this book marks the first comprehensive examination of contemporary british influence in oman and bahrain analysing britain s legacy since the official withdrawal from the gulf in 1971 using theories of power as a framework the book examines the development of british economic strategic and political influence in the two countries post withdrawal a topic overlooked by academics and political observers the author argues that a divergence has developed between britain s influence in oman a site of strategic power and bahrain a site of economic power focusing on the british government private corporations and individuals topics range from the development of british foreign direct investments and the presence of british oil and gas companies in the region to joint defence training exercises and the presence of omani and bahraini military cadets in british military academies the book also crucially assesses the increasing influence that the gulf states are gaining over britain as the legacy of the residency gradually fades british diplomacy in oman and bahrain will be useful to students and scholars studying politics and economics in the gulf and britain as well as policy analysts international relations experts and historians interested in the legacy of colonialism

this book makes a substantial and timely contribution to discussions on energy security in oman providing a systematic analysis of energy security in oman from 1920 to 2020 it is particularly relevant in light of the recent global geopolitics of the gulf particularly and the middle eastern region broadly as well as connecting to current climate change research and debates combining a political sociological account with postcolonial concepts within a theoretical and empirical exploration of energy politics the book weaves a study of energy security into the historical and contemporary development of political economic security and social structures in oman including interviews with omani and oman based practitioners as well as grounded in historical documents which include arabic language sources this book evaluates the energy question beyond the typical economic perspective considering socio political opportunities and challenges it also makes economic related recommendations in tandem with rentier state theory unlike the dominant accounts of energy security in oman this book sets itself apart by moving away from utilising liberal and realist approaches for its analysis and engages systematically with critical security studies to introduce a non eurocentric perspective to the arena of interest to scholars in middle eastern history energy security and security studies this book assumes an important place in the critical literature on the gulf particularly within environmental studies and energy policy

looking at the social political and legal changes in oman since 1970 this book challenges the islamic and tribal traditional cultural norms relating to marriage divorce and women s rights which guide social and legal practice in the modern omani state the book argues that despite the establishment of legal instruments guaranteeing equality for all citizens the fact that the state depends upon islamic and tribal elites for its legitimacy invalidates these guarantees in practice two particular features of the legal and cultural regulation of marriage and marital rights are focused on the perceived requirement for kafa aor equality in marriage between so called high and low socio economic status peoples is examined and the institution of talaq which grants greater rights to men than to women in appeals for divorce this book addresses highly complex subjects with great rigor in terms of empirical research and engagement with theory sociological and political as well as theological and legal it is an interesting investigation of the divisions of authority between the state islam and tribal norms highlighting barriers to reform in both oman and wider islamic society and advocating the removal of such obstacles

in the depths of the cold war and in the wake of britain s announcement of its intention to withdraw east of suz by the end of 1971 britain was faced with the stark reality of a marxist rebellion in the dhofar province of oman state building and counter insurgency in oman offers an exploration of the attempts by officials and politicians in whitehall and the gulf to reconcile attempts to protect national interests and create an effective centralised omani administration and security bodies whilst maintaining the image of strategic withdrawal and the sovereign independence of oman this book thus provides vital information and analysis for students and researchers of middle east history and politics the decline and end of empire and the policymaking processes at the heart of an imperial and military withdrawal

first published in 1999 oman in the decades prior to the 1960s was largely isolated from the rest of the world and its changing economies and societies with a limited education little international links small health systems and government under the then sultan said bin taimur rural communities in northern oman had very little contact with the sultan's government which was based in the southern province of dhofar in a world in which people in most countries including the gulf states gained at least some benefit from modern education and health services omani villagers and pastoralists had recourse only to koranic schools and traditional healers on the other hand however they retained full responsibility for the management of their rural resources on which they depended for their livelihoods and for life itself and had evolved effective communal systems for their development and conservation these were exemplified by regulations governing the protection of trees and by the work of the committees which controlled the traditional falaj water supply network people worked interdependently responding to the contributions made by other members of the rural communities in a system of mutual self reliance they also lived in harmony with their environment in a manner which time had proven to be truly sustainable this volume looks at the changes that occurred after sultan qaboos came to power in 1970

oman today is a rapidly modernizing and peaceful country on the fringes of a region in turmoil it does however have a long history of internal strife in the twentieth century this strife took the form of two internal conflicts the northern oman or al jabal al akhdar war of the 1950s was a struggle between the forces of the old tribally based imamate and the newer sultanate in the northern part of the country in the dhufar war of the 1960s 70s an anti sultanate and later marxist front sought secession in the south j e peterson takes a detailed look at these two wars in the context of insurgency and counter insurgency warfare he surveys oman s transition from a strictly traditional regime controlling only parts of the country to a modern inclusive state particularly in terms of security concerns peterson analyses the development of the sultanate s successful responses to security challenges especially in the creation and evolution of modern armed forces

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
