since the mid 1980s a dramatic opening in mexico's political and electoral processes combined with the growth of a new civic culture has created unprecedented opportunities for women and other previously repressed or ignored groups to participate in the political life of the nation in this book victoria rodríguez offers the first comprehensive analysis of how mexican women have taken advantage of new opportunities to participate in the political process through elected and appointed office nongovernmental organizations and grassroots activism drawing on scores of interviews with politically active women conducted since 1994 rodríguez looks at mexican women's political participation from a variety of angles she analyzes the factors that have increased women's political activity from the women's movement to the economic crises of the 1980s and 1990s to increasing democratization to the victory of vicente fox in the 2000 presidential election she maps out the pathways that women have used to gain access to public life and also the roadblocks that continue to limit women's participation in politics especially at higher levels of government and she offers hopeful yet realistic predictions for women's future participation in the political life of mexico

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a comprehensive view of the remarkable transformation of mexico's political system to a democratic model the contributors to this volume assess the most influential institutions actors policies and issues in the country's current evolution toward democratic consolidation

this text argues that instead of leading toward greater democratization mexico s policies of privatization in the 1980s were used for personal benefit and to lubricate the existing state labour relationship it builds its case around the privatization of mexico s telecommunications

with the passage of the cold war political parties in nearly every corner of the globe have undergone a vast upheaval old ideas have become obsolete electoral maps have been redrawn party structures have been rebuilt and new leaders have emerged political parties and the collapse of the old orders describes these changes using several countries as laboratories the united states united kingdom france germany italy canada australia mexico israel south africa and russia while the nature and extent of the political upheavals vary from place to place the transformations in each nation s party system have been extraordinary in this new world order the old political arrangements and old ways of doing things have disappeared the altered states of political parties in the post cold war world pose a central question what does change look like the answers given here illuminate our understanding of why the world has changed and how political parties are attempting to cope with it

to date the mainstream literature on mexican politics has said little about women even though their participation as formal political actors has increased dramatically in the past fifteen years somewhat surprisingly the political participation of women although well documented in other latin american countries has been neglected in the case

this book explores the process of popular mobilisation in contemporary mexico through the experience of the country s most important popular organisation the teachers movement it creates a distinctive perspective on mexican politics and makes an interesting contribution to the study of popular or social movements this in depth study of a popular movement in latin america provides a richly detailed account of its organisation leadership strategic choices and factional divisions through its innovative methods which produce an unusual and compelling blend of fact and theory the book uncovers the motivations and mechanisms of popular mobilization as well as explaining its interactions with national politics in mexico and beyond

initiated in the mid 1970s mexico s program of political reform was designed to provide a new opportunity for political competition in this book contributors examine the significance political mobilization has had and the extent to which the reform has served as a vehicle for defusing discontent in the wake of mexico s failed oil based developme

now in its third edition this unique textbook remains a favourite for introductory undergraduate courses in comparative politics it features twelve theoretically and historically grounded country studies that show how the three major concepts of comparative analysis interests identities and institutions shape the politics of nations and regions written in a style free of heavy handed jargon and organized to address the concerns of contemporary comparativists this textbook provides students with the conceptual tools and historical background they need to understand the politics of our complex world this third edition introduces completely new chapters on the european union france and nigeria

covering the period from the re establishment of the irish militia during the crimean war until the disbandment of the ulster defence regiment in 1992 this book examines the irish amateur military tradition within the british army distinctive from a british amateur military tradition irish men and women of both religions and political persuasions made a significant contribution to these forces and in so doing played an important role within the british empire whilst also providing a crucial link between the army and irish society utilising new source material this book demonstrates the complex nature of irish involvement with british institutions and its empire it argues that within this unique tradition two divergent protestant and catholic traditions emerged and membership of these organisations was used as a means of social mobility for political patronage and crucially to demonstrate loyalty to britain and its empire

neoliberalism in mexico characterized by free markets by the privitization of thousands of state enterprises and by influence from washington and wall street has forever changed the political climate making it necessary to theorize new paths for the future indeed liberal ideology champions not only economic freedom but individual liberty as well in the canon of liberal texts adam smith s the wealth of nations coexists with john stuart mill s the subjugation of women a biting commentary on gender inequality the debate over neoliberalism in mexico is not exclusively a left right conflict many leftists see ties with the u s as a means to promote social change even though they oppose neoliberal economics many on the right while supporting neoliberalism fear social influences from the north this volume focuses on the neoliberal debate in plays by four mexican authors sabina berman vicente lenero victor hugo rascon banda and alejandra trigueros these playwrights stage the complexity of neoliberalism providing insight into a global trend and its manifestation in mexico stuart a chapel hill

features a comprehensive presentation of mexico s political social and economic issues this book covers such topics as mexico s foreign economic policy and nafta maquiladoras technology policy and asian competition as well as domestic economics such as banking tax reform and oil energy policy the environment and more

this book offers an analysis of how women s participation is conducted in mexico s political sphere federalization and decentralization

processes can have a significant impact on women's participation and discrimination by questioning the form in which a democratic state is built that is the degree of decentralization the book looks to a set of forms and processes affecting women's political life a decentralized form of state government implies three levels of government in which women or any other group of people can have active participation central federal government state regional province government and local municipalities government this book offers an analysis of how gender discrimination operates in a different way in each of these levels of government and the corresponding political activity policies that fight against gender discrimination and promote women's participation in both administration and political parties do not always operate cooperatively and often exist in contradiction with each other

regarded as among modern Mexico's foremost creative writers Octavio Paz Carlos Fuentes Carlos Monsiváis and Elena Poniatowska are also esteemed as analyzers of society critics of public officials and both molders and mirrors of public opinion this book offers a reading of Mexican current affairs from 1968 to 1995 through a comparative study of these four writers' political work in hundreds of articles essays and comments published in the Mexican press *Excelsior* *La Cultura en México* *La Jornada* *Proceso* and many other publications these writers tackled current affairs as events unfolded yet the lack of detailed examination of their contributions in the press has left a gap in our understanding of their vital role in raising awareness of national concerns as they were happening Claire Brewster has mined direct quotations from a host of publications to illustrate the techniques that they used in combating government and editorial restraints Brewster first addresses the student movement of 1968 the violent suppression of which was a watershed in the relationship between the Mexican government and people and illustrates the ways in which the student crisis affected the writers' relationships with presidents Luis Echeverría Álvarez and José López Portillo she next considers the profound social and political repercussions of the 1985 earthquake as described by Poniatowska and Monsiváis and the consequent emergence of Mexican civil society she then outlines Paz's and Monsiváis's vociferous responses to the 1988 presidential election campaigns and their highly contentious result and lastly she examines the Chiapas rebellion from January to July 1994 the eloquent Zapatista spokesman Subcomandante Marcos challenged Mexican writers to a duel of words and Brewster analyzes the ways in which the four writers took up the gauntlet and in so doing reveals the development of their political thoughts and their relationships with the Mexican people and the federal government the work of these four authors charts an important historical era and a close examination of their essays reveals their maturation as writers and provides an understanding of the development of Mexican society by bringing their opinions and attitudes to light Brewster unearths a rich lode of insight into the inner workings of Mexican intellectuals and invites observers of contemporary Mexico to reconsider their role in reflecting social change

a study of the relationship between the presidential power in Mexico and of key societal groups this text examines how this has developed since the 1960s other titles in this series include *Gender Culture and Empire* *Black Writers from South Africa* and *Kabuki in Modern Japan*

the field of gender and politics has continuously grown becoming more interdisciplinary and engaging with issues context and people from all around the world because of this new emerging approaches and studies challenge embedded notions ideas and preconceptions of how the world is meant to be studied and understood it is particularly true for studies on women and their engagement in political affairs how should institutions conceptualize women in order to advance rules and mechanisms that favor women what roles do representatives have on the making of gender equality when women are legislating which are the consequences of the approved legislation

this book explores environmental policymaking in mexico as a vehicle to understanding the broader changes in the policy process within a system undergoing a democratic transformation it constitutes the first major analysis of environmental policymaking in mexico at the national level and examines the implementation of forestry policy in mexico s largest rain forest the selva lacandona of the state of chiapas

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
