hindering relief efforts for ireland were the british government s lack of a parliamentary majority from 1846 the financial crises of 1847 and a battle of ideas over monetary policy between proponents and opponents of financial orthodoxy the high death toll in ireland resulted from the british government s plans for intervention going awry rather than being prematurely cancelled because of laissez faire this book is essential reading for scholars students and anyone interested in anglo irish relations the history of financial crises and famines and why humanitarian relief efforts can go wrong even with good intentions
