informed western understanding of imperial japan still often conjures up images of militarism blind devotion to leaders and fanatical pride in the country but as imperial japan and defeat in the second world war reveals western imagination is often reductive in its explanation of the japanese empire and its collapse in his analysis of the emperor imperial japanese army and navy during the second world war peter wetzler examines the disconnect between nation and state during wartime japan and in doing so offers a much needed nuanced and sensitive corrective to existing western scholarship rooted in the perspective of the japanese wetzler makes available to readers vital primary and secondary japanese archival sources most notably this book provides the first english assessment of the recently released actual record of the showa emperor this book is an important advance in english language studies of the

second world war in asia and is thus essential reading for all those wishing to understand this crucial period in japanese history

a sweeping epic promises to do for the war in the pacific what rick atkinson did for europe james m scott author of rampage in 1937 the swath of the globe east from india to the pacific ocean encompassed half the world s population japan s onslaught into china that year unleashed a tidal wave of events that fundamentally transformed this region and killed about twenty five million people this extraordinary world war ii narrative vividly portrays the battles across this entire region and links those struggles on many levels with their profound twenty first century legacies in this first volume of a trilogy award winning historian richard b frank draws on rich archival research and recently discovered documentary evidence to tell an epic story that gave birth to the world we live in now

a photo filled tour of wrecked warships around the world with their stories recounted in a wonderfully clear and lively style seattle post intelligencer sunk by enemy fire scuttled or run aground the number of world war ii era battleships cruisers submarines and other warships that ended their service on the bottom of the world s oceans and seas is enormous in the decades since the conflict wreck hunters have pored over historical records and combed the world s oceans to find their remains now you too can see them up close without getting your feet wet in hidden warships naval historian nicholas a veronico details the history recovery and preservation of these sunken combat ships including accounts from the divers and restorers who have worked with them beginning with the japanese midget submarines that attacked pearl harbor and continuing into the modern era including the 2006 sinking of the postwar aircraft carrier uss oriskany veronico provides rich detail on each noteworthy vessel including over 150 photographs ship specifications geographic coordinates and more for the enthusiast who wants an even more complete experience the book concludes with a list of preserved ships an internet resource guide and a suggested reading list to continue the exploration whether you plan on visiting these historic sites yourself or simply enjoy their compelling stories hidden warships will guide you above the surface and underwater through some of the most famous relics of world war ii naval warfare a tantalizing selection of sunken vessels including many recent discoveries naval history magazine

david mccampbell was the leader of the most successful naval air group in combat in world war ii an unequalled naval aviator mccampbell shot down a total of 34 japanese aircraft across numerous battles eventually awarded the medal of honor he first served in the atlantic as a carrier landing safety officer then as an air group leader in the pacific theater mccampbell s 31 year career reveals an astounding diversity of leadership roles and service assignments mccampbell commanded ships training centers and aircraft squadrons and held a variety of navy and defense department senior staff positions

the imperial japanese navy developed the submarine faster than any other country in the world but as a result of rivalries between the two military hierarchies the army and the navy they never utilized the submarine to its full extent nevertheless during the

second world war japan deployed a number of unique submarines these included the type b1 which carried a yokosuka e14y1 reconnaissance seaplane in a watertight capsule attached to the deck of the submarine one of these aircraft carried out two bomb attacks on a forest in oregon by dropping six incendiary bombs taking the war to the american mainland the use of aircraft from submarines as scout planes proved not to be as successful as hoped mainly because of the difficulty after launching the aircraft of it finding the submarine again in the vast pacific and indian oceans the japanese also developed the giant i 400 class submarines that carried three sieran bombers there were other notable actions involving ijn submarines this included i 17 that attempted to shell unsuccessfully an oil refinery off the coast of santa barbara causing a major panic along the west coast of america also memorable are the midget submarines that attempted to attack pearl harbor and the submarines that carried the one man submarines kaitens and the human torpedoes the submarine losses suffered by the japanese navy as the war progressed when allied and in particular us destroyers and aircraft hunted them down are all recorded in this comprehensive account of a fascinating element of the war at sea

most people in our country become fascinated by stories reported by favorite newscasters walter cronkite and ed murrow being two prime examples that had wide audiences who accepted their comments and reported their news and views as gospel chicago on the other hand began a love affair with a street reporter named studs terkel 1912 2008 whose 45 year career of recording interviews with a wide spectrum of street people and common folk who were asked for their views on what they liked hated living circumstances and an abundance of topics that they tolerated but despised racial views being a prime topic of comments the people terkel sought out were the homeless streetwalkers prostitutes cops firemen celebrities doctors teachers businessmen and a full spectrum of people in the building trades usually those he chose to interview were more than pleased to be asked for their comments and would pour out stories that made terkels hour long radio broadcasts on chicagos wfmts a fascinating listening experience as if the person being interviewed hadnt bared

enough of his her soul to the reporter terkel would wait until their story was finished before then asking them and then what happened the shock of this quest invariably resulted with additional startling stories coming out of the mouths of the victims studs had chosen to interview in fact these comments asked the people he interviewed after the first part of the story they rendered revealed secrets and things that the person had never mentioned to anybody they were like icing added to a cake and turned out to be the fascination that brought the reporter abundant listeners as well as rendering studs terkel just about every book award and citation ever given to a single person in the united states studs terkel interviews gained him the top echelon of reporters during the 45 years that his radio and then television shows were in demand by chigagoans from 1952 1997 his variety of stories was the catalyst that prompted victor kelley to publish his own version of events that fascinated readers of his eight books

domestic causes of american wars offers a unique and critical take on the causes of major american wars throughout its history unlike most histories that designate foreign threats as casus belli this work examines their important underlying economic triggers reaching the striking conclusion that many were unnecessary for national security nor were they as heroic in upholding american values as commonly concluded further conventional histories often dwell on the positive outcomes of those wars rather than on their much more important domestic ill effects the erosion of the american founders constitution and of the civil liberties and constitutional checks and balances therein while enabling the rise of an imperial presidency this historical volume addresses those often buried domestic causes and effects in particular how the american elections cycle often affects u s entry into wars and how economic motives incentivize war america s early wars the 1812 war against canada the mexican war the wars against native americans all concerned territorial aggrandizement and acquisition of the rich resources therein the industrial north fought the civil war to prevent the expansion of the south s cheaper mode of production based on slavery into the expansive territories acquired during the mexican war the spanish american war marked the u s lift off beyond its new domestic borders in pursuit of domination and exploitation in latin

america and the acquisition of new territories overseas the united states entered world war i to save its trade and loans with britain and france during world war ii a unique permanent u s military industrial complex arose that lobbied for continued weapons production during peacetime to sustain its fragile local economies thus by exaggerating the soviet threat pressures arose for military interventions in korea and then vietnam during the cold war the threat of terrorism similarly served to keep the war economy afloat during the post cold war era by an overly expansive war on terrorism the prospect of accessing iraq s oil incentivized the war in that country the need for ongoing wars to feed the voracious appetite of the military industrial complex through billions of dollars of arms sales has been an ever present factor in the wars in afghanistan and ukraine
