today a cultural dimension is increasingly being taught at universities as a supplement to disciplines that have not traditionally paid much attention to culture universities are competing to produce graduates with a global mindset who are well equipped to cope in multicultural team oriented workplaces yet the way in which culture is taught is bound to differ depending on the context in which the teaching takes place current research on teaching cultural skills tends to favor a social constructivist approach where actors are seen as constructing collective means of sense making in the arenas and groups in which they participate teachers who are often very keen to promote tolerance empathy and intercultural dialogue often support such an approach but it can be a challenge to transfer this to teaching especially in interdisciplinary contexts teaching cultural skills explores these challenges based on experiences from Danish universities its broader themes make it highly relevant for teachers of culture elsewhere these themes include the globalization of labor markets and trade immigration which has led to increased awareness of the need for cultural skills and the internationalization of higher education which has made classrooms more multicultural than ever before

many teacher education programs globally are undergoing significant changes in response to government policy imperatives driven by global competitiveness as well as local conditions this is particularly relevant in the South African context where teacher education seeks to navigate from the ravages of apartheid education towards addressing the developmental needs of the majority of its citizens this book records and explores efforts by academic staff members within the faculty of education at Stellenbosch University South Africa responding to the demands of a new program in initial teacher education it brings together diverse views seeking to present a coherent program in the postgraduate certificate in education PGCE it examines how curriculum design unfolds across disciplines in the program and crucially the commonalities in the presentation of course material lecturers examine the purpose structure and

budget literacy is defined as the ability to read decipher and understand public budgets to enable and enhance meaningful citizen participation in the budget process it is comprised of two main parts i a technical understanding of public budgets including familiarity with government spending tax rates and public debt and ii the ability to engage in the budget process comprising of practical knowledge on day to day issues as well as an elementary understanding of the economic social and political implications of budget policies the stakeholders involved and when and how to provide inputs during the annual budget cycle given that no international standards or guidelines have been established for budget literacy education to date this book seeks to address this gap by taking stock of illustrative initiatives promoting budget literacy for youth in selected countries the underlying presumption is that when supply side actors in the budget process governments simplify and disseminate budget information for demand side actors citizens this information will then be used by citizens to provide feedback on the budget however since citizens are often insufficiently informed about public budgets to constructively participate in budget processes one way to empower them and to remedy the problem of budget illiteracy is to provide budget literacy education in schools to youth helping them evolve into civic minded adults with the essential knowledge needed for analyzing their government's fiscal policy objectives and measures and the confidence and sense of social responsibility to participate in the oversight of public resources this book elaborates on approaches learning outcomes pedagogical strategies and assessment approaches for budget literacy education and presents lessons that are relevant for the development improvement or scaling up of budget literacy initiatives

in formal education a curriculum plural curricula is the set of courses and their content offered at a school or university as an idea curriculum stems from the latin word for race course referring to the course of deeds and experiences through which children grow and mature in becoming adults crucial to the curriculum is the definition of the course objectives that usually are expressed as learning outcomes and normally include the program s assessment strategy these outcomes and assessments are grouped as units or modules and therefore the curriculum comprises a collection of such units each in turn comprising a specialised specific part of the curriculum so a typical curriculum includes communications numeracy information technology and social skills units with specific specialised teaching of each this book presents research on educational curricula from around the world

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
