understanding social psychology across cultures second edition starts by asking why social psychology needs a cross cultural perspective it then examines cultural differences and their origins before addressing traditional social psychological themes cross culturally for example group processes self and identity intergroup relations themes of contemporary relevance including migration ethnic conflict and climate change are also covered key features presentation of concepts and theories made accessible to the reader using practical examples and everyday life experiences from diverse parts of the world biographical portraits of key researchers in the field coverage of the appropriate methods for conducting state of the art cross cultural research this textbook is appropriate for students of social and cross cultural psychology it will also interest practitioners wanting to understand the impact of culture on their fields of work such as international relations social policy health promotion ethnic relations and international business

how is it that cultures come into existence at all how do cultures develop particular customs and characteristics rather than others how do cultures persist and change over time most previous attempts to address these questions have been descriptive and historical the purpose of this book is to provide answers that are explanatory predictive and relevant to the emergence and continuing evolution of cultures past present and future most other investigations into cultural psychology have focused on the impact that culture has on the psychology of the individual the focus of this book is the reverse the

authors show how questions about the origins and evolution of culture can be fruitfully answered through rigorous and creative examination of fundamental characteristics of human cognition motivation and social interaction they review recent theory and research that in many different ways points to the influence of basic psychological processes on the collective structures that define cultures these processes operate in all sorts of different populations ranging from very small interacting groups to grand scale masses of people occupying the same demographic or geographic category the cultural effects often unintended of individuals thoughts and actions are demonstrated in a wide variety of customs ritualized practices and shared mythologies for example religious beliefs moral standards rules for the allocation of resources norms for the acceptable expression of aggression gender stereotypes and scientific values the psychological foundations of culture reveals that the consequences of psychological processes resonate well beyond the disciplinary constraints of psychology by taking a psychological approach to questions usually addressed by anthropologists sociologists and other social scientists it suggests that psychological research into the foundations of culture is a useful perhaps even necessary complement to other forms of inquiry

in this text contributors explore the historical conceptual methodological and empirical foundations that link the two fields of personality psychology and social psychology across numerous domains

this handbook provides a broad overview of the field of social psychology and up to date coverage of current social psychological topics it reflects the recent and substantial development of the field both with regard to theory and empirical research it starts out by covering major theoretical perspectives including the inter actionist identity social exchange social structure and the person perspectives next it discusses development and socialization in childhood adolescence and adulthood in addition to updated discussions of topics that were included in the first edition the part examining personal processes includes entirely new topics such as social psychology and the body and individual agency and social motivation interpersonal processes are discussed from a contemporary perspective with a focus on stress and health the final section examines the person in sociocultural context and includes another topic new to the second edition the social psychology of race and gender and intersectionality
