by 20 quantifies the impact of the teams efforts Crafting Powerful Performance Statements Focus on quantifiable results Numbers speak volumes Use them to showcase the tangible impact of your work Use strong verbs Active verbs make your performance statements more impactful Instead of helped say led or implemented Be specific Avoid vague statements Provide concrete details that demonstrate your skills Tailor your examples Match your responses to the specific requirements of the role and company Research the companys values and priorities beforehand Common Competency Examples Communication Describe a time you effectively communicated complex information to a diverse audience Problem Solving Tell us about a time you identified a problem and implemented a solution Leadership Share an example of a time you led a team or project successfully 3 Time Management Describe how you manage your time effectively to meet deadlines Adaptability Share an example of a time you had to adjust to a new situation or unexpected challenges Practice Makes Perfect The key to excelling in competencybased interviews is practice Think about your past experiences and prepare detailed examples for common competencies Practice articulating them clearly and concisely Remember your performance statements are your strongest allies in showcasing your skills and potential By crafting compelling examples that demonstrate your achievements youll be well on your way to a successful interview and a promising career FAQs 1 What if I dont have a lot of work experience Focus on your academic projects extracurricular activities or volunteer work Highlight the skills and experiences you gained even if theyre not directly related to the job 2 How many examples should I prepare Its good to have at least 35 examples for common competencies This gives you a good range to draw from depending on the questions asked 3 What if I cant think of specific numbers Try to estimate or provide qualitative metrics For example instead of increased sales you could say significantly increased sales or achieved a notable improvement in customer satisfaction 4 Should I be honest about my mistakes Absolutely Its okay to mention a challenge you faced and what you learned from it Demonstrating selfawareness and growth is a positive attribute 5 What if the interviewer asks about a competency I havent prepared for Take a moment to think and draw on your experiences Try to relate your answer back to the job requirements and your transferable skills
