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long considered a classic in bolivia juan de la rosa tells the story of a young boy s coming of age during the violent and tumultuous years of bolivia s struggle for independence indeed in this remarkable novel juan s search for his personal identity functions as an allegory of bolivia s search for its identity as a nation set in the early 1800s the novel is narrated by one of the last surviving bolivian rebels octogenarian juan de la rosa juan recreates his childhood in the rebellious town of cochabamba and with it a large cast of full bodied dickensian characters both heroic and malevolent the larger cultural dislocations brought about by bolivia s political upheaval are echoed in those experienced by juan whose mother s untimely death sets off a chain of unpredictable events that propel him into the fiery crucible of the south american independence movement outraged by juan s outspokenness against spanish rule and his awakening political consciousness his loyalist guardians banish him to the countryside where he witnesses firsthand the spaniards violent repression and rebels valiant resistance that crystallize both his personal destiny and that of his country in sergio gabriel waisman s fluid translation english readers have access to juan de la rosa for the very first time

about the work José F. Buscaglia is the first scholar to furnish direct and irrefutable proof that the story contained in the *Infortunios* misfortunes is based on the life and times of a man certifiably named Alonso Ramírez who was shipwrecked on Herradura Point in the coast of Yucatán on Sunday September 18, 1689. This first bilingual edition of the *Infortunios* misfortunes reports the findings of almost two decades of sustained research in pursuit on land and by sea of a most elusive historical character who was, as we now can attest with all degree of certainty, the first American known to have circumnavigated the globe, captured by pirates, shipwrecked and eventually rescued and sent on his way. Embracing a multiconfessional and transnational approach that stretches from central Europe to Scotland and England, from Iberia to Africa and Asia, this volume explores the lives, work and experiences of women and men during the tumultuous fifteenth to seventeenth centuries. The authors, all leading experts in their fields, utilize a broad range of methodologies from cultural history to women's history, from masculinity studies to digital mapping to explore the dynamics and power of constructed gender roles ranging from intellectual representations of virginity to the plight of refugees from the sea, journeys of Jesuit missionaries to the impact of transatlantic economies on women's work from nuns discovering new ways to tolerate different religious expressions to bleeding corpses used in criminal trials. These essays address the wide diversity and historical complexity of identity, gender and the body in the early modern age with its diversity of topics, fields and interests. Of its authors, this volume is a valuable source for students and scholars of the history of women, gender and sexuality as well as social and cultural history in the early modern world.

Testaments written in their own language, Nahuatl, have been crucial for reconstructing the everyday life of the indigenous people of central Mexico after Spanish contact. Those published to date have largely been from the sixteenth and early seventeenth centuries. *Testaments of Toluca* presents a large body of Nahuatl wills, 98 from 1652 to 1783, from an important valley not much studied, thus greatly enlarging our perspective on the evolution of indigenous society and culture in central Mexico. Each testament is transcribed, translated and accompanied by a commentary on the testator's situation and on interesting terminology. A substantial introductory study fully analyzes the testamentary genre as seen in this corpus. A first and summarizes the content of the documents in realms such as gender, kinship, household and land. Wills are very human documents and the apparatus draws out this aspect, telling us much of local indigenous life in central Mexico in the third century after Spanish contact, so that the book is of potential interest to a broad spectrum of readers.

Lope de Vega (1562-1635) poet, playwright of unrivaled popularity during Spain's Golden Age of literature, including Miguel de Cervantes and Calderón de la Barca, rescued theater from ineffective conventions and claimed authorship of some 1800 titles. Many of the almost 500 existing plays are stagings of pivotal events and protagonists from national history. Lope entertains his eager public with colorful

stories of the passions heroism and villainy of the high and mighty blending these with the virtues and vices of ordinary folk and stock characters in the twilight of the once great empire now powerless and bankrupt lope draws his audience into a reimagined past that is confirmed and redeemed by a prophecy of future greatness with the history play lope gives new meaning to the moniker often ascribed to him phoenix of spain in audiences of empire author elaine bunn proposes a new subgenre the populist national history play that is communal and deliberately expansive she shows lope the frustrated historian connecting king to commoner and putting myths legends and miracles to fresh use finally audiences of empire includes a personal reminiscence by the author about the challenges of the writing process and her experience as a feminist academic in a slowly transforming patriarchal university system her protracted research on lopes early theater makes her aware finally of the significance of her own historical moment with surprising insights

using case studies and biographies the author examines women s mysticism in 16th and 17th century spain and investigates the spiritual forces that provided women with a way to transcend the control of the male dominated catholic church

a tale blazed through heaven examines developments in the representation of the classical tale of mars venus and vulcan in the literature and painting of the golden age of spain c 1526 1681 anchored in close analysis of individual primary texts the five chapters that comprise this study assess how poets and painters breathed new life into the tale inherited from homer ovid and others examining some of the ways in which the story of mars venus and vulcan was disguised developed expanded mocked combined with or played off against different subjects or otherwise modified in order to pique the interest of successive generations of readers and viewers each chapter discusses what particular changes and shifts in emphasis reveal about the tale itself specific renderings the aims and intentions of individual poets and painters and the wider context of the literary and visual culture of early modern spain discussing a range of poems by both canonical garcilaso de la vega luis de gongora lope de vega etc and less well known writers juan de la cueva alonso de castillo solorzano salvador jacinto polo de medina etc and culminating in detailed examination of select mythological works by philip iv s court painter diego velazquez this book sheds light on questions relating to aspects of classical reception in the renaissance the rise of specific poetic styles epic mock epic burlesque etc the interplay between the sister arts of poetry and painting and the continual process of imitation and invention that was one of the defining features of the spanish golden age
