mirza asadullah khan ghalib was born in agra in the closing years of the eighteenth century he wrote in both urdu and persian and was also a great prose stylist ghalib fascinates his readers for many reasons but one of the most noted qualities in ghalib was that he was a careful even strict editor of his work it is said that he discarded or disregarded more than half of his urdu verses these verses were forgotten for long until as late as 1918 in the library of the princely state of bhopal in 1921 they were edited and published as a new divan e ghalib in flowers in a mirror mehr afshan farooqi continues her research in the strain of her first book a wilderness at my doorstep she examines ghalib s approach to his work the world in which he lived and composed and ultimately his genius she selects 30 ghazals from the rejected corpus translates them into english and provides an erudite sparkling critical commentary through this book she highlights the significance of marginalized poetry and the need to reinstate the forgotten verses in our lives and hearts

mirza asadullah khan 1797 1869 popularly ghalib is the most influential poet of the urdu language he is noted for the ghazals he wrote during his lifetime which have since been interpreted and sung by different people in myriad ways ghalib s popularity has today extended beyond the indian subcontinent to the hindustani diaspora around the world in this book gopi chand narang studies ghalib s

poetics by tracing the archetypical roots of his creative consciousness and enigmatic thought in buddhist dialectical philosophy particularly in the concept of shunyata he underscores the importance of the mughal era s sabke hindi poetry especially through bedil whom ghalib considered his mentor the author also engages with ghalib criticism that has flourished since his death and analyses the important works of the poet including pieces from early nuskhas and divan e ghalib strengthening this central argument much has been written about ghalib s life and his poetry a marked departure from this dominant trend narang s book looks at ghalib from different angles and places him in the galaxy of the great eastern poets stretching far beyond the boundaries of india and the urdu language

this book has the unique distinction of presenting in one compendious volume the best of ghalib in poetry and prose it contains 104 ghazals seven miscellaneous poems and a bouquet of sixty eight selected letters besides a few striking couplets and qitas the ghazals and poems are first given in the original form in calligraphic urdu this is followed on the opposite page by their english translation couched in a language that is simple lucid and rhythmical the ghazals and poems have also been provided with a transliterated version in the roman script this should enable the non urdu knowing reader to have a feel and flavour of the urdu text in addition the book contains a critical cum biographical introduction which is comprehensive well documented and insightful it is hoped that the book will receive a welcome response from the lovers of ghalib who was an outstanding poet fit to rank with the greatest poets of the world and a precious part of our cultural heritage

a major activity of the sahitya akademi is the preparation of an encyclopaedia of indian literature the venture covering twenty two languages of india is the first of its kind written in english the encyclopaedia gives a comprehensive idea of the growth and development of indian literature the entries on authors books and general topics have been tabulated by the concerned advisory boards and finalised by a steering committee hundreds of writers all over the country contributed articles on various topics the encyclopaedia planned as a six volume project has been brought out the sahitya akademi embarked upon this project in right earnest in 1984 the efforts

of the highly skilled and professional editorial staff started showing results and the first volume was brought out in 1987 the second volume was brought out in 1988 the third in 1989 the fourth in 1991 the fifth in 1992 and the sixth volume in 1994 all the six volumes together include approximately 7500 entries on various topics literary trends and movements eminent authors and significant works the first three volume were edited by prof amaresh datta fourth and fifth volume by mohan lal and sixth volume by shri k c dutt

this book offers a representative selection of humorous and satirical urdu poetry drawn from the works of seventeen major poets including the classics like mohammed rafi sauda and akbar allahabadi besides the famous practitioners of this art in the 20th century the poems are chosen on the basis of their artistic and thematic quality these are then translated verse by verse into english and translaterated in the roman script for the benefit of the non urdu knowing reader this is probably the first book of its kind in urdu english translated literature

british a lonely and forgotten individual far away from his beloved delhi and from the trappings of his empire

difficult times to face life and support his family the indian subcontinent faced internecine wars and the great mughal empire was crumbling in front of the child mir who was left to fend for himself and provide for his family mir witnessed the destruction and savagery of nadir shah and ahmed shah abdali brought upon delhi these historical times left a deep impression on mir as is seen in his poetic sensibilities the book captures the personal travails of mir the drama of his time and his soul stirring poetry arguably the greatest of urdu poets ghalib made a rare unqualified exception when it came to mir as he wrote rekhta ke tum hee ustaad nahin ho ghalib kehte hain agle zamane mein koi mir bhi tha ghalib you are not the only master of urdu poetry heard people say there was one mir in the bygone era

the history of the book in south asia covers not only the various modern states that make up south asia today but also a multitude of languages and scripts for centuries it was manuscripts that dominated book production and circulation and printing technology only began to make an impact in the late eighteenth century print flourished in the colonial period and in particular lithographic printing proved particularly popular in south asia both because it was economical and because it enabled multi script printing there are now vibrant publishing cultures in the nation states of south asia and the essays in this volume cover the whole range from palm leaf manuscripts to contemporary print culture
